Unveils portrait of King Rajendra Chola-I & released special souvenir on the history of A & N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 17
Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency attended as the Chief Guest at the commemoration ceremony marking 1000 years of the historic naval expedition of the legendary Emperor Rajendra Chola-I to Southeast Asia organized by Andaman Tamizhar Sangam at its premises here today. The event celebrated a golden chapter in India's maritime history, showcasing the Chola Empire's naval supremacy and its cultural and trade linkages with Southeast Asian nations a millennium ago.

On the occasion, the Lt. Governor unveiled the portrait of King



Rajendra Chola-I and released a special souvenir on the History of Andaman and Nicobar Islands brought out by

World Tamizh Siragam group from France and the Netherlands. The Lt. Governor also garlanded the statue of Saint Poet



Thiruvalluvar. Lt. Governor also presented Lifetime Achiever Award to Thiru Saidai Duraiswamy (Founder of

Lt. Governor, A & N Islands outlines achievements, Island's economic hub vision in Independence Day speech

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 17

The Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Admiral DK Joshi on Friday said, the Union Territory recorded its highest-ever tourist footfall this year with domestic visitors increasing by 41 per cent and foreign arrivals by 27 per cent over 2024.

Delivering his Independence Day address here, Admiral Joshi, who is also the Vice-Chairman of the Islands Development Agency, outlined an ambitious vision to transform the islands into a major economic and strategic hub in the Indo-Pacific region.

The administration has invited bids for developing five-star luxury resorts at Megapode Resort, Aves Island, Shaheed Dweep, Long Island, and Smith Island under the PPP mode, adhering to global environmental norms, he added.

In a major boost to connectivity, seaplane services linking Sri Vijaya Puram, Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep, Long Island, Hut Bay, and Mayabunder will



commence under UDAN-5.5, with three water aerodromes to be completed by September, he said.

A civil terminal at Shibpur and Car Nicobar are ready, while Campbell Bay will be operational by October. Commercial helicopter services to connect 11 tourist islands and a dedicated yacht marina are also in the pipeline, he said.

The Lt. Governor announced incentives for international flights from Sri Vijaya Puram, including a complete waiver of User Development Fee in the first year and significant reductions over the next two years.

"The VAT on aviation turbine fuel is already exempt, with proposals

for further concessions sent to the Defence Ministry," he said.

Highlighting on investments, the Lt Governor said over Rs.1.5 lakh-crore has been invested in IDA projects over the past seven years, with 15 of 54 projects completed, including the Chennai Andaman Nicobar Islands-Submarine Cable Optical Fibre Cable project and the Azad Hind Fauj Setu Bridge.

Key decisions from the seventh IDA meeting include achieving 100 per cent renewable power generation by 2029 and full coverage under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana by 2027, he said.

The opening ceremony at Netaji Stadium was marked by the symbolic

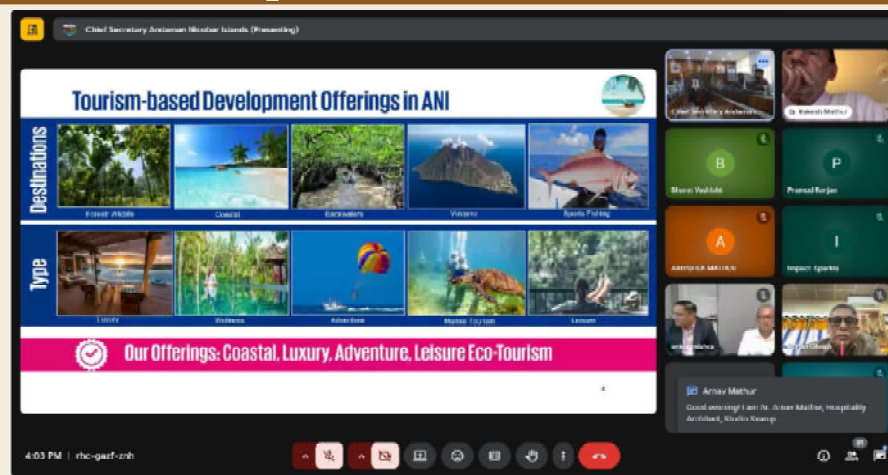

The Mela also brought together multiple Government Departments, including Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Agriculture, Fisheries, Fire, Health, Rural Development, Social Welfare, State Bank of India, and INS Kardip, each facilitating awareness on their respective schemes and services. More than 150 members from Self Help Groups representing remote villages and islands such as Katchal, Teressa, and Bunderkhadi participated, displaying handicrafts, embroidery, and local produce.

A special attraction of the event was the Tribal Food Festival in which wide variety of Nicobarese cuisines were showcased by the SHGs. Traditional dishes prepared with coconut, pandanus, taro, yam, and fresh seafood reflected the rich culinary heritage of the Islands. Adding rhythm and vibrancy to the festival, the much-awaited "Dance Nancowry Dance" competition brought the stage alive with youthful energy and cultural expression. Participants from different villages and islands competed in traditional as well as contemporary dance forms, blending heritage with creativity.

Equally significant was the festive atmosphere created through community games and competitions. project - featuring a green-field airport, international container trans-shipment terminal, power plant, and township - is progressing, with DPRs prepared and site works advancing. Offshore oil exploration has been approved in 3.81 lakh sq km of previously restricted waters, with promising hydrocarbon prospects identified," he said.

The islands have also gained national recognition, with 86 per cent of hotels in Sri Vijaya Puram receiving Swachhata Green Leaf Ratings, and seven local products, including Nicobar Tribal Virgin Coconut Oil, awarded GI tags. Efforts are on to register 18 more traditional products, he said.

"Under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana, an amount of Rs. 3.31 crore has been disbursed to 13,296 beneficiaries, taking the total amount disbursed to farmers so far to more than Rs. 56.92 crore. The constructions of a wholesale-cum-retail fish market at Bathubasti and Modern Fishing Harbour at Mayabunder at a cost of Rs. 209 crore will further strengthen the fish farming infrastructure," he added.
