DLSA to hold National Lok Adalat on Sept. 14

Port Blair, Aug. 28

The District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court Complex at Mayabunder and Circuit Court at Diglipur on Sept. 14. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in

different Courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include (i) NI Act cases u/s 138 (ii) Money recovery cases (iii) Labour dispute cases, (iv) Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non-

compoundable) (v) Maintenance cases (vi) Civil disputes and (vii) Disputes under the Consumer Protection Act.

The public in general having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair

The District Administration, South Andaman has intensified its efforts to address the issue of encroachments through continuous eviction drives across the District. This initiative aims to remove unauthorized structures and restore Government lands and public spaces from encroachments by unscrupulous elements.

In Port Blair Tehsil, fresh encroachment in the shape of locked unidentified structure



was dismantled in the village of Aberdeen and an area of 0.02 hec has been restored to Government Khata by the revenue field staff.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has cautioned the general

public that the District Administration has zero tolerance towards encroachment on Government land and to refrain from encroaching on Government land.

Table Top Exercise to finalize scenario and other activities for SLME held at Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan

A Table Top Exercise (TTEx) was conducted today under the Chairmanship of Shri A.S.P.S. Raviprakash, IAS, Secretary (Disaster Management), A&N Administration in coordination with the National Disaster Management Authority, Ministry of Home Affairs, GoI, New Delhi with all line Departments of A&N Administration, District Administrations (South Andaman, N&M Andaman and Nicobar), Armed Forces, NDRF, Police and other stakeholders of A&N Islands in the Conference Hall of Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan to finalize scenario and other activities for State Level Mock Exercise (SLME)-2024 to be conducted in A&N Islands on 30.08.2024.

PS Pahargaon solves burglary attempt case at Jewellery Shop in Pathergudda

Port Blair, Aug. 28

A burglary attempt was reported from Raju Jewellery Shop at Pathergudda on Aug.26, 2024. A criminal case was promptly registered at Pahargaon Police Station and the investigation was entrusted to SI Shivhare.

Under the guidance of Inspector Mohd Elias, SHO of Police Station Pahargaon, an intense analysis of the CCTV footage from the vicinity of the jewellery shop was conducted. Through forward and backward linkage analysis of the footage, a car was identified as being involved in the incident.

Further, investigation was focused on tracking the movements of this vehicle during the time frame of the burglary attempt. The owner of

the car was subsequently interrogated. Utilizing the timeline data from Google Maps of suspect mobile, it was established that the car owner had visited the jewellery shop at the time of the crime, with his movements matching those captured on the CCTV footage.

Upon confrontation with the evidence, the accused Chandan Jesse Toppo, S/o Late Daud Toppo, 41 yrs, R/o Prothrapur confessed to the crime. A hoody, hacksaw blade and other articles used

during the attempted burglary which had been hidden by the accused were recovered by the Police.

The successful resolution of this case was due to the tireless efforts of the Police team, which included SI Shivhare, SI Jeevan, HCs Ravi Limbu, PCs L. Horo, Vinod, Shivkumar and Janaki. The operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Vikas Swami, IPS, SDPO, SA and the overall supervision of Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS, SP (D) South Andaman, a press release from SP (SA) said.

Rangat Police seizes illicit ganja; two arrested

Rangat, Aug. 28

In a major success in the fight against drugs, a dedicated team of PS Rangat headed by SI Madhab Halder, SHO, PS Rangat in a well-coordinated operation, seized 1.753 kg of illicit ganja and arrested two accused persons namely Krishna Das, S/o Late Jiten Das, (50 yrs, R/o Vegetable Market, Rangat and Anal Biswas, S/o Shri Bishnupada Biswas, (40) yrs, DRM at Post Office, Rangat, R/o Near Fish Market, Rangat.

Acting on credible

information, the team conducted a raid near Shiv Mandir, Rangat, and intercepted Krishna Das, who was found possessing 1.536 kilograms of illicit ganja. Further investigation revealed that the accused was receiving the contraband from Kolkata through the Post Office with the help of his associate, Anal Biswas, a DRM at Rangat Post Office.

The team swiftly moved to apprehend Anal Biswas, who was found with an additional

217 grams of illicit ganja. Following a thorough interrogation, both the accused, confessed to their crime of illegal sale of ganja. Subsequently, they were arrested and a case has been registered at PS Rangat under the NDPS Act for further investigation. The seizure of 1.753 kgs of illicit ganja is a significant blow to the drug peddlers and a major victory for North & Middle Andaman District Police, a press release from SP, N&MA said.

Billiground Police seize illicit ganja

Billiground, Aug. 28

In a swift and decisive operation, PS Billiground successfully uncovered an illegal drug sale at Billiground based on credible information. GUIDELINES FOR GANESH PUJA COMMITTEES FOR ARANGEMENTS DURING THE CELEBRATION OF GANESH PUJA-2024.

1.

The height of the idol should be maintained below 16 feet, in order to prevent any untoward incident due to overhead HT lines along the route of immersion of idols. This instruction should be followed very strictly by all organizing committees.

2.

The Puja Organizers shall use only natural colors on idols and avoid hazardous chemicals since the immersion of idols made from non-biodegradable or toxic materials has environmental repercussions.

3.

The route for immersion of idols shall be finalized by the Police Department and all Puja Organizers shall intimate the date and time well in advance to the Police Department.

4.

The Puja Organizers are advised to ensure that proper ISI insulated wiring including proper earthing should be provided in the Pandals for decoration and lightings. They should also ensure that tarpaulins and the plastic materials are placed safely on the electrical wires by taking extra precaution.

5.

No lighting decoration should be made over the road imitating roof like structure. No objection certificate should be obtained by every organizing committee for their respective pandal from the Electricity Department.

6.

The organizer shall ensure to place the decorative lights at least 5 feets above from the surface to avoid untoward incidents.

7.

Inspection of the Ganesh Puja Pandal shall be made by the officials of the Electricity Dept, Police, Fire Brigade and Executive Magistrate of the area. All Organizing Committee should cooperate in the inspection and no-objection certificate to be obtained and displayed at prominent location inside pandal.

8.

No loud speakers shall be allowed after 10.00 PM as notified under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000 and the noise level of the speakers shall be maintained at permissible decibels as defined Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) during Puja days and on the day of immersion. The loud speakers used after 10.00 PM shall be seized by the Police and action will be taken in accordance with law.

9.

The Organizing Committees shall ensure that loudspeakers are not used in the area comprising not less than 100 metres around hospitals, educational institutions and courts which are declared as silence area/zone.

10.

The Committees shall ensure adequate fire fighting arrangements are put in place in and around the Puja Pandals in order to mitigate any mishap. The Organizing Committees shall coordinate with the Fire Service and Emergency Services Department of A & N Police and deploy volunteers and get them trained for fire fighting.

11.

The Organizer are advised to coordinate with the Electricity Department and ensure that overhead branches of the trees etc along the way of immersion which is likely to be a hindrance to the immersion procession and HT lines to be pruned/trimmed well in time especially in the areas of Phoenix Bay, Delanipur, Sea Shore road, Chatham road etc.

12.

The Organizers/Puja Committee shall ensure deployment of volunteers to prevent any public nuisance. The volunteers should abstain from consumption of alcohol or any kind of intoxication. In case of any kind of violation of rules and guidelines by any of the Puja Committee or their volunteer, they will be debarred from greeting permission for next subsequent year and stringent action as per law shall be taken. An affidavit shall be filed by the Puja Organizers/Committee while applying for permission.

13.

The Organizing Committees shall provide identity cards, badges or dress code to identify the volunteers to help the Police personnel to take action against the miscreants and shall direct their volunteers to keep close vigil in and around the Pandals and during the immersion procession too. The details of volunteers along with photograph should be submitted before the concerned area Police Station.

14.

A single window facility has been set up in the District Control Room of the Deputy Commissioner's Office, South Andaman where the applications will be received from the concerned Puja committees for processing of required permissions. Once permission from individual department is obtained, verified permission to be granted by the District Control Room.

15.

The Organizers shall ensure that the drivers of the vehicle used for immersion of the idols are instructed not to ply the vehicle at over speed particularly after the immersion of idols. The drivers or their helpers should not consume alcoholic beverages and any other intoxication during the occasion. The members of the committee shall be accompanying the processions to control the immersion procession party.

16.

The Puja Committees are directed to keep dustbin for disposal of waste and a separate dustbin for plastic waste.

17.

The Puja Committees are requested to play only devotional songs in Puja Pandals and at the time of immersion of idols and no volunteers or group of youth should consume alcohol and any kind of intoxication. If any person found under the influence of alcohol he would be prosecuted and requisite action shall be taken and penalty imposed.

The Puja Organizers shall keep power backup in Puja Pandal in case of load shedding and obtain NOC from concerned JE (Site Office) with regard to proper earthing and wiring as well as installation of lightning of Pandal.

19.

In case of any violence or beach of peace or any eve-teasing activity is reported or committed by any member of the Puja committee or their volunteers, they shall be debarred from getting permission for next subsequent year and stringent action as per law shall be taken. An Affidavit shall be filed by the Puja Organizers/Committees while applying for permission.

20.

The organizing committee shall be responsible for any mishap/incidence/untoward situation because of non-compliance of electricity, fire, law and order & other prevalent laws. In case of any aberration found, action as deemed fit will be taken.

21.

Organizers/ participants are directed to strictly comply with Hon'ble National Green Tribunal "Guidelines for Idol immersion", issued by CPCB, New Delhi, published as public notice in The Daily Telegrams dated 1/09/2016.
