ISRO aims for Indian on Moon by 2040, Space Station by 2035: ISRO Chairman

New Delhi, Mar. 22
Chairman of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Dr. V Narayanan, said that the Organisation is working on a mission to take an Indian to the Moon and bring him back safely. He also said that India will have its own Space Station by 2035. He was at Lovely Professional University near Jalandhar as one of the key speakers at the 8th Chhatra Sansad. Dr. Narayanan said that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has given the guidelines to work on the mission of taking an Indian to the Moon and



bringing him back safely, and the ISRO will accomplish this task by 2040. He also spoke about the humble but inspiring journey of the Indian Space Programme, which has many firsts to its credit now, including being the only Space Organisation to successfully complete a Mars orbit mission in its

first attempt and that too by using a single rocket.

On the safe return of NASA Astronauts, Ms Sunita Williams and Mr. Butch Wilmore after their epic nine-month odyssey in space, Dr. Narayanan said, he did not sleep as he was watching the entire mission. We have to learn from others for the success of our own missions.

He encouraged the students to work with a single-minded devotion to excel in any chosen field to contribute to making the nation a developed country. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

According to the data released by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), India is now the fifth-largest country in terms of GDP in the world after the US, China, Germany and Japan. It added that India is set to outpace Japan soon, as the latter's GDP grew nil in the past decade. Agriculture Deptt. of Little Andaman initiates targeted Azadirachtin Spray to combat Rugose Spiraling Whitefly infestation

Little Andaman, Mar.22

The Department of Agriculture, Little Andaman regularly conducts Pest & Disease Surveillance in the farmers’ field for monitoring pest and disease incidence. The prevailing weather conditions offer suitable environment for pest infestation in major crops particularly Coconut and Arecanut. During the pest and disease surveillance at Vivekanandapur, Ramakrishnapur and Rabindranagar incidences of pest and disease like Rhinoceros Beetle, Leaf Spot disease, Crown Rot, Yellow Leaf Disease, Rugose Spiralling Whiteflies on Coconut & Arecanut were reported in pockets.

The Rugose Spiralling Whitefly (RSW) is an invasive pest that attacks various crops, particularly vegetables, fruits, and ornamental plants. The whitefly feeds on plant sap, weakening the plant, causing yellowing of leaves, and often leading to a reduction in crop yield, although the incidence level of the pest were observed in trace intensity below Economic Threshold Level(ETL).

In a significant effort to combat the growing menace of pests, particularly the Rugose Spiraling Whitefly, the Department of Agriculture has taken proactive measures. On 20th March, 2025, a mass spraying of Neem Insecticide-0.02 % E.C was conducted in the field of Shri Deepak Ranjan Bala, Shri Hari Mondal, Shri Krishnapada Bachar, Vivekanandapur for effective control of these pests. The spraying of Neem Oil-0.02% E.C was kick-started by



Shri Parimal Mondal, Pradhan, Vivekanandapur. Along with PRIs, 16 farmers from Vivekanandapur, Assistant Director (Agri.), Agriculture Officer, Agriculture Field Assistants, ATMA Staffs, and farmer friends worked collaboratively for this drive for control of this pest.

In addition to spraying of Neem insecticide-0.02 % E.C farmers were advised for installation of Yellow Sticky Trap @15nos/Acre and conserve and augment natural predators of Rugose Spiralling Whitefly such as Green Lacewing(Chrysoperla sp.), Ladybird Beetle (Coccinellid spp.). Advisory has been issued to PRIs & farmers for effective control of the pests. situation. Farmers were sensitized about various pest management practices like field sanitation, installation of yellow sticky traps @15 Nos. per ha, mechanical method of controlling the spread of pest infestation by cutting & removal of pest infested leaves, crown cleaning and use of bio agents to check the pest outbreak in coconut.



As part of Integrated Pest Management practices, Neem Insecticide Azadirachtin 0.3% EC was sprayed in the field of Shri. Ashok Sarkar of Gobindpur village on 08.03.2025 and in the field of ShriShakeel Mohammed of Rampur village on 11.03.2025.

The second round spray of Azadirachtin was done yesterday in the field of Shri. Ashok Sarkar, R/o Govindapur village in the presence of fellow farmers and PRIs. No sign of spread of the pest is noticed in the field. 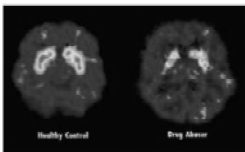
