### Our TB elimination strategy is based on 'whole of the society' and 'whole of the Government' approach: Minister

New Delhi, Mar. 24 (PIB)  
"Our TB elimination strategy is based on 'whole of the society' and 'whole of the Government' approach". This was stated by Shri Jagat Prakash Nadda, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare during his address to the World TB Day 2025 summit, here today. The theme for this year's World TB Day summit is "Yes! We Can End TB: Commit, Invest, Deliver".  
The Union Minister reaffirmed India's



unwavering commitment to achieving a TB-Mukt Bharat in his address.

While presiding over the Summit, he lauded the 100 Days Intensified TB

Elimination campaign's strategy to deploy cutting-edge technologies, including

handheld X-ray units and upfront Nucleic Acid Amplification Testing (NAAT) some of which were deployed using mobile vans (Nikshay Vahans). This helped the campaign shatter geographical barriers and brought vital screening and diagnostic services to remote and underserved areas. He mentioned that over 13.46 lakh Nikshay Shivirs, or community screening and awareness camps were organised in the


## M. Bhavani shines at Khelo India Para Games 2025; wins Silver and Bronze for A&N Islands

districts bringing essential TB services directly to the doorsteps of crores of people.

The Union Minister noted that TB treatment coverage in India has increased from 59% to 85%. He informed that 12.97 crore people were screened for TB with 7.19 lakh new cases detected. Among the notified TB cases, approximately 2.85 lakh were asymptomatic cases who might have otherwise gone undetected without the stratified screening strategy of the campaign. More than 5,000 MLAs and 10,000 Gram Panchayats participated in the campaign. Citing these successes, he announced the Ministry's plans to scale the campaign nationwide. Stating that TB is not over yet, he announced further scaling up of the TB elimination campaign to cover all districts in India.

Shri Nadda highlighted that 22 line Ministries supported the 100-days campaign and more than 30,000 elected representatives were mobilized for the common cause, demonstrating that the fight against TB is a collective mission. He informed that in just 100 days, over 1,05,181 new Ni-kshay Mitras have registered and distributed over 3,06,368 food baskets among TB patients and their family members.

ORDER NO.115

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the notice of the undersigned by the Executive Engineer, Construction Division, APWD, Diglipur, vide Letter No. WS-DB/CD/DP/2024-25/1065 dated 13th March, 2025, regarding significant depletion in the water level at the Kalpong Nallah intake wells situated at Kudhirampur, Navin Nagar, and Subashgram, attributed to the prevailing heat and onset of summer since mid-March, 2025;

AND WHEREAS, it has further been reported that substantial volumes of water are being extracted, particularly during odd hours, from the vicinity of Khudirampur Bridge, Navin Nagar, and Subashgram through motor pumps for agricultural usage, primarily for arecanut plantations, which is likely to adversely affect the availability of potable water for the general public in the Diglipur region;

AND WHEREAS, a committee constituted vide Order No. 111 dated 19th March, 2025, has confirmed widespread and uncontrolled extraction of water using high-capacity pump sets (5.0 HP) in the aforementioned stretch, leading to an alarming decline in water levels and impacting drinking water sources;

AND WHEREAS, such unauthorized extraction through mechanical means constitutes an unlawful obstruction to the natural flow of Kalpong Nallah and poses a serious threat to the sustainability of essential public water resources, thereby amounting to public nuisance and hardship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KAMALESHWAR RAO S, IAS, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Diglipur in exercise of the powers vested upon me under Section 152 of the BNSS, 2023, hereby direct that no individual, group, or entity shall henceforth extract water from Kalpong Nallah, in the stretch from Khudirampur to Subashgram, through motor pump sets or any mechanical means with immediate effect.

FURTHER, all pump sets presently engaged in unauthorized water extraction shall be removed forthwith, failing which action shall be taken under relevant section of law.

ALSO, all PRI representatives concerned are required to sensitise local residents and ensure strict adherence to this directive while facilitating viable alternative irrigation arrangements where necessary.

The SDPO, Diglipur, is hereby enjoined upon to ensure strict enforcement of this Order and submit a daily action taken report to the undersigned without fail.

This order shall remain in force until further orders and is issued in the larger public interest to safeguard the drinking water availability in the region during the ongoing summer season.
