In an inspiring testament to the power of skill development and determination, Newton, a 36-year-old youth from a small village in Katchal Island, Nancowry Block, has turned his dreams into reality. Through the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), he has embarked on a promising career in the solar lighting industry, proving that no dream is too big when given the right opportunity.

He was born and raised in the isolated Katchal Island, one of the remotest corner of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Newton



Katchal School, but like many young men from remote areas, he had limited access to career opportunities. His turning point came, when he learned about the DDU-GKY scheme through an awareness camp organized by the Block Development Office, CD Block Nancowry. Representatives from the Programme Implementation Agency (PIA) were present during the camp, providing crucial information about skill development programs and job opportunities.

It was during this camp that Newton first

Hon'ble MP meets Hon'ble Finance Minister and discusses Budget Deficit for A&N Islands; Requests enhancement of Budget

Mock Drill on Earthquake & Fire conducted at Directorate of Health Services

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 26

A comprehensive Earthquake and Fire Mock Drill was conducted at the Directorate of Health Services, A&N Administration, in compliance with the Chief Secretary's directive for quarterly mock drills across all Departments. The exercise aimed to assess the Department's disaster response readiness.

The mock drill scenario and activities were finalized during a Table Top Exercise held in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Health Services. The session was chaired by Dr. Suja Antony, Director (Health Services), A&N Administration.

The drill commenced with a simulated earthquake and fire scenario. Staff followed the 'Drop, Cover, and Hold' protocol for earthquake safety and safely



evacuated the building to a designated safe area. Section in-charges conducted a headcount and reported any missing persons to the Incident Commander (IC). The IC promptly activated response teams to coordinate with the State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC - 1070), District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC - S/A - 1077), Emergency Response Support System (ERSS - 112), and Resource Departments. Search and rescue operations were carried out for the missing persons, and first aid was provided to the injured. The fire tender and ambulance arrived on time, and the drill concluded with an 'All Clear' message from the Incident Commander.

Later, a debriefing session held, in which, the Director (Health Services) expressed gratitude to all resource Departments of Disaster Management, District Administration, NDRF, Police, Fire and Electricity for their support and participation. It was emphasized that strengthening disaster management capacity remains a priority, and upcoming mock drills will continue to assess and improve preparedness, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

Block Level Training Program conducted under RGSA at Swaraj Dweep

An awareness session on waste management and role of SHG members along with the PRIs in the waste management process was explained by the representatives of Kachrewala NGO.

The training concluded with encouraging remarks by the Pradhan, Gram Panchayat Shyamnagar wherein he ensured to provide necessary support to the SHGs for their Institution Building as well as Livelihood Generation avenues, a press release from BDO, Prothrapur said.

HRD programme on IPM practices in vegetable crops conducted at Beodnabad GP

Shri Abhishek Kumar, SA, CIPMC, Sri Vijaya Puram demonstrated seed treatment of vegetable crops with biocontrol agents like Trichoderma viride and Pseudomonas fluorescens. He also discussed about agro-ecosystem analysis in vegetable crops.

Dr. Shiva Kumar H.D., APPO (WS), CIPMC, Sri Vijaya Puram discussed on importance of natural enemies against insect pests of vegetable crops. He also explained about National Pest Surveillance System

The training program was a lifetime experience for Newton.
