## Hon'ble MP's efforts lead to consideration of reserved M.Sc Nursing seats for A&N Students & Establishment of New Nursing College in Sri Vijaya Puram

Responding to the long-standing demand of students from the Andaman & Nicobar Islands for the reservation of seats in the M.Sc Nursing course in States like West Bengal and Kerala, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, took up the matter with the Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Shri JP Nadda. In response to the MP's request, the Hon'ble Minister has communicated that the matter has been taken up with the respective State Governments for further consideration. This initiative aims to enhance opportunities

for students from the Islands to pursue higher education in nursing in reputed institutions across the country.

Furthermore, in his official communication, the Hon'ble Minister has informed Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, MP that under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for establishing new medical colleges attached to existing district/referral hospitals, the Government has sanctioned 157 new Nursing Colleges across India. Among these, a New Nursing College is being established in Sri Vijaya Puram, A&N Islands, in co-location with the existing medical college.

Ray expressed his gratitude to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi and Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Shri JP Nadda, for their continued commitment to improving higher education facilities in the Islands. He stated that the establishment of the new Nursing College in Sri Vijaya Puram would considerably benefit local students by providing them the opportunity to pursue nursing courses within the Islands, thereby reducing the need to travel to mainland India for higher studies.

## Joint Commissioner (Food Safety)/ADM(SA) along with Food Safety Officials conducted field inspection at Fish Market, Junglighat



Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 27

Upon the direction of Commissioner Food Safety, A&N Islands (DC,SA), the Joint Commissioner (Food Safety)/ADM(SA) along with a team of Food Safety Officials conducted field inspection at the Fish Market, Junglighat today. The inspection was conducted to check the use of harmful chemicals such as formalin in fishes being sold in the South Andaman District. Harmful chemicals are used sometimes to prolong the freshness of fish.

The team carried out tests of the fishes in the

market using test kits developed by ICAR-CIFT Cochin. Out of more than 50 samples tested, 04 were found to be positive with formalin content. Further investigation with accredited labs is being done on the positive samples and action deemed appropriate under Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 will be taken. The Joint Commissioner (Food Safety)/ADM interacted with the fish sellers in the market and informed them about the harmful effects of such formalin laced fishes on human health.

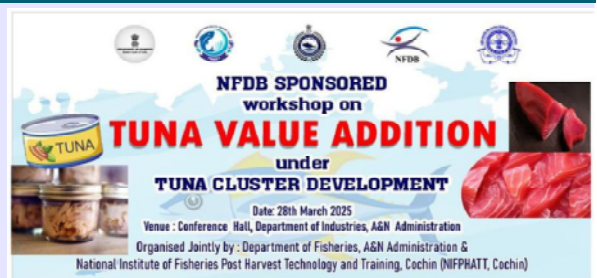

The Joint Commissioner (Food Safety)/ADM has strictly warned all the stakeholders to refrain from any such activities. The punitive action shall be initiated under the provisions of FSS Act and appropriate action will be taken against the violators to ensure the public health and safety.

Further, another team of Food Safety Officials were also deputed to collect samples of water and ice that are being used for preservation of fishes commonly by local fish vendors. Spot test of ice and water were also carried out with the use of field test kit and were found negative.

Moreover, the Food Safety Department has also lifted regulatory samples of fishes to be analysed by the FSSAI and NABL accredited laboratory for various parameters prescribed by FSSAI.

The Joint Commissioner (Food Safety)/ADM has warned the food business operators not to indulge in any such violations failing which strict action under Food Safety Act shall be initiated against the violators. 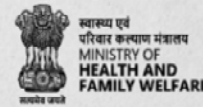

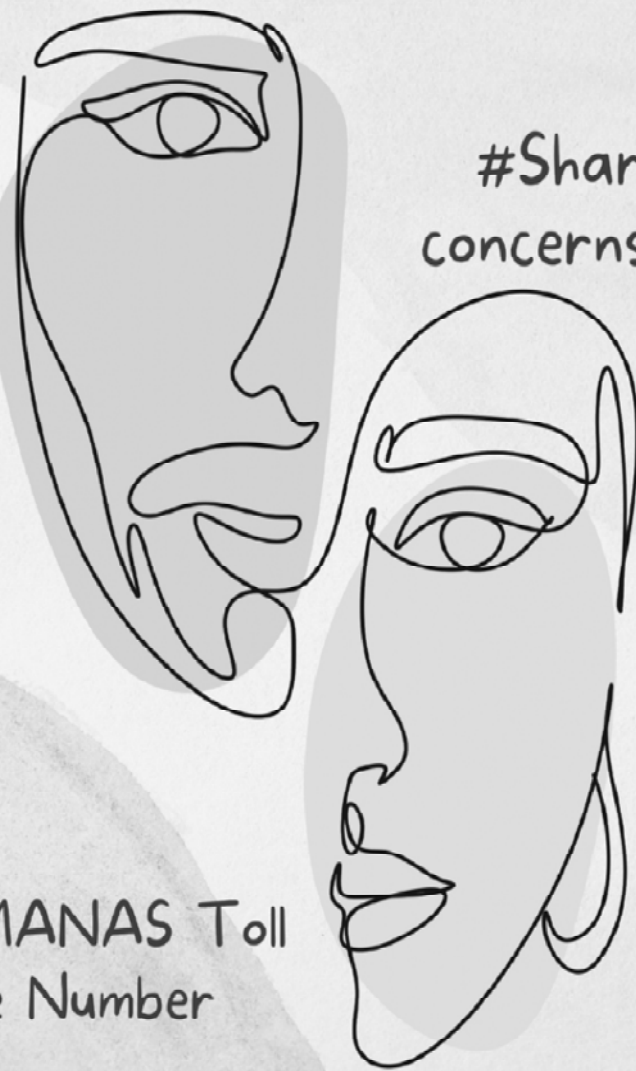
