National Task Force constituted by Supreme Court holds first meeting to address Medical Professionals' safety

Meeting discussed various issues in detail & members put forth their suggestions

New Delhi, Aug. 27

The first meeting of the National Task Force (NTF), formed by the Supreme Court to make recommendations for the safety, security and working conditions of medical professionals was held today. The meeting was chaired by the Cabinet Secretary and all members including the Home Secretary and Health Secretary were present. The meeting discussed in detail on various issues and the members put forth their suggestions. Union Health Ministry has created a national portal on its website under the title "Suggestions to NTF"-to seek suggestions from individuals and different



stakeholders across the country. The Ministry has requested the States to provide information on the security measures available

consideration by the members of the National Task Force. Union Health Secretary along with NTF members will have wider consultations with various major stakeholders. The NTF members informed that they have been approached directly by various stakeholders and have individually received almost 300 to 400 suggestions. The meeting will also be held tomorrow through Video Conference to discuss short-term measures regarding the security of medical professionals with State Chief Secretaries and DGPs. Ensuring holistic development of Agriculture & allied sectors through Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana

Support to farmers for purchase of modern tools & technologies to enhance productivity

Port Blair, Aug. 27

Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) is being implemented by the Department of Agriculture, A&N Administration for ensuring holistic development of Agriculture & allied sectors as per the approved District/State Agriculture Plan in the UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. During the year 2024-25, the following Projects have been approved, aiming to enhance productivity and support to farmers with modern tools and technologies.

The pattern of assistance to be provided to individual eligible farmer are as follows:

- Assistance for purchase of carbon fiber telescopic harvester @ 50% subsidy limited to Rs. 30000/-.
- Assistance for purchase of Motorized Arecanut harvesting bike @ 50% limited to Rs. 37500/-.
- Assistance for purchase of Motorized Coconut Tree Climber (Coconut Harvesting Machine) @ 50% subsidy limited to Rs. 62500/-.



➤ Assistance for purchase of Coconut Climbers (3ss rod) @ 50% subsidy of actual cost or maximum limit of Rs.2500/-.

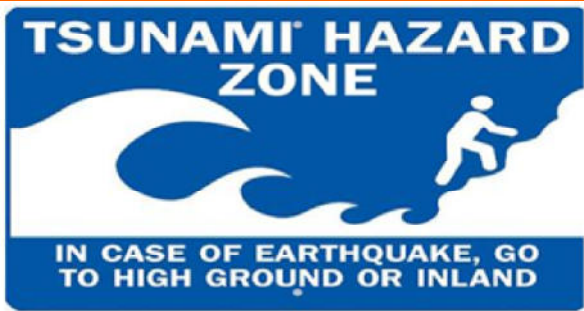

Precautionary measures to be taken during Tsunami

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration requested to general public of A&N Islands to follow do's & don'ts of Tsunami, if occurs.



DO's:

- > Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.
- > Move to higher ground: If a tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.
- > Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
- > Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
- > Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

DON'Ts:

- > Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.
- > Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.
- > Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.
- > Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.
- > Don't return to the area until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

children and severely stunted children were referred to child specialist for further medical interventions. Further, meeting was conducted with mothers along with community participation for behavioral change in understanding the perspective of malnutrition and hygiene.

Under this project, appetite test was also conducted in all Anganwadi Centers along with the participation of PRI members. An appetite test is conducted to help determine the risk of children with Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM). The buddy mother concept was



developed in all the Anganwadi Centres in which healthy mothers becoming buddies to malnourished children's mother in the same Anganwadi Center with an aim to fillup the gap of best practices of healthy mother for nurturing children.

This led to a measurable progress in reducing malnutrition rate. About 187 awareness programmes were conducted from Baratang to Mayabunder under this project and similar, awareness programmes will also be carried in the coming months to eradicate malnutrition from ICDS Project Rangat, a press release from CDPO, Rangat said.

Director (DM), Shri Azharuddin Zahiruddin Quazi, IAS has informed that the State Level Mock Exercise (SLME) -2024 on Earthquake & Tsunami is a crucial part of the on-going efforts to enhance the preparedness and coordination of emergency response teams. All residents and businesses have been urged to remain calm and carry on with their regular activities, as this is a planned drill with no real threat to public safety.

This Exercise may carry the following activities:

Increased Emergency Presence: On the day of the exercise, one may notice an increased presence of emergency vehicles, including PCR Vehicles, Fire Tenders, ambulances, and other specialized units. Please be assured that these vehicles are part of the drill and are not responding to a real incident.

Simulated Scenarios: The exercise will involve staged incidents on Earthquake & Tsunami, such as simulated fires, medical emergencies, or other crisis situations and regularly blowing of Sirens and mock related announcement along with SMS. To maintain safety and authenticity, these scenarios will be closely prepared and finalized by the A&N Administration in coordination with NDMA and other stakeholders.

Location and Timing: The exercise will be held at various places in South Andaman, N&M Andaman and Nicobar Districts on 30.08.2024, starting at 09:00 am and conclude by 04:00 pm.

The general public have been asked not to be alarmed by the sights and sound associated with the exercise. This is a controlled drill, and all activities are being carried out under the supervision of professional trainers and coordinators. They have also been encouraged to continue their daily routine as normal. There is no need to take any special precautions or alter your plans due to this exercise.

To minimize disruption, people have been requested to avoid the exercise areas, if possible. Traffic delays may occur near the drill sites, patience and cooperation of general public have been sought in following any detours or instructions from traffic officers. In case of any unexpected changes or updates, the public will be notified through local news, social media, etc.

This mock exercise is a key part of community's preparedness strategy. The cooperation and support are greatly appreciated from general public of A&N Islands as we work together to enhance the safety and security of A&N Islands from disasters. Crackdown on drug trafficking: Kadamtala Police seize illicit ganja

Kadamtala, Aug. 27

In a swift and decisive operation, PS Kadamtala successfully uncovered an illegal drug sale at Kadamtala based on credible information received. The operation was conducted under the direction of Shri Rahul L. Nair, IPS SDPO, Rangat. A dedicated team, led by SI P.M Krishna Kumar, SHO, PS Kadamtala and comprising of HCs Sailen Halder, Pradeep Das, D. Bhattacharya (IRBn) and PC Benedikh Minj, along with two independent witnesses, was immediately formed to take action.

Acting on a tip-off that a person is traveling on a car with registration number AN01Q-3118 is in possession of a significant quantity of

illicit Ganja. The team swiftly reached near Roy Garage, Kadamtala and placed Nakabandhi. After waiting for the suspect, the suspected car was spotted approaching Kadamtala. The raiding team immediately intercepted the car and conducted a search, resulting in the discovery of 91 gram of illicit ganja in the possession of the car owner Kiran Mistry S/o Kunju Mistry, 37yrs R/o Bhakta Road, Kadamtala. Following thorough interrogation, the accused person confessed to his crime. Subsequently, the accused was served notice U/S 35(3) BNSS, and a case was registered at PS Kadamtala under the NDPS Act, a press release from SP N&MA said.

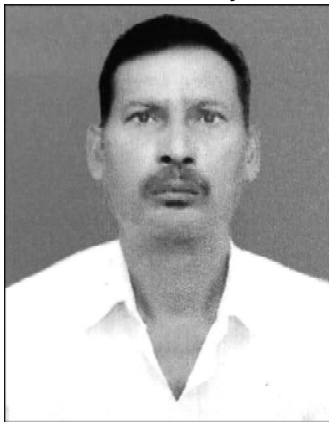
