Employees Pension Scheme 1995 amended to provide withdrawal benefit to members having less than 6 months service

New Delhi, June 29 (PIB)

Government of India has amended the Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS), 1995 to ensure that EPS members with less than 6 months of contributory service also receive withdrawal benefit. This amendment will benefit more than 7 lakh EPS members every year who leave the scheme with less than 6 months of contributory service.

Further, the Central Government has modified the Table D and has ensured that every completed month of service rendered is taken into account to give proportionate withdrawal benefit to

the members. The amount of withdrawal benefit will henceforth depend upon the number of completed months of service rendered by the member and the wages on which EPS contribution was received. The above measure has rationalized the payment of withdrawal benefit to members. It is estimated that every year more than 23 lakh members will benefit from this modification of the Table D.

Every year, lakhs of EPS members leave the scheme prior to rendering the requisite 10 years of contributory service for pension. Such members are

given withdrawal benefit as per the provisions of the Scheme.

More than 30 lakh withdrawal benefit claims were settled in the financial year 2023-24.

Till now, the withdrawal benefit was being calculated on the basis of the period of contributory service in completed years and the wages on which EPS contribution has been paid.

Therefore, only after completing 6 months and above of contributory service, the members were entitled for such withdrawal benefit. Consequently, the members leaving

Nicobar District Police conducts awareness sessions on New Criminal Laws

Car Nicobar, June 29

The Nicobar District Police has launched a comprehensive initiative to educate the public about the newly enacted criminal laws: the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, and the Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023. These landmark legislations, which will come into effect on July 1, 2024, replace the Indian Penal Code, the Code of Criminal Procedure, and the Indian Evidence Act, respectively.

Intensive training sessions have already been conducted for the police personnel. To extend this awareness to the general public on a larger scale, the Nicobar Police have initiated various outreach activities which include

awareness sessions to public, villagers at respective community halls, members of Self Help Groups, S h o p k e e p e r Association and youth to sensitize the basics of the new criminal laws at various places under Nicobar District.

Additionally, awareness efforts included displaying banners at key locations such as bus stops, jetties, market areas, and offices, as well as distributing pamphlets.

On June 28, a special awareness session was held at the Community Hall in Perka. Shri Sunny Gupta, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Nicobar District, and Shri Vijay Singh, SDPO (Car Nicobar), conducted an interactive session, highlighting various citizen-centric provisions of the new criminal laws. They also distributed

pamphlets to the attendees from three villages.

An awareness program on new criminal laws was organized at Vikash Nagar, Kamorta. Village Captains and local residents were informed about the provisions that would benefit common citizens and complainants or victims.

On 27/06/2024, police personnel from PS Campbell Bay conducted an awareness program at the Community Hall, Kamal Basti, Campbell Bay. On the same day, police personnel from PS Nancowry arranged an awareness session on new criminal laws on the boat MV Barren. zone were imparted hands on training on how to prepare bee hive boxes by the Zonal Team of Industries Department. The trainees successfully manufactured 4 bee hive boxes during the training period.

Honey Bees play a vital role in agriculture by helping in pollination of crops specially the cross pollinated crops, thereby increasing the production and productivity of crops. In addition, it provides extra income to the farmers through honey and natural wax, adding nutrition and income in their life. As such, this training shall play a crucial role on further promoting bee keeping among farmers in Diglipur Zone.

Farmers can adopt bee keeping as subsidiary occupation which can provide livelihood support to them. To popularize bee keeping among farmers, financial assistance of Rs. 800/- per Bee Hive (40% of the cost limited to 50 Bee Hives per beneficiary) and Rs. 800/- per Bee colony (40% of the cost limited to 50 Bee Colonies per beneficiary), Rs 8000/- per set (40% of the cost limited to one set per beneficiary) of Bee keeping equipment including honey extractor (4 frames), food grade container (30 kg), net, mask etc. is being provided under National Horticulture Mission of High Value Agriculture - 'Pollination support through bee keeping' by the Department of Agriculture, a press release from Assistant Director (Agri), Diglipur said.

scheme, before contributing for 6 months or more, used to get no withdrawal benefit. This was a cause of many claim rejections and grievances as many members were exiting without having less than 6 months of contributory service. During the financial year 2023-24, approximately 7 lakh claims for withdrawal benefits were rejected due to contributory service being less than 6 months. Henceforth, all such EPS members who have not attained the age of 58 years as on 14.06.2024 will become entitled for withdrawal benefit.

Earlier, the calculation under erstwhile Table D ignored the fractional period of service rendered for less than 6 months after each completed year. This resulted in lesser amount of withdrawal benefit in many cases. With the modification of Table D, the Contributory service for calculating the withdrawal benefit will be now considered in completed months. This will ensure fair payment of withdrawal benefit. E.g. a member taking withdrawal benefit after 2 years and 5 months of contributory service & wages of 15,000/- per months was earlier entitled to Rs. 29,850/- withdrawal benefit. Now he will receive Rs. 36,000/- withdrawal benefit.

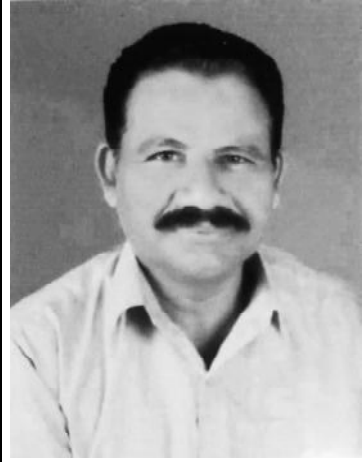
