Those behind the cowardly terror attack in Pahalgam will soon get a befitting reply for their nefarious acts: Raksha Mantri

Every Indian is united, we can never be intimidated by such terror activities

New Delhi, Apr. 23 (PIB)

Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh has assured the people that those responsible for the cowardly terrorist attack on innocent citizens in Pahalgam, Jammu & Kashmir will soon get a befitting reply for their nefarious acts on Indian soil. Delivering a memorial lecture on the Marshal of the Indian Air Force (IAF) Arjan Singh in New Delhi today, Raksha Mantri reiterated India's firm resolve of zero tolerance against terrorism and stated that the Government, led by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, will take every necessary and appropriate step. "India is an old civilisation and such a big country can never be intimidated by any such terror activities. Every Indian is united against this cowardly act. Not just those who perpetrated the attack, but even those who conspired from behind the scenes to commit such nefarious acts on the Indian soil will soon get an appropriate response," said Shri Rajnath Singh.

In the context of cross-border-supported terrorist incidents, Raksha Mantri said "History is



witness to the withering away of nations not due to the action of the adversary, but due to the result of their own misdeeds. I hope people across the border look at lessons of history more closely".

Shri Rajnath Singh expressed deepest condolences to the families who lost their loved ones in

the terror attack at Pahalgam. "Our country has lost many innocent citizens in a cowardly attack by terrorists targeting religion. This extremely inhuman act has left us in deep pain. In this hour of grief, I pray for peace to the departed souls," he said.

Shri Rajnath Singh described the journey of

IAF as an aspiring, inspirational, and transformational epic, which is not just about touching the sky, but also turning the dreams of national security into reality. He stated that, despite challenges, IAF has grown stronger post-independence, and is today contributing significantly to national security as a strong pillar.

Raksha Mantri emphasised that the Government's focus is on transforming the Armed Forces on the back of a self-reliant defence ecosystem. He reiterated the commitment towards establishing IAF as a dominant power in the region, stating that the journey towards Aatmanirbharta is a shared responsibility. Commitment, collaboration and unified vision is the need of the hour, he said. He added that India's national security will further strengthen if IAF is well-equipped and highly technology-oriented.

Shri Rajnath Singh stressed that national security cannot be ensured through import dependency, and the Government is working relentlessly towards achieving

ECBC Rules mandates all commercial buildings with a connected load of 50 kW or above or a contract demand of 60 kVA or above must comply with prescribed energy efficiency standards

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 23

The general public and consumers of Electricity Department have been informed that the Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC) Rules mandates that all commercial buildings with a connected load of 50 kW or above or a contract demand of 60 kVA or above must comply with the prescribed energy efficiency standards. This includes all newly constructed buildings

and those undergoing additions or alterations that increase their energy demands.

The building owners are responsible for ensuring that energy conservation measures are incorporated into their building designs and are inspected for compliance. Upon completion an occupancy permit must be obtained from the concerned authority.

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council

(SVP/MC) as the jurisdictional authority for urban areas has incorporated these ECBC provisions into its Bye Laws as notified in the Gazette as A&N Islands Energy Conservation Building Code Rule 2019 on 11.02.2021. Henceforth, for all such commercial buildings that fall within the purview of these rules, submission of necessary approval or clearance from the

PM Vishwakarma Scheme, launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 17th September, 2023 is a Central Sector Scheme aimed at providing comprehensive support to traditional artisans and craftspeople who work with their hands and tools.

The scheme covers 18 traditional trades, including i) Carpenter; (ii) Boat Maker; (iii) Armourer; (iv)

Blacksmith ; (v) Hammer and Tool Kit Maker; (vi) Locksmith; (vii) Goldsmith; (viii) Potter; (ix) Sculptor, Stone breaker; (x) Cobbler (Shoe smith/ Footwear artisan); (xi) Mason (Rajmistri); (xii) Basket/Mat/Broom Maker/Coir Weaver; (xiii) Doll & Toy Maker (Traditional); (xiv) Barber; (xv) Garland maker; (xvi) Washer man; (xvii) Tailor; and (xviii) Fishing Net Maker. The initiative

aims to empower V i s h w a k a r m a community members through skill development, credit support, modern tools, and market access.

To provide c o m p r e h e n s i v e awareness about the scheme and promote enrollment of targeted group under the scheme, a focused campaign was organized in North and Middle Andaman with

Hon'ble MP raises DRM regularisation issue at DPC Meeting and assured to take up the matter at appropriate level

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble MP, A&N Islands in a press release issued today has stated that time and again, many Daily Rated Mazdoors (DRMs) have approached him seeking the regularisation of their services a long-pending and genuine demand aimed at securing their employment and future.

In this regard, he stated that during the District Planning Committee (DPC) meeting for South Andaman district held from 15th to 17th April, 2025, he formally raised the issue of

regularisation and absorption of all 7,520 DRMs across various categories working in different Departments under the Andaman & N i c o b a r Administration. The proposal was thoroughly discussed and unanimously supported by the DPC, South Andaman which comprises all Zilla Parishad Members, Municipal Councillors and Pramukhs of Panchayat Samities. The demand has now been formally included as part of the pre-mandatory process required for its incorporation in the

Action Plan.

He further said, he wish to assure all DRMs that a similar demand will be tabled before the District Planning Committees of North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar districts shortly. Following these deliberations, the matter will be submitted for consideration before the State Plan Board meeting and will personally take it up with the competent authorities to ensure its early and favourable resolution. For transparency, the text of the proposal presented by him before the DPC is reproduced below for

information.

"DRMs - Regularisation: The Daily-Rated Mazdoors (DRMs) of various categories have been receiving 1/30th of the Pay + Dearness Allowance (DA) as per Government/Court orders since September 2017. As of date, around 7,520 DRMs are serving in various Departments, including the Municipal Council and have been continuously working for the past 15 to 25 years without any monetary benefits other than their daily wages. Most of these workers are now nearing

District Administration, SA reclaims Government land from encroachers

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 23

The District Administration, South Andaman in its continuous efforts to preserve community spaces and to ensure lawful use of public property has been keeping strict vigil and monitoring and Government land is being restored back from encroachment by unscrupulous elements in past few days in South Andaman District.

On April 23, 2025, a major eviction drive was conducted in Ferrargunj village. Encroachment on set apart land were removed by a team of Revenue officials, with vital support from the Police Department and



APWD staff. A d d i t i o n a l l y , unauthorized structures at Temple Myo, also in Ferrargunj, were cleared during the operation. A total of 10,200 square meters of Government revenue land was reclaimed and restored to the Government Khaata.

Similar action was taken in Mithakhari Village, where Revenue officials dismantled unauthorized balli

fencing and plantations, reclaiming an additional 1,500 square meters of Government land. In total, approximately 11,700 square meters of Government revenue land has been restored to its rightful status by the District Revenue authorities.

Residents are strongly urged to refrain from u n a u t h o r i z e d occupations, as stringent legal action will be taken against

violators. To strengthen public participation in this initiative, the District Administration, South Andaman has provided multiple avenues for reporting encroachments or illegal constructions.

He termed Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas, Advanced Light Helicopter Dhruv, Light Utility Helicopter Prachand, Akash & BrahMos Air Defence weapons as shining examples of the capability of Indian designers, engineers and scientists.

Raksha Mantri emphasised that due to the shift of power dynamics to Asia in the 21st century, the Indo-Pacific region has emerged as the most important region strategically, and the Government is leaving no stone unturned to address the complex challenges emanating from a fluid international order and technological revolution. He pointed out that the revolutionary breakthrough in the field of technology, including the growing use of Artificial Intelligence, Hypersonic Directed Energy weapons, Quantum Computing, drones, cyber & space tech, have brought unpredictability and lethality in modern-day warfare, making it unconventional & even more uncertain. He voiced Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi-led Government's commitment to tackle these challenges and uncertainties.

retirement age and are likely to be compelled to exit service without any retirement benefits. At this stage, it would be virtually impossible for them to secure permanent employment in other sectors through direct recruitment as per existing Recruitment Rules (RRs), despite having rendered prolonged and dedicated service.

In light of the above, it is proposed that all the existing DRMs working in various Departments may be absorbed/regularized against existing vacancies and where necessary, by creating supernumerary posts as a one-time measure and as a special case, by relaxing general procedures and the matter shall be taken up with the competent authority for seeking necessary approval.

The decision for absorption/regularization of these DRMs falls under the purview of policy matters and can be executed through an administrative decision by the competent authority in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), in order to safeguard the welfare and future of these long-serving workers."

During the DPC, it was also highlighted that many DRMs, who were initially engaged directly by Departments such as the Zilla Parishad, RD/ Panchayat, Municipal and others, have had their mode of engagement changed to contractual DRM staff and have been classified as outsourcing staff. It was emphasized that they should also be considered for the grant of 1/30th Pay + DA, similar to the pay protection provided to the existing 7,520 DRMs and be included in the regularisation process without any discrimination, a press release from MP Office said.
