Alternative photo identity documents for establishing identity in lieu of EPIC notified

Electorates under ANIPC appealed to cast their vote on April 19

Port Blair, Apr. 4

In an effort to achieve 100% active participation of the electorate in the current General Elections-2024, the Election Commission of India has taken special initiatives Vide Order No.3/4/4/ID/2024/SDR/Vol. I Dt. 19th March, 2024, to encourage the electorate to exercise their most basic democratic franchise. Those who are not able to produce the EPIC, shall produce one of the alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity viz. Aadhaar Card, MNREGA Job Card, Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office, Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour, Driving License, PAN Card, Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR, Indian Passport, Pension document with photograph,

Service Identity Cards with Photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs/Public Limited Companies, Official Identity Cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India.

Moreover, the Commission has evolved specific modus operandi to facilitate and outreach the voters through the distribution of Voter Information Slip through the Booth Level Officer of respective Polling Station wherein the voters could easily know the serial number of electoral roll of his/her Polling Station, date of poll, time etc. However, Voter Information Slip will not be allowed as a proof to identify the voters.

Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to cast their vote by exercising their

most basic democratic right. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/

Disaster Management Deptt. issues advisory on forest fire safety measures

Port Blair, Apr. 4

The A & N Islands are covered with 81% of tropical rain forests of its total geographical area and it is rich heritage of biodiversity having various eco-systems like marine, terrestrial, coastal, mangroves etc.

Extended summer season may cause forest fire as dry leaves are susceptible and works as good fuel. In past, few forest fires have caused damage of forest, wildlife and environment etc. The residents of rural areas surrounding forest have been requested to follow Do's and Don'ts of forest fire and to safeguard the eco-system of the territory.

Know your forest fire risk:

- > Be aware of weather updates, emergency instructions of evacuation orders.
- > Teach all household members

the technique of stop, drop and roll methods in case of fire.

- > Create a safety zone by removing vegetation/articles that easily catches fire. Consult with local Fire & Forest Departments about making home fire-resistant.
- > Keep evacuation checklist and emergency Kit (including a flashlight, mobile phone, batteries, cash, water bottle, dry fruits/snacks, first aid supplies etc.) ready before the fire season sets in.
- > Breathe close to the ground preferably through moist cloth to avoid inhaling smoke.
- > During any fire activity keep a shovel, water and fire extinguisher nearby to keep fires in check in dry seasons.
- > Never leave a fire unattended without completely extinguishing, checking and re-

checking the ashes near the vegetation. Do not leave/throw cigarettes, matches, and other smoking materials from moving vehicles near forest area without completely extinguishing it. Do not leave behind flammables during outdoor camping in forest areas.

- > Avoid any open burning in windy conditions in forest area.

The Disaster Management Department has urged the general public to contact & report immediately to the local Fire & Emergency Services, Forest Department and Control Rooms of A&N Islands in case of forest fire over (Helpline Numbers: 101 (Fire), 112 (ERSS) 244166 (Forest), 1070(SEOC) & 1077(DEOC), a press release from Disaster Management Department said.

Successful operation by Police leads to seizure of protected wildlife meat in Mayabunder

Mayabunder, Apr. 4

In a collaborative effort between the Police and Forest officials of Mayabunder, a significant breakthrough was achieved with the seizure of 2.100 kilograms of meat suspected to be of protected wildlife. During the joint operation, the team searched the area at Tugapur, Mayabunder.

Upon suspicion, the team conducted a thorough search of the backside of Sukanto Mistry's house, where they discovered meat suspected to be of protected wildlife stored in a refrigerator. Upon interrogation, the accused, identified as Sukanto Mistry, S/o Late Arbindo Mistry, 35 yrs, R/o Tugapur No.7 admitted to his involvement in the illegal activity.

In adherence to legal procedures, the meat has been seized, and the accused was apprehended by forest officials in the presence of Police. This seizure highlights the commitment of the Police in protecting wildlife and enforcing strict measures against illegal activities that threaten the natural resources.

The N&MA

District Police and Forest officials remain vigilant in their efforts to combat wildlife crime and ensure the preservation of biodiversity in the region. The general public have been requested to pass and share any credible information pertaining to any crime or illegal activities to their nearest Police Station or over phone No. 100, 112 & 03192-273344. The identity of the informers will be kept secret and will also be suitably rewarded, a press release from SP (N&M) said.
