CEO, A&N Islands reviews Law & Order situation in Isles for General Elections to Lok Sabha-2024

Urges Police & Defence Forces to be on high alert for smooth conduct of Election in ANIPC

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B.S. Jaglan, IAS, in the Mini Conference Hall of Secretariat here today to review the Law & Order situation in view of the General Elections to Lok Sabha-2024. Chairing the meeting, the CEO urged the Police Force to be on high alert in maintaining Law and Order situation for the smooth conduct of

Election in Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency. The CEO further urged to check the MCC violation as per the guidelines issued by the ECI, especially the movement of cash, drugs and liquor to lure the voters and directed for its immediate seizure without any hesitation. He also urged for minimal harassment to public during checking being carried out by the Police teams and



people carrying legal cash should not be harassed. The CEO underlined that Police Teams have to be on high alert at Nakas (Check Points). He made a special mention for better checking at Airport and Seaport as well as checking of cargo vessels entering different Ports of A&N Islands especially the container cargo vessels. He asked the senior Police officials to keep a special vigil

on the buses and other vehicle plying on the Andaman Trunk Road (ATR). He also urged the Command for increasing their surveillance in sea routes to check MCC violation. Concluding the meeting, the CEO sought the cooperation of Police and Defence forces for the smooth conduct of Election in ANIPC and to maintain zero tolerance towards MCC violations.

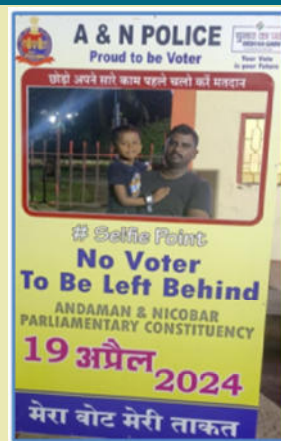
Police Deptt. sets up Hoardings & Selfie Points to create awareness on General Elections-2024

A&N Police appeals general public to report misuse of SMSs and Social Media platforms during Elections

Report malicious online activities on WhatsApp number '9531856083'; offenders will be prosecuted

Port Blair, Apr. 5

With a steadfast commitment to preserving the sanctity and fairness of the democratic process and to combat the potential misuse of Short Message Services (SMSs) and various social media platforms during elections, a dedicated WhatsApp number '9531856083' has been made available to the public by A & N Police, in consonance with the direction of Election Commission of India (ECI).

Citizens are strongly urged to promptly report any instances of objectionable messages, providing essential details such as the sender's number etc. to this specialized platform. Any such malicious online activity may lead to prosecution of offenders.

Upon receipt of reports, the Andaman & Nicobar Police will initiate a thorough investigation, leveraging the full extent of legal provisions outlined in the Indian Penal Code, Representation of the People Act, 1951, Information Technology Act-2000, Conduct of Election Rules, 1961, and various directives issued by the Election Commission of India, from time to time. This will ensure that perpetrators of electoral misconduct or online crimes are held accountable for their actions.

The cooperation and vigilance of citizens play a pivotal role in upholding the integrity of the electoral process. Therefore, A&N Police implore all members of the community to remain vigilant and report any instances of SMS or social media misuse promptly, to ensure free, fair and peaceful election in the Islands, a press release from A & N Police said.

DHS issues Health Advisory to Officials on Election Duty

Port Blair, Apr. 5

In compliance with the directions issued by the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency during the meeting held on 1st April, 2024 and communicated in the minutes of the meeting vide F.No.PA/ERO/MTNGS/GE/2024/003 dated 02nd April 2024, the following health advisory has been issued for officials on election duty.

➤ Drink plenty of water and keep yourself hydrated (03 Litres per day)

➤ Take your regular medicines for hypertension, diabetes or any chronic illness as prescribed by your doctor on time.

➤ In case you are diabetic, carry sweet items/toffees with you for ready use in case you develop Hypoglycemia (Low Sugar Levels)

➤ The symptoms of Low Sugar Levels include irritability, confusion, sweating, feeling dizzy, fast heartbeat, blurring of vision, headache and seizures.

➤ Glucose powder is also supplied in the first aid kit provided to your Polling Station. You can have 3 teaspoons of glucose powder in the event of low sugar levels.

➤ In case you develop any unusual symptoms like chest pain, breathlessness, giddiness, sweating, numbness or weakness especially on one side of the body or difficulty in speaking, please contact your doctor immediately. The contact details of the doctors are available with the Sector Magistrate.

➤ Heat stroke may result from physical over-exertion in hot climatic conditions. The symptoms include excessive sweating, hot skin, confusion, dizziness, balance problems, fast heart rate and weakness.

➤ In case of such symptoms, take ORS solutions, sponge the person with cool water and contact your doctor immediately.

➤ In case of minor injuries, antiseptic solutions and dressing materials are provided in the first aid kit.

➤ In case of loose stools or vomiting, take ORS solution provided in the first aid kit and contact your doctor immediately.

➤ In case of any other emergency, call the doctor assigned or the Call Centre no.102 for assistance.

➤ Don't panic. In an emergency take a moment to think before you act.

Panicking will only make the situation worse. Stay calm and focus on what you need to do, a press release from DHS said.

Precautionary measures during Tsunami

Port Blair, Apr. 5

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public of A&N Islands to follow the Do's & Don'ts of Tsunami, if it occurs.

DO's:

- Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.
- Move to higher ground: If a tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.
- Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
- Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
- Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.
- DON'Ts:**
- Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.
- Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.
- Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.
- Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.
- Don't return to the area until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

In case of emergency, one may contact the Emergency Helpline Numbers: 112 (ERSS), 1070 (SEOC), 1077 (DEOC), 100 (Police), 101 (Fire) & 102 (Ambulance), a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

N&M Andaman District Police committed towards zero tolerance for illegal activities



Diglipur, Apr. 5

The Kalighat Police conducted a swift and efficient operation that resulted in the successful confiscation of a significant quantity of illicit liquor in the dense forests of Talbagan, Doctor Para, Sagar Par Khari, and Paschim Sagar. SI Ashok Kumar Baghel, SHO, PS Kalighat, demonstrated leadership by assembling a specialized team consisting of ASI Mukesh Charan, I/c, OP Kishorinagar, PCs Jaspal Singh, Ripon Mistry, Ranjit, Sushil Sarkar and Ireneious. The proactive team successfully seized a significant quantity of 750 liters of illicit lehan and 4.5 liters of illicit liquor, along with various utensils and timber materials used in the production process. These materials were clandestinely hidden within the jungles. Following the seizure, the illicit lehan was promptly destroyed on-site, along with the other materials used in the production process. The seized illicit liquor was brought to PS Kalighat and a case under Excise Regulation has been registered, dealing a major blow to the illegal liquor manufacturing network, a press release from SP (N&M) said.

Power suspension in various parts of city on April 6 & 7

The general public and consumers have been informed that on Apr. 6, there will be power outages in Haddo, Haddo Wharf, Foreshore Road and upto Civil Aviation Delanipur between 0800 hrs and 1330 hrs in connection with urgent maintenance of the 11 KV high tension line of the Haddo feeder.

Meanwhile, the general public and electricity consumers have been informed that during the repair and maintenance of T&D lines and line clearance by tree pruning on April 6 & 7, 2024, as announced, power supply will also remain suspended in Bhatu Basti complete, Laxmi Motor Area, Pathergudda, Satellite Colony & New Pahargaon, Agency House, Garacharama grid, a press release from Solar Power Plant Electricity Department said.

Sub Station, Japan Nallah, Austinabad, Prothrapur, Corbyn's Cove, Brichgunj, Brookshabad & part of Chakkargaon, part of Garacharama, Dollygunj, Attam Pahad, Old Pahargaon, ICMR Colony area, part of Minnie Bay, part of Dollygunj, part of Pahargaon, part of School Line and Water Treatment Plant area at Lamba Line, CIARI, Ayyanar Temple, Calicut, New Bilmblitan, part of Teylarabad & Macca Pahad, between 8 am and 3 pm in order to perform similar work in the feeders supplying power to the area. This planned outage is necessary to ensure the safety of the worker undertaking the maintenance and reliable operation of the electricity grid, a press release from Electricity Department said.

PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 of Cr.PC, 1973.

Sub: - General Elections-2024- Ban on unlawful assemblies and prohibition on holding of public meeting during the period of 48 Hours ending with the hours fixed for the close of the poll-reg.

WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 (Phase-I) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency and polling will be held on **19/04/2024 from 0700 Hrs. to 1800 Hrs.;**

AND WHEREAS, under section 126 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which connotes prohibition for conduct of public meetings during the period of 48 hours ending with hour fixed for conclusion of poll;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions inter-alia during the last 48 hours of end of poll by taking into consideration for ensuring creation of conducive environment for conduct of free and fair polling especially in context of Law and Order view point by banning on unlawful assemblies and prohibition on holding public meetings.

AND WHEREAS, it appears to me that to ensure level playing field for conduct of free, fair and transparent election which would require larger participation of electorate to exercise their most basic democratic right without any fear and apprehensions thus sufficient substantiated grounds are available that warrants for proceeding under section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Dilkhush Meena, IAS, District Magistrate, District of North & Middle Andaman in exercise of the powers vested upon me under section 144 of Cr. PC do hereby ban unlawful assemblies and prohibit on holding of public meeting during the period **from 17/04/2024 (1800 Hrs. onwards) to 20/04/2024** (P-2 to P+1) under entire North and Middle Andaman District. However, the prohibitory order **does not apply** in the way of citizens going on their normal business and chores and even gathering for religious functions, marriages, funerals and the gathering of people inside polling booths for voting purpose etc., as long as do not indulge in anything illegal or foment troubles or breach of peace.

Any infringements whatsoever be of this Order shall attract legal action against the violators under the provisions provided u/s 126 (2) of the Representative of People Act, 1951 and other relevant provisions under the Statute;

The present situation warrants immediate attention which involves larger public interest owing to emergent nature of case where the circumstances do not allow of the serving in due time a Notice upon the concerned, hence this Order is passed ex-parte under section 144 (2) of the Cr.PC, 1973 calling upon all the stakeholders for strict compliance.

Let a plain copy of this Order be served upon the stakeholders by affixing at Tehsil Headquarters/Police Stations (under North & Middle Andaman District) and through prominent local Daily for strict compliance.

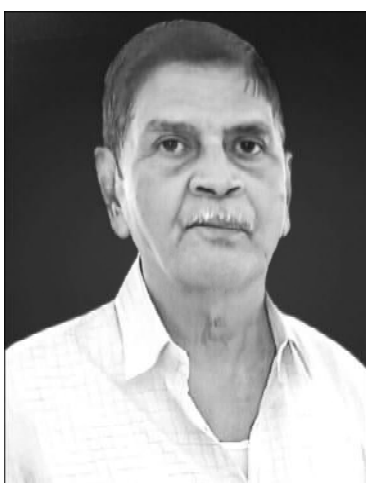
