In this regard, Mobile Polling Teams shall visit the homes of eligible voters belonging to Senior Citizens 85+, Persons with Disability, Covid suspect/affected categories approved for voting by Postal Ballot on 12.04.2024 & 13.04.2024 to facilitate voting. Hence, all eligible voters have been requested to be present at their homes on the above mentioned dates, a press release from Nodal Officer (Postal Ballot) said.

ECI issues Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth

Port Blair, Apr. 11

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant objective by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth, which have been summarised as under:

- ◆ Each contesting candidate, on the Poll Day will be entitled for one

- vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The Poll Day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during Poll Day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.
- ◆ More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
- ◆ Private vehicles utilised by owners for

- themselves/family members for going to Polling Booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling Station.
- ◆ Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the Polling Station.
- ◆ Candidate Election Booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the Polling

Health Advisory to Officials on Election Duty

Port Blair, Apr. 11

In compliance with the directions issued by the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency during the meeting held on 1st April, 2024 and communicated in the minutes of the meeting vide F.No.PA/ERO/MTNGS/GE/2024/003 dated 02nd April 2024, the following health advisory has been issued for officials on election duty.

- ◆ Drink plenty of water and keep yourself hydrated (03 Litres per day).
- ◆ Take your regular medicines for hypertension, diabetes or any chronic illness as prescribed by your doctor on time.
- ◆ In case you are diabetic, carry sweet items/toffees with you for ready use in case you develop Hypoglycemia (Low Sugar Levels).
 - > The symptoms of Low Sugar Levels include irritability, confusion, sweating, feeling dizzy, fast heartbeat, blurring of vision, headache and seizures.
 - > Glucose powder is also supplied in the first aid kit provided to your Polling Station. You can have 3 teaspoons of glucose powder in the event of low sugar levels.
- ◆ In case you develop any unusual symptoms like chest pain, breathlessness, giddiness, sweating, numbness or weakness especially on one side of the body or difficulty in speaking, please contact your doctor immediately. The contact details of the doctors are available with the Sector Magistrate.
- ◆ Heat stroke may result from physical over-exertion in hot climatic conditions. The symptoms include excessive sweating, hot skin, confusion, dizziness, balance problems, fast heart rate and weakness.
 - > In case of such symptoms, take ORS solutions, sponge the person with cool water and contact your doctor immediately.
- ◆ In case of minor injuries, antiseptic solutions and dressing materials are provided in the first aid kit.
- ◆ In case of loose stools or vomiting, take ORS solution provided in the first aid kit and contact your doctor immediately.
- ◆ In case of any other emergency, call the doctor assigned or the Call Centre no. 102 for assistance.
- ◆ Don't panic. In an emergency take a moment to think before you act.

Panicking will only make the situation worse. Stay calm and focus on what you need to do, a press release from DHS said.

'Be aware, Be Prepared, Be Safe' Do's & Don'ts during Earthquake

Port Blair, Apr. 11

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to geological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts (Zone-V) of the world and great earthquakes have occurred in the past. The severe earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical shift of land mass in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which caused the loss of lives and property of this UT.

Considering the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to the Do's & Don'ts of Earthquake to mitigate the impact of earthquake and save their precious lives.

Before Earthquake
◆ Consult a structural engineer to make your house earthquake resilient.
◆ Fasten shelves securely to walls; place heavy/large objects on lower shelves. Provide strong support to power and gas

appliances.

- ◆ Prepare an emergency kit with essential items for safety and survival.
- ◆ Develop an emergency communication and evacuation plan for your family and community.
- ◆ Learn the technique of 'Duck-Cover-Hold.'
- ◆ Educate yourself and family members about earthquake risk by participating in earthquake safety programmes.

During Earthquake

- ◆ Stay calm do not panic. If you're indoors, stay inside. If you're outside, stay outside.
- ◆ Don't use matches, candles, or any flame. Broken gas lines and fire don't mix.
- ◆ If you are in a car, stop the car and stay inside until the earthquake stops.
- ◆ Duck under a table; Cover your head with one hand and hold the table till the tremors last.
- ◆ Stay away from mirrors and windows. Do not exit the building while the earth is still shaking.
- ◆ Move outside as soon as the tremors stop. Do not

use a lift.

- ◆ When outside, move away from buildings, trees, walls and poles/electric lines.
- ◆ When inside a vehicle, pull over in an open place and remain inside, avoid bridges.

After Earthquake

- ◆ Do not enter damaged buildings.
- ◆ If trapped in rubble:
 - > Do not light a matchstick.
 - > Cover your mouth with a cloth.
 - > Tap on a pipe or a wall.
 - > Sound a whistle.
- ◆ Use stairs and not lifts or elevators.
- ◆ Move cautiously and check for unstable objects and other hazards above and around you. Check yourself for injuries.
- ◆ Stay away from beaches. Tsunamis and beaches sometimes hit after the ground stops shaking.
- ◆ Do not spread and/or believe in rumours.
