

dispatch of polling materials and collection of polled materials etc. The copy of the Plan will be handed over to the concerned Election Officials so that they can execute their work effectively for the smooth, free, fair and transparent elections in Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency.

The CEO further informed that transportation of polling materials has begun and Polling materials and Polling kits have reached Nancowry and Campbell Bay today. The Polling materials for the other Islands will be dispatched as per the schedule prepared, he added.

Speaking to the media persons, the RO, ANIPC, Shri Arjun Sharma informed that a Tehsil-wise transportation schedule has been prepared for the dispatch of materials to be used during Election. He said that EVMs, Polling materials and Polling kits for the Polling Stations at Rangat, Mayabunder, Diglipur and Little Andaman will be dispatched by ship on April 15 and it will reach to their respective destination on April 16, 2024. The dispatch of Polling Materials for Port Blair and Ferragunj Tehsils will start from Netaji Stadium on April 18, 2024. #### PRESS NOTE

**General Elections-2024- Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling stations & candidate election Booth.**

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant object by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict **Poll day instructions** on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling stations & candidate election booth, which are been summarised as under:-

1. Each contesting candidate, on the poll day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The poll day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during poll day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.
2. More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
3. Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/family members for going to polling booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling station.
4. Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the polling station.
5. Candidate election booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the polling station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency are hereby appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll from 07.00 AM to 06.00 PM.
