2024 and urged for work with full coordination and highest level of energy for the free, fair, smooth and peaceful conduct of election in ANIPC. The highest level of energy and moral is maintained in this leg of poll process.

The CEO underlined the need for better coordination of all agencies and the need for extra effort from the DCs, ACs and AROs for an error free Election. He further urged for proper utilization of manpower and materials for the free, fair and transparent election. He directed for speeding up of the distribution of voter information slip to the eligible electors of all the three districts which is very important for ensuring maximum participation of the electors in voting on Poll Day. He also urged for following all the SOPs for the dispatch and collection of EVMs from the Strong Room. The Political Party/contesting candidates/election agents must be communicated during this process without

Reminding about the robust communication plan put in place, the CEO urged for dissemination of the two hourly Polling report from all the Polling Station at all cost for its further transmission to ECI. Apart from this, the reports of the readiness of Polling Stations, completion of Mock Poll and starting of Voting has to be communicated step by step. He further informed that the randomization of Polling Parties will be done on April, 15 2024 and it will be communicated to the Polling Parties through respective District Election Officers immediately so that they can be well prepared.

The CEO further informed that the EVMs and polling materials for Nancowry and Campbell Bay have already been sent and kept in the Strong Room and its dispatch to other Islands will start from tomorrow (April.15). He urged the senior police officials to step up checking during this remaining less than one week period. He said while checking of vehicle there should not be any harassment to general public but guilty should not be spared at any cost.

The Returning Officer, Shri Arjun Sharma stated that Polling should not stop in any Polling Booth spread over the Islands. If any issue of EVM crops up, the area Sector Officer and ECIL Engineer must be contacted immediately.

The CEO directed all DEOs to ensure Assured Minimum Facilities as per the guidelines of ECI in all the Polling Booths spread over ANIPC and VHF & Satellite Phones have been made available for seamless transmission of polling data in areas wherever mobile network is not available.

The State Police Nodal Officer, A&N Islands, Ms Monika Bhardwaj, IPS, informed that elaborate arrangements have been made by A&N Police in the entire Islands for the smooth conduct of Polling in ANIPC. She informed that proper security arrangements have been put in place in all the Polling Stations. She stated that the A&N Police will leave no stone unturned in the conduct of free, fair and smooth elections in ANIPC.

PS Pahargaon destroys significant quantity of illicit liquor in Bimblitan jungle Port Blair, Apr. 14

Keeping in view of the forthcoming General Elections to Lok Sabha- 2024 scheduled for polling on 19/04/2024 across these Islands and MCC has been rigorously enforced since 16/03/2024, Police Station Pahargaon has demonstrated unwavering dedication to ensuring the MCC is upheld in true letter and spirit.

Accordingly, PS Pahargaon successfully executed a rapid and efficient operation in the Bimblitan jungle, confiscating a significant quantity of illicit lehan yesterday. Acting swiftly on intelligence received, Ms Anushtha Kalia, IPS(P), SHO PS Pahargaon formed a specialized team and executed a proactive operation. They successfully confiscated a substantial 350 liters of illicit lehan along with utensils and timber materials used in its production. Following the seizure, all confiscated items were promptly destroyed, dealing a significant blow to the illegal liquor from SP (SA) said.

ORDER

- 1. Whereas, Section 61 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that with a view to preventing personation of electors, so as to make the right of genuine electors to vote under section 62 of that Act more effective, provisions may be made by rules under that Act for use of Electors Photo Identity Card for electors as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling; and
- 2. Whereas, Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, empowers the Election Commission to direct, with a view to preventing personation of electors and facilitating their identification at the time of poll, issue of Electors Photo Identity Card to electors bearing their photographs at State cost; and
- 3. Whereas, Rules 49H (3) and 49K (2) (b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, stipulate that where the electors of a constituency have been supplied with Electors' Photo Identity Card under the said provisions of Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, the electors shall produce their Elector Photo Identity Card at the polling station and failure or refusal on their part to produce those Elector Photo Identity Card may result in the denial of permission to vote; and
- 4. Whereas, a combined and harmonious reading of the aforesaid provisions of the said Act and the Rules, makes it clear that although the right to vote arises by the existence of the name in the electoral roll, it is also dependent upon the use of the Elector Photo Identity Card, where provided by the Election Commission at State cost, as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling and that both are to be used together; and
- 5. Whereas, the Election Commission made an Order on the 28th August, 1993, directing the issue of Electors' Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to all electors, according to a time bound programme; and
- Whereas, Electors' Photo Identity Card have been issued to approximate 100% electors in the country, and
- 7. Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual position, the Election Commission hereby directs that for the current General Election to the Lok Sabhaand Legislative Assemblies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Odisha & Sikkim, 2024 and Byeelections to 26 Assembly Constituencies in 13 States (as per Annexure-I) to be notified on 20.03.2024, 28.03.2024, 12.04.2024, 18.04.2024, 26.04.2024, 29.04.2024, 07.05.2024 all electors who have been issued EPIC are expected to produce the EPIC for their identification at the polling stations before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity: -
 - (i) Aadhaar Card.
 - MNREGA Job Card,
- Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office,
- HealthInsurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour, (iv)
- Driving License, (v)
- PAN Card, (vi)
- Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR, (vii)
- (viii) Indian Passport,
- Pension document with photograph,
- Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs/ Public Limited Companies,
- Official identity cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and
- (xii) Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India
- 8. In the case of EPIC, clerical errors, spelling mistakes, etc. should be ignored provided the identity of the elector can be established by the EPIC. If an elector produces an EPIC which has been issued by the Electoral Registration Officer of another Assembly Constituency, such EPIC shall also be accepted for identification provided that the name of that elector finds place in the electoral roll pertaining to the polling station where the elector has turned up for voting. If it is not possible to establish the identity of the elector on account of mismatch of photograph, etc. the elector shall have to produce one of the alternative photo documents mentioned in Para 7 above.
- 9. Notwithstanding anything in Para 7 above, overseas electors who are registered in the electoral roll under Section 20A of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, based on the particulars in their Indian Passport, shall be identified on the basis of their original passport only (and no other identity document) at the polling station.
