2024 and urged for work with full co-ordination and highest level of energy for the free, fair, smooth and peaceful conduct of election in ANIPC. The highest level of energy and moral is maintained in this leg of poll process.

The CEO underlined the need for better co-ordination of all agencies and the need for extra effort from the DCs, ACs and AROs for an error free Election. He further urged for proper utilization of manpower and materials for the free, fair and transparent election. He directed for speeding up of the distribution of voter information slip to the eligible electors of all the three districts which is very important for ensuring maximum participation of the electors in voting on Poll Day. He also urged for following all the SOPs for the dispatch and collection of EVMs from the Strong Room. The Political Party/contesting candidates/election agents must be communicated during this process without fail.

Reminding about the robust communication plan put in place, the CEO urged for dissemination of the two hourly Polling report from all the Polling Station at all cost for its further transmission to ECI. Apart from this, the reports of the readiness of Polling Stations, completion of Mock Poll and starting of Voting has to be communicated step by step. He further informed that the randomization of Polling Parties will be done on April, 15 2024 and it will be communicated to the Polling Parties through respective District Election Officers immediately so that they can be well prepared.

The CEO further informed that the EVMs and polling materials for Nancowry and Campbell Bay have already been sent and kept in the Strong Room and its dispatch to other Islands will start from tomorrow (April.15). He urged the senior police officials to step up checking during this remaining less than one week period. He said while checking of vehicle there should not be any harassment to general public but guilty should not be spared at any cost.

The Returning Officer, Shri Arjun Sharma stated that Polling should not stop in any Polling Booth spread over the Islands. If any issue of EVM crops up, the area Sector Officer and ECIL Engineer must be contacted immediately.

The CEO directed all DEOs to ensure Assured Minimum Facilities as per the guidelines of ECI in all the Polling Booths spread over ANIPC and VHF & Satellite Phones have been made available for seamless transmission of polling data in areas wherever mobile network is not available.

The State Police Nodal Officer, A&N Islands, Ms Monika Bhardwaj, IPS, informed that elaborate arrangements have been made by A&N Police in the entire Islands for the smooth conduct of Polling in ANIPC. She informed that proper security arrangements have been put in place in all the Polling Stations. She stated that the A&N Police will leave no stone unturned in the conduct of free, fair and smooth elections in ANIPC.

has been assigned duty. He said, MO has to closely observe the procedure related to electoral roll and should be present at the time of Mock Polls to ensure that the polling process is being carried out as per the prescribed procedure. The Observer also advised the MOs to refrain from making any personal comments when on duty and to maintain 100% professionalism from the start of the poll till the end. He urged the MOs to work as a team to facilitate and ensure that the election is conducted in free, fair & transparent manner. The Observer also ascertained from the MOs their duties and responsibilities and assured them of all support and guidance.

The Returning Officer, ANIPC/DC SA, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS also addressed the Micro Observers and urged them to meticulously observe the polling process and ensure that the entire electoral process from mock poll till the end is carried out in free & fair manner. Any issues faced by the MOs must be communicated to the General Observer or the RO. He also informed that all arrangements have been made for the MOs who will be deployed on duty to outer Islands.

The Nodal Officer, Manpower & Management, Shri Anand Vardhan Mishra also addressed the MOs and assured them that all facilities and arrangements have been put in place to facilitate the MOs during the course of their duty in outer Islands.

- Gadgets like Mobile Phones & Cameras are not allowed inside the Polling Station.
- Offering or accepting Money or any other gratification to Vote for a particular candidate is corrupt practise under Law.
- For the purpose of Identification in Polling Station, you are requested to to carry EPIC or one of the 12 alternative documents specified by the Commission for Voting.

ORDER

1. Whereas, Section 61 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that with a view to preventing personation of electors, so as to make the right of genuine electors to vote under section 62 of that Act more effective, provisions may be made by rules under that Act for use of Electors Photo Identity Card for electors as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling; and

2. Whereas, Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, empowers the Election Commission to direct, with a view to preventing personation of electors and facilitating their identification at the time of poll, issue of Electors Photo Identity Card to electors bearing their photographs at State cost; and

3. Whereas, Rules 49H (3) and 49K (2) (b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, stipulate that where the electors of a constituency have been supplied with Electors' Photo Identity Card under the said provisions of Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, the electors shall produce their Elector Photo Identity Card at the polling station and failure or refusal on their part to produce those Elector Photo Identity Card may result in the denial of permission to vote; and

4. Whereas, a combined and harmonious reading of the aforesaid provisions of the said Act and the Rules, makes it clear that although the right to vote arises by the existence of the name in the electoral roll, it is also dependent upon the use of the Elector Photo Identity Card, where provided by the Election Commission at State cost, as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling and that both are to be used together; and

5. Whereas, the Election Commission made an Order on the 28th August, 1993, directing the issue of Electors' Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to all electors, according to a time bound programme; and

6. Whereas, Electors' Photo Identity Card have been issued to approximate 100% electors in the country, and

7. Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual position, the Election Commission hereby directs that for the **current General Election to the Lok Sabha and Legislative Assemblies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Odisha & Sikkim, 2024 and Bye-elections to 26 Assembly Constituencies in 13 States (as per Annexure-I) to be notified on 20.03.2024, 28.03.2024, 12.04.2024, 18.04.2024, 26.04.2024, 29.04.2024, 07.05.2024** all electors who have been issued EPIC are expected to produce the EPIC for their identification at the polling stations before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity: -

(i) Aadhaar Card,

(ii) MNREGA Job Card,

(iii) Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office,

(iv) HealthInsurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour,

(v) Driving License,

(vi) PAN Card,

(vii) Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR,

(viii) Indian Passport,

(ix) Pension document with photograph,

(x) Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs/ Public Limited Companies,

(xi) Official identity cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and

(xii) Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice &Empowerment, Government of India

8. In the case of EPIC, clerical errors, spelling mistakes, etc. should be ignored provided the identity of the elector can be established by the EPIC. If an elector produces an EPIC which has been issued by the Electoral Registration Officer of another Assembly Constituency, such EPIC shall also be accepted for identification provided that the name of that elector finds place in the electoral roll pertaining to the polling station where the elector has turned up for voting. If it is not possible to establish the identity of the elector on account of mismatch of photograph, etc. the elector shall have to produce one of the alternative photo documents mentioned in Para 7 above.


9. Notwithstanding anything in Para 7 above, overseas electors who are registered in the electoral roll under Section 20A of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, based on the particulars in their Indian Passport, shall be identified on the basis of their original passport only (and no other identity document) at the polling station.



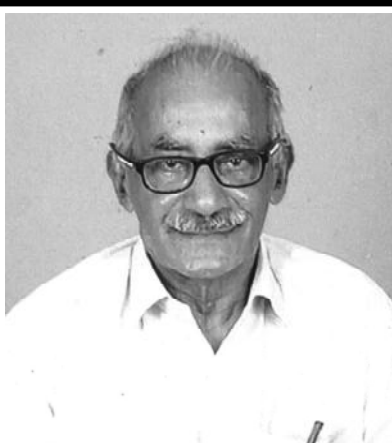
