CEO, A&N Islands urges general public not to entertain any fake messages on inclusion of names in voter list

Eligible 18+ voters may apply for inclusion in voter list; application will be processed only after June 6, 2024

Port Blair, Apr. 15

The Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS, today informed that fake news on inclusion of names in voter list is circulating among general public through various platforms.

In this regard, the CEO informed that the final Electoral Roll for the General

Election 2024 has been finalized and published on 27th March, 2024 (Last date of nomination) and thereafter no inclusion of names in electoral roll shall be made till 06.06.2024 i.e. on completion of election period.

However, the eligible 18+ voters may apply for inclusion in voter list but their application

will be processed only after 06.06.2024 i.e. on completion of election period.

The CEO has requested general public not to entertain any fake messages on inclusion of names in voter list.

Further, the CEO informed that as per the Electoral Roll published on 27th March, 2024, the total number of electors for

the General Election 2024 is 3,15,148. The number of male electors is 1,64,012 and the number of female electors is 1,51,132 while the no. of third gender is 04. The gender ratio has improved and stands at 921 this time compared to 886 in the Elections in 2019 which shows that the number of female electors has increased. The CEO

further informed that the electors in between the age of 18-19 years are 5,319 while in the age group of 20-29 years is 65,706. He further informed that the electors in the age group of 30-79 years are 2,41,332 while the number of electors in the age 85+ is 1,037 while the number of PwDs is 2,422, a press release from CEO, A&N Islands said.

RO, ANIPC warns YouTube Channels/ WhatsApp groups to strictly adhere to MCC guidelines

The Office of the Returning Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency has received complaints regarding violation of Model Code of Conduct (MCC)

guidelines by YouTube channels/ WhatsApp Groups since the implementation of Model Code of Conduct from 16th March, 2024. Acting on the complaints, the Returning Officer, ANIPC has taken

strict action and Show Cause Notices have been issued to Admins of the YouTube Channels/ WhatsApp Groups.

The Returning Officer, ANIPC has warned all the Youtubers/Admins of Social media groups

to refrain from any violations of MCC guidelines during the election, and has further reiterated that strict action shall be initiated against anyone found violating the same, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

Returning Officer, ANIPC carries out night inspections of Flying Squads and Surveillance Team

General Elections-2024: Prohibitory Order under section 144 of Cr.PC, 1973

Ban on unlawful assemblies and prohibition on holding of public meeting during the period of 48 hours ending with the hours fixed for the close of the poll

Port Blair, Apr.15

The Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 (Phase-I) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency and Polling will be held on 19/04/2024 from 0700 hrs. to 1800 hrs. Under section 126 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which connotes prohibition for conduct of public meetings during the period of 48 hours ending with hour fixed

for conclusion of poll, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions inter-alia during the last 48 hours of end of poll by taking into consideration for ensuring creation of conducive environment for conduct of free and fair polling especially in context of Law and Order view point by banning unlawful assemblies and prohibition on holding public meetings.

To ensure level playing field for conduct

of free, fair and transparent election which would require larger participation of electorate to exercise their most basic democratic right without any fear and apprehensions thus sufficient substantiated grounds are available that warrants for proceeding under section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, District of South Andaman in exercise of the powers

vested upon under section 144 of Cr. PC do hereby ban unlawful assemblies and prohibit on holding of public meeting during the period from 17/04/2024 (1800 Hrs. onwards) to 20/04/2024 (P-2 to P+1) under entire South Andaman District. However, the prohibitory order does not apply in the way of citizens going on their normal business and chores and even gathering for religious functions, marriages,

ECI prohibits use of camera/cellular (mobile)/ cordless/wireless phone sets, etc. in Polling Stations

Herculean efforts of A&N Police leads to tracing of missing tourist from Kerala inside Shaheed Dweep forest

Port Blair, Apr. 15

Information was received at PS Shaheed Dweep on April 8, 2024, that a tourist has not returned back to the resort since 07/04/2024 morning, when he left on a cycle before sunrise. Subsequently, a team was formed for the search of the missing person and upon checking of CCTVs, it was found that he was cycling towards Neil Kendra on 07/04/2024 at around 4 am. With this clue, it was assumed that he was cycling towards Neil Kendra for watching the sunrise and accordingly search was initiated in the jungles around Neil Kendra. Police Marine Force and local fishermen community were also roped in to aid search in the sea.

after a day of intense jungle combing operation a cycle, that was identified as belonging to the tourist, was found inside the jungle. To further expedite the search, assistance of Police Tracker Dog was taken and search began with renewed vigor.

Police teams along with local villagers continued with combing operation through the dense forests. The search operation was particularly challenging due to the intense heat wave and high density of the jungle foliage. Despite these challenges, the team recognized the value of time in the search operation and continued the effort without care for day and night.

Finally, on April 14, 2024 the missing person

was found alive in the jungle. Due to certain underlying health condition, he had ventured into the forest in the early hours of morning of 07/04/2024 and lost his way. The condition of the missing person is stable and he is getting treated for dehydration caused due to excessive heat. He has been handed over to his father who had arrived from Kerala on being informed of his missing report.

A&N Police issues advisory on Cybercriminals using malicious browser extensions to hack email accounts

Port Blair, Apr. 15

A new wave of cyber-attacks has been observed targeting users through malicious browser extensions. The attackers often use social engineering techniques to trick users into installing the malicious browser extension. Generally, Gmail accounts are being targeted from a malicious browser extension, spread via phishing emails, that targets Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge and other Chromium-based browsers. Once installed, this extension is able to steal contents of Gmail messages and even infect the mobile phones, especially android phones.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens.

- ◆ Regularly review the installed browser extensions to identify any suspicious ones. Avoid installing any extension or other software sent to you in an email.
- ◆ Only download extensions from trusted sources, such as the Chrome Web Store or Mozilla add-ons, etc.
- ◆ Avoid opening emails from unknown senders as well as downloading any attachments they may contain.
- ◆ Avoid clicking on links from suspicious emails or posts on message boards, as they could lead to compromised pages.
- ◆ Install antivirus apps and enable Google Play Protect on your smartphone.
- ◆ Keep software up to date to benefit from the latest bug fixes and security patches.



WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 (Phase-I) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency and polling will be held on **19/04/2024 from 0700 Hrs. to 1800 Hrs.;**

AND WHEREAS, under section 126 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which connotes prohibition for conduct of public meetings during the period of 48 hours ending with hour fixed for conclusion of poll;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions inter-alia during the last 48 hours of end of poll by taking into consideration for ensuring creation of conducive environment for conduct of free and fair polling especially in context of Law and Order view point by banning on unlawful assemblies and prohibition on holding public meetings.

AND WHEREAS, it appears to me that to ensure level playing field for conduct of free, fair and transparent election which would require larger participation of electorate to exercise their most basic democratic right without any fear and apprehensions thus sufficient substantiated grounds are available that warrants for proceeding under section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Dilkhush Meena, IAS, District Magistrate, District of North & Middle Andaman in exercise of the powers vested upon me under section 144 of Cr. However, the prohibitory order **does not apply** in the way of citizens going on their normal business and chores and even gathering for religious functions, marriages, funerals and the gathering of people inside polling booths for voting purpose etc., as long as do not indulge in anything illegal or foment troubles or breach of peace.

Any infringements whatsoever be of this Order shall attract legal action against the violators under the provisions provided u/s 126 (2) of the Representative of People Act, 1951 and other relevant provisions under the Statute;

The present situation warrants immediate attention which involves larger public interest owing to emergent nature of case where the circumstances do not allow of the serving in due time a Notice upon the concerned, hence this Order is passed ex-parte under section 144 (2) of the Cr.PC, 1973 calling upon all the stakeholders for strict compliance.

PRESS NOTE

General Elections-2024- Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling stations & candidate election Booth.

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant object by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict **Poll day instructions** on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling stations & candidate election booth, which are been summarised as under:-

1. Each contesting candidate, on the poll day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The poll day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during poll day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.
2. More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
3. Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/family members for going to polling booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling station.
4. Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the polling station.
5. Candidate election booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the polling station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency are hereby appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll from 07.00 AM to 06.00 PM.
