District Administration, South Andaman facilitates Free Pick Up and Drop Facility to Senior Citizens & Divyangjans

The District Administration, South Andaman has been taking many pro-active steps in reaching out to eligible voters especially senior citizens and divyangjans. In this regard, special drive was undertaken by facilitating postal ballots on 12.04.2024 and 13.04.2024 at their households. Auto and Taxi Associations were also sensitized and advised to provide free ride between their home and Polling Stations. All Polling Stations are made Divyang friendly by providing suitable ramps. Similarly, wheelchairs have also been made available in the Polling Stations.

In another step towards encouraging the voters who are Senior Citizens and Divyang voters to exercise their votes, it has been decided by the District Election Office that suitable transportation facility would be provided free of cost on Poll Day i.e. on 19th of April 2024. Eligible voters may register their names by contacting the Toll Free Number '1950' or by submitting their request through the Mobile App 'SAKSHAM'. Accordingly, the District Administration would make necessary arrangements for providing free pick up and drop facility to the eligible voters. If any voter has

messages, providing essential details such as the sender's number etc. to this specialized platform. Any such malicious online activity may lead to prosecution of offenders. Upon receipt of reports, the Andaman & Nicobar Police will initiate a thorough investigation, leveraging the full extent of legal provisions outlined in the Indian Penal Code, Representation of the People Act, 1951, Information Technology Act-2000, Conduct of Election Rules, 1961, and various directives issued by the Election Commission of

ECI prohibits conducting & publishing of Exit Poll in any form between 7 am on 19th April and 6.30 pm on 1st June, 2024

Electorates under ANIPC cautioned for any kind of act in contravention of the provisions envisaged under the statute

Port Blair, Apr. 17

All concerned have been informed that the Election Commission of India has notified the period between 7 am on 19th April, 2024 (Friday) and 6.30 pm on 1st June, 2024 (Saturday) as the period during which conducting and publishing or publicising exit poll by means of the print or electronic media or dissemination in manner whatsoever, the result of

any exit poll in connection with the General Elections- 2024, shall be prohibited.

Furthermore, displaying any election matter including results of any opinion poll or any other poll survey, in any electronic media, would be prohibited during the period of 48 hours ending with the hours fixed for the conclusion of the poll. Moreover, adequate provisions are available

under the Representation of People Act, 1951 for any contravention.

All the electorates under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to be informed citizens and to be cautioned for any kind of act in contravention of the provisions envisaged under the statute, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

ECI prohibits use of camera/cellular (mobile)/cordless/wireless phone sets etc. in Polling Stations

Voters urged not to carry any such gadgets with them to Polling Station

Port Blair, Apr. 17

The Election Commission of India has issued strict standing instructions that no cellular (mobile)/cordless/wireless phone sets, are allowed inside the Polling Stations and also in the 100 meters perimeter of Polling Stations

by the voters while exercising their franchise in order to maintain the secrecy of voting process.

It is, therefore, hereby appealed to the voters under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency not to carry any such

gadgets with them to the Polling Station to obviate any last minute inconvenience.

The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and hours of Poll is from 7 AM to 6 PM, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

Health Advisory to Officials on Election Duty

Port Blair, Apr. 17

In compliance with the directions issued by the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency during the meeting held on 1st April, 2024 and communicated in the minutes of the meeting vide F.No.PA/ERO/MTNGS/GE/2024/003 dated 02nd April 2024, the following health advisory has been issued for officials on election duty.

► Drink plenty of water and keep yourself hydrated (03 Litres per day)

► Take your regular medicines for hypertension, diabetes or any chronic illness as prescribed by your doctor on time.

► In case you are diabetic, carry sweet items/toffees with you for ready use in case you develop Hypoglycemia (Low Sugar Levels)

► The symptoms of Low Sugar Levels include irritability, confusion, sweating, feeling dizzy, fast heartbeat, blurring of vision, headache and seizures.

► Glucose powder is also supplied in the first aid kit provided to your Polling

Station. You can have 3 teaspoons of glucose powder in the event of low sugar levels.

► In case you develop any unusual symptoms like chest pain, breathlessness, giddiness, sweating, numbness or weakness especially on one side of the body or difficulty in speaking, please contact your doctor immediately. The contact details of the doctors are available with the Sector Magistrate.

► Heat stroke may result from physical over-exertion in hot climatic conditions. The symptoms include excessive sweating, hot skin, confusion, dizziness, balance problems, fast heart rate and weakness.

► In case of such symptoms, take ORS solutions, sponge the person with cool water and contact your doctor immediately.

► In case of minor injuries, antiseptic solutions and dressing materials are provided in the first aid kit.

► In case of loose stools or vomiting, take ORS solution provided in the

first aid kit and contact your doctor immediately.

► In case of any other emergency, call the doctor assigned or the Call Centre no. 102 for assistance.

► Don't panic. In an emergency take a moment to think before you act. Panicking will only make the situation worse. Stay calm and focus on what you need to do, a press release from DHS said.

PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 of Cr.PC. 1973.

Sub:- General Elections- MCC restriction on presence of political functionaries in constituency after the campaign period is over.

WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has laid down strict instruction for compliance during the period of 48 hours ending with the hours fixed for the conclusion of the poll, to ensure level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections;

AND WHEREAS, the Commission taking into cognizance of the matter has instructed that after the closure of campaign period effective under this constituency from 17/04/2024 (Wednesday) at 1800 Hrs. onwards, all political functionary/s/party workers/procession functionaries/campaign-functionaries/ star campaigners, who have been brought from outside the constituency and who are not electors of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency, should not continue to remain in this constituency forthwith as their presence after campaign ends may undermine the atmosphere for free and fair poll.

AND WHEREAS, the ibid instruction remains incumbent upon all Political functionaries (other than the election agent) who are not electors of this Constituency to leave the Constituency immediately;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, District of South Andaman in exercise of the powers vested upon me under section 144 of Cr. PC 1973 do hereby direct all political functionaries (other than the election agent) to leave the A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency after the campaign period is over immediately, failing which deemed action shall be taken against the concerned under the extant provisions under the statute.

Let a plain copy of the order be posted in public domain, media and on the Notice Board of all offices.

ECI issues Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth

Port Blair, Apr. 17

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant objective by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth, which have been summarised as under:

► Each contesting candidate, on the Poll Day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The Poll Day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the

vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during Poll Day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.

► More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.

► Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/ family members for going to Polling Booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling Station. ► Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the Polling Station.

► Candidate Election Booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the Polling Station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain, they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll from 7 am to 6 pm, a press note from office of RO, ANIPC said.

RO, ANIPC warns YouTube Channels/ WhatsApp groups to strictly adhere to MCC guidelines

Port Blair, Apr. 17

The Office of the Returning Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency has received complaints regarding violation of Model Code of Conduct (MCC) guidelines by YouTube channels/ WhatsApp Groups since

the implementation of Model Code of Conduct from 16th March, 2024. Acting on the complaints, the Returning Officer, ANIPC has taken strict action and Show Cause Notices have been issued to Admins of the YouTube Channels/ WhatsApp Groups. The Returning

Officer, ANIPC has warned all the Youtubers/Admins of Social media groups to refrain from any violations of MCC guidelines during the election, and has further reiterated that strict action shall be initiated against anyone found violating the same, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

Whereas, the election schedule has been announced by the Election Commission of India, vide Press Note No. ECI/PN/23/2024 dated 16.03.2024 and No. ECI/PN/24/2024 dated 16.03.2024, which stipulates that the General Election of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency will be held in a single phase on 19.04.2024 (Friday).

Whereas, in the exercise of powers conferred under Section 25 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 read with MHA's Notification No.2/6/57-J dated 17.12.1957 and in pursuance of Section 135B of the Representation of People Act, 1951 read with letter No.78/EPS.2024 dated 16th March, 2024 of Election Commission of India, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands is pleased to declare a public holiday on the day of Poll i.e. 19.04.2024 (Friday) vide Notification No. E-231/25/2024-Accts.Sect-Election/AN/397 dated 01.04.2024 for all Public Offices, Local Bodies and Educational Institutions and a paid holiday for all Commercial Establishments/Undertakings in the UT of A&N Islands and also instructed the Secretary (Labour & Employment) to declare paid holiday on the day of poll i.e. 19.04.2024 (Friday) under the Factories Act, 1948 and the A&N Islands Shops & Establishments Regulation, 2004 read with the provisions laid down in Section 135-B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Whereas, Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that-

1. Every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at an election to the House of the People or the Legislative Assembly of a State shall, on the day of poll, be granted a holiday.

2. No deduction or abatement of the wages of any such person shall be made on account of a holiday having been granted in accordance with sub-section (1) and if such person is employed on the basis that she/he would not ordinarily receive wages for such a day, she/he would have drawn had not a holiday been granted to her/him on that day.

3. If an employer contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2), then such employers shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to five hundred rupees.

4. This section shall not apply to any elector whose absence may cause danger or substantial loss in respect of the employment in which he is engaged.

5. The daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on the poll day.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 135 B of the Representation of People Act, 1951 read with Notification No. E-231/25/2024-Accts.Sect-Election/AN/397 dated 01.04.2024, issued by the A&N Admn, it is hereby directed that all Business Establishments including Shops, Hotels, Restaurants, Resorts etc., Trade, Industrial Undertakings or any other Establishments which fall under the A&N Islands Shops & Establishments Regulation, 2004 and all Factories covered under the Factories Act, 1948 shall observe the day of poll i.e. the 19th April 2024 (Friday) as a paid holiday for their employees so as to enable them to exercise their franchise.
