All Party Meeting: Leaders across party line endorse actions taken against Pakistan post Pahalgam attack

New Delhi, Apr. 24

Leaders cutting across party lines have extended support to the actions taken by the Cabinet Committee on Security against Pakistan following Pahalgam terror attack. They also assured the Government of full support in the fight against terrorism and possible action taken by it during the All-Party Meeting convened by Government at the Parliament House complex in New Delhi today in view of the Pahalgam terror



attack. Talking to the media, Parliamentary Affairs Minister, Shri Kiren Rijiju said, all parties expressed their concern at the terror attack and extended

their support. He said, the Defence Minister informed about the incident that happened in Pahalgam and the actions taken by the Indian Government

in the CCS meeting. He said, the Government has also expressed its intention to take more stringent action. Shri Rijiju said the leaders were briefed about the

incident and Government action.

Minor girl rescued from West Bengal by PS Ograbraj in coordinated Police operation

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 24
In a commendable display of swift action and inter-state coordination, a 13-year-old minor girl, residing under PS Ograbraj jurisdiction, was successfully rescued from West Bengal by the Police Station Ograbraj with the assistance of the local police of West Bengal within few hours of reporting.

On 20th April, 2025, the girl was reported missing, following which a kidnapping case has been registered at PS Ograbraj. Upon investigation and analysis of technical evidence, her location was traced to Gopalnagar, West Bengal. Immediate official communication was

established with the In-charge, PS Gopalnagar, seeking urgent action. On 21st April, 2025, the minor girl was rescued by the Gopalnagar Police and produced her before Child Welfare Committee (CWC) from there to Shelter Home for protection.

Subsequently, on 22nd April, 2025, a team from PS Ograbraj, consisting of SI Agnes Bartholoma and HC/ Benjamin Toppo were deputed to West Bengal to facilitate the repatriation of the rescued girl. The minor girl was successfully brought back to Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 24th April, 2025 and produced before Child Welfare Committee, Sri

Vijaya Puram. This entire rescue and repatriation operation was carried out under the leadership of SI Devanand Pathak, SHO PS Ograbraj, under the command of Shri Brij Mohan Meena, SDPO Bambooflat and the overall supervision of Shri Manoj Kumar Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District.

The general public have been requested to remain vigilant and report any suspicious or illegal activities to the Police Control Room via 112, or 03192-232100. The identity of informants will be kept strictly confidential, a press release from SSP (SA) said.

Presently, 03 One Stop Centres (OSCs) are functioning in Junglighthat near AYUSH Hospital for South Andaman, at Zonal Library building at Mayabunder in North & Middle Andaman and at Perka Head Quarter in Nicobar. The distress women can reach OSC, South Andaman over phone 03192-234221. For OSC, North & Middle Andaman one can contact 03192-273009 and for OSC, Nicobar 03193-265141/ by self-visiting/through Anganwadi Workers/ relative, friends and public servant. Since the inception of One Stop Centres, various cases have been handled in these Centres.

Likewise, the Women and Child Control Room is functioning under the Directorate of Social Welfare at VIP Road in which dedicated helplines (Women Helpline-181 and Child Helpline-1098) functions as 24/7 hours emergency response center for women and children experiencing distress or violence.

The Women Helpline-181 and Child Helpline-1098 handles calls from Women and Children in danger, including those experiencing violence, in need of urgent help. The Helplines connect individuals with relevant resources like Police, One Stop Centres, Hospitals, District Legal Services Authority and other support services. Further, the Helplines provide information about available GoI schemes and program for women welfare and child protection.

Any women / children can dial these Helplines (Women Helpline-181 & Child Helpline-1098) to access the services during distress. In addition, women can approach concerned District One Stop Centre for redressal of their grievances and amicable settlement of minor issues within the family and other issues concerning women safety and security in urban, rural and tribal areas, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
