can help us move forward on an ecologically sustainable, ethically desirable and socially justifiable path. She stressed that we will have Do's to unlearn many misconceptions and relearn from the ideals of a For general population balanced lifestyle of the tribal society. We have to move forward with the spirit of climate justice.

The President said that the Industrial Revolution in the 18th and 19th centuries increased the demand for timber and other forest products. New rules, regulations and methods of forest use were adopted to cope with the demand. To implement such rules and regulations, the Imperial Forest Service, the predecessor service of the Indian Forest Service, was formed. The mandate of that service was not to protect the tribal society and forest wealth. Their mandate was to promote the objectives of the British Raj by exploiting India's forest resources to the maximum.

Referring to the mass hunting of wild animals during the British period, the President said that when she visits museums where animal skins or severed heads adorn the walls, she feels that those exhibits are telling the story of the decline of human civilization.

The President said that she was confident that the officers of the Indian Forest Service had become completely free from the colonial mentality and outlook of the former Imperial Forest Service. She stated that IFS officers not only have to conserve and augment India's natural resources but also use the traditional knowledge in the interest of humanity. They have to protect the forest wealth by synchronizing modernity and tradition and advancing the interests of the people whose life is based on forests. By doing this, they will be able to make a contribution that is truly inclusive and congenial to the environment.

The President said that the Indian Forest Service has given many officers to the country who have done unparalleled work for the environment. IFS Officers such as Shri P. Srinivas, Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh, Shri S. Manikandan have sacrificed their lives in the line of duty. She urged the Officer Trainees to make such Officers their role models and mentors and move forward on the ideals shown by them.

The President urged IFS Officers to spend time among the tribal people in the field and earn their affection and trust. She said that they should learn from the good practices of the tribal society. She also urged them to take ownership of their responsibilities and become a role model.

Life skill education awareness program ...

Dr. Nitin Shakya, Director (Social Welfare), emphasized the significance of life skills and advocated for the continuous implementation of such programs across all Child Care Institutions (CCIs). He stressed the importance of raising awareness among children and encouraged active participation in initiatives aimed at fostering positive impacts.

During the program, Smti Rehaneth Begum, Program Manager, State Child Protection Society (SCPS) highlighted the importance of Life Skill Education. She explained how acquiring such skills can profoundly impact an individual's overall development and success in life.

The program focused on several key areas viz. Communication: Teaching children how to express themselves effectively and listen actively. Problem Solving: Equipping them with skills to solve problems independently and Emotional Intelligence: Helping them understand and manage emotions etc.

Speaking on behalf of the CCI home, Shri P.K. Mohammed Ali, In-Charge expressed gratitude to the State Child Protection Society (SCPS) for organizing the event and emphasized the critical role of such programs in assisting children under the care and protection of CCIs to develop into independent individuals capable of leading fulfilling and productive lives, a press release from DSW said.

Public Health Advisory: Extreme Heat/Heat wave

Stay hydrated:

Drink sufficient water whenever possible, even if you are not thirsty.

Thirst is not a good indicator of dehydration. Carry drinking water when travelling.

- Use Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), and consume homemade drinks like lemon water, buttermilk/lassi, fruit juices with some added salt.
- Eat seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content like watermelon, musk melon, orange, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, lettuce or other locally available fruits and vegetables.

Stay covered:

- Wear thin loose, cotton garments preferably light coloured.
- Cover your head: use an umbrella, hat, cap, towel and other traditional head gears during exposure to direct sunlight.
- Wear shoes or chappals while going out in the sun.
- Stay alert: Listen to the Radio; watch TV; read the Newspaper for local weather news.
- Get the latest update on weather on India Meteorological Department (IMD) website at https://mausam.imd.gov.in.

Stay indoors/in the shade as much as possible:

- In well-ventilated and cool places.
- Block direct sunlight and heat waves: Keep windows and curtains closed during the day, especially on the sunny side of your house. Open them up at night to let cooler air in.
- If going outdoors, limit your outdoor activity to cooler times of the day i.e., morning and evening.
- Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.

On'ts

- Avoid getting out in the sun, especially between 12:00 noon and 03:00 pm.
- Avoid strenuous activities when outside in the afternoon.
- Do not go out barefoot.
- Avoid cooking during peak summer hours. Open doors and windows to ventilate the cooking area adequately.
- Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks or drinks with large amounts of sugar- as these actually, lead to loss of more body fluid or may cause stomach cramps.
- Avoid high-protein food and do not eat stale food.
- Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles. The temperature inside a vehicle could get dangerous. (Source: State Health Society, UTHM)






