The Department of CS&CA has extended the last date for doing e-KYC for FIC holders upto 31st March. However, it is noticed that despite repeated request and all possible effort, there are considerable number of beneficiaries who have not yet approached their Fair Price Shops or the Department of CS&CA and respective Supply Units functioning in the Inter Islands for updating their e-KYC. Hence, all those left out Ration Card beneficiaries (APL/ PHH & AAY) who have not yet updated their e-KYC due to whatsoever reason have been once again requested to contact

any of their nearest Fair Price Shops along with their Aadhaar numbers to get the e-KYC done for all the members listed in the Ration Card.

The Department has also constituted area wise teams for organizing Special Camps in close coordination with the elected representatives of the respective Gram Panchayats and Municipal Wards. The area wise team has already been published in the Daily Telegrams on

April 26, 2024.

The left out migrant labourers may also approach the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Port Blair and respective Supply Units of other Islands with valid document required for Ration Card.

However, since One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC) has been implemented in the UT, migrant labourers registered on e-Shram portal,

PS Crime & Economic Offence seizes huge cache of IMFL; one person arrested

Port Blair, Apr. 26

On the basis of an intelligence input, one autorickshaw driven by K. Anandan, 27, S/o Shri Karuppaiah, R/o Bengali Club, Aberdeen Bazaar was checked at Bimblitan junction by the team of PS Crime & Economic Offence comprising of Head Constables Sanjay Kujur & Sanjit Madhu and Constables N. Thangaraj & K.

Rajendran today. During the checking, 102 bottles of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) was recovered. He was possessing, this huge quantity of IMFL without any valid license or documents. The recovered IMFL & autorickshaw were seized on the spot followed by the arrest of K. Anandan after following due legal procedures. On this, a case has been registered under relevant sections at CID and investigation is under progress. The general public have been requested to inform about any credible information pertaining to any kind of illegal activity on telephone numbers- 100, 232586, 233307, 9434280100. Contraband ganja seized under NDPS Act at PS Rangat

Rangat, Apr. 26

Based on credible information received, a raiding team led by SI Madhab Halder, SHO, PS Rangat, conducted a raid in Dashratpur area. The team along with two independent witnesses which was supervised by Shri Rahul L. Nair, IPS, SDPO Rangat reached Dashratpur near the house of the suspect

and concealed themselves. Shortly after, the suspected individual was observed approaching from the main road having a bag in his hand and the raiding team swiftly intercepted him and conducted a search, resulting in the discovery of 860 grams of illicit ganja from Jagannath Sil, S/o late Aditya Sil, 35, R/o Dashratpur. Following a thorough interrogation, Jagannath Sil confessed to his crime. Subsequently, a notice under Section 41 (A) of Cr. PC was served to the accused, and a case was registered at PS Rangat under the NDPS Act, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.

Public Health Advisory: Extreme Heat/Heat wave

Do's

For general population

Stay hydrated:

Drink sufficient water whenever possible, even if you are not thirsty.

Thirst is not a good indicator of dehydration.

- ◆ Carry drinking water when travelling.
- ◆ Use Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), and consume homemade drinks like lemon water, buttermilk/lassi, fruit juices with some added salt.
- ◆ Eat seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content like watermelon, musk melon, orange, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, lettuce or other locally available fruits and vegetables.

Stay covered:

- ◆ Wear thin loose, cotton garments preferably light coloured.
- ◆ Cover your head: use an umbrella, hat, cap, towel and other traditional head gears during exposure to direct sunlight.
- ◆ Wear shoes or chappals while going out in the sun.

Stay alert:

- ◆ Listen to the Radio; watch TV; read the Newspaper for local weather news.
- ◆ Get the latest update on weather on India Meteorological Department (IMD) website at <https://mausam.imd.gov.in>.

Stay indoors/in the shade as much as possible:

- ◆ In well-ventilated and cool places.
- ◆ Block direct sunlight and heat waves: Keep windows and curtains closed during the day, especially on the sunny side of your house. Open them up at night to let cooler air in.

If going outdoors, limit your outdoor activity to cooler times of the day i.e., morning and evening.

Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.

Don'ts

Avoid getting out in the sun, especially between 12:00 noon and 03:00 pm.

Avoid strenuous activities when outside in the afternoon.

Do not go out barefoot.

Avoid cooking during peak summer hours. Open doors and windows to ventilate the cooking area adequately.

Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks or drinks with large amounts of sugar- as these actually, lead to loss of more body fluid or may cause stomach cramps.

Avoid high-protein food and do not eat stale food.

Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles. The temperature inside a vehicle could get dangerous. (Source: State Health Society, UTHM)

Zero malaria can be achieved by active community participation in the Malaria Control Programme. He also thanked community for participation in reducing the incidence of malaria in A&N Islands.

Earlier, the District Malaria Officer, NVBDCP Unit, Shri Madhu Prakash welcomed the gathering. The programme concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Shri Polycarb, PGT, GSSS Haddo, Port Blair, a press release from DHS said.

Medium Range Weather Forecast:
(27th April to 1st May, 2024)

Port Blair, Apr. 26

The forecast for the next five days in the South Andaman, North and Middle Andaman indicates generally cloudy weather and 1.0 mm of rainfall is expected during the period whereas in Nicobar Islands cloudy weather is likely to occur and 24 mm of rainfall is expected. The maximum temperature is projected to range between 33.0 and 34.0 degrees Celsius, while the minimum temperature is expected to be within the range of 25.0 to 27.0 degrees Celsius. Additionally, the forecast suggests that the maximum relative humidity will fall between 71 % and 78 %, and the minimum relative humidity will be in the range of 65 % to 69 % in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speeds are expected to range from 4.0 to 15.0 kmph, predominantly from the North Westerly direction.

Weather based agro advisories

For South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman

⇒ Remove shoot borer affected terminals shoots in brinjal and install pheromone trap @ 12/ ha at flowering stages.
⇒ Provide mulching and irrigation in vegetables during evening hours.
⇒ Prune away severely infested portion of plant to manage white fly in vegetables and do water spray below the leaves to wash off whiteflies.
⇒ Slug caterpillar attack is observed in various patches of coconut garden in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and advice to use light traps and removal and burning of slug caterpillar infested leaves in highly recommended for coconut.
⇒ Provide artificial shed to avoid heat shock to fishes.
⇒ Reduce feeding rate to prevent water quality degradation in pond.
⇒ Provide aeration facility in case of high stocking of fish in

ponds.

⇒ Provide plenty of drinking water with homemade butter milk to all livestock/ poultry to reduce mortality due to heat stress.

For Nicobar

⇒ Managing shoot borers in brinjal (eggplant) can be crucial for maintaining plant health and maximizing yield. Install pheromone trap @ 12/ ha at flowering stages.
⇒ Spray water below the leaves to wash off whiteflies and pruning severely infested portions of plants is one of several strategies to manage whiteflies effectively.
⇒ Slug caterpillar attack is observed in various patches of coconut garden in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and advice to use light traps and removal and burning of slug caterpillar infested leaves in highly recommended for coconut.
⇒ Deworm all the goats and pig before pre monsoon shower and avoid incase of pregnant animals.

A&N Police issues public advisory on how fraudsters using armed forces personnel details to perpetrate financial cyber frauds

Port Blair, Apr.26

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters impersonate Indian army personnel to exploit the goodwill associated with the armed forces to siphon off money from innocent victims who have advertised to put their property (House, Flat, Rooms, etc. on rent) on the popular house renting websites/apps, real estate database website or social media websites, etc.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens.

→ Always remember that entering OTP is a requirement for sending money, not for receiving it.

→ If an unknown person makes contact for renting your house, flat, or rooms,



etc., try to confirm his/her identity from other available methods/sources.

→ Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize, if a request seems too urgent.

→ Avoid relying on conversations and identity details provided by unknown people on messaging apps, house renting platforms, etc.

→ Scrutinize every transaction request made to you from people unknown to you.

→ Captiously perform transactions on various online transaction platforms, aware yourself with all the features a payment gateway.

Precautionary measures during Tsunami

Port Blair, Apr. 26

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public of A&N Islands to follow the Do's & Don'ts of Tsunami, if it occurs.

DO's:
► Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.
► Move to higher ground: If a

tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.

► Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.

► Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.

► Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

DON'Ts:
► Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.
► Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from

the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.

► Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.

► Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.

► Don't return to the area until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

CBDT extends due date for filing Form 10A/10AB upto 30th June, 2024

New Delhi, Apr. 26 (PIB)

The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT), has issued Circular No.---07/2024 dated 25.04.2024 further extending the due date for filing Form 10A/ Form 10AB under the Income-tax Act, 1961 (the 'Act') upto 30th June, 2024. CBDT had earlier extended the due date for filing Form 10A/ Form 10AB by trusts, institutions and funds multiple times to mitigate genuine hardships of the taxpayers. The last such extension was made by Circular No. 06/2023 extended the date to 30.09.2023.

Considering the representations received by CBDT requesting for further extension of due

date for filing of such

The Central Board of Forms beyond the last extended date of 30.09.2023, and with a view to avoid genuine hardships to taxpayers, CBDT has extended the due date of filing Form 10A/ Form 10AB upto 30th June, 2024, in respect of certain provisions of section 10(23C)/ section 12A/ section 80G/ and section 35 of the Act.

CBDT further clarifies that, if any such existing trust, institution or fund had failed to file Form 10A for AY 2022-23 within the extended due date, and subsequently, applied for provisional registration as a new entity and received Form 10AC, can also now avail this opportunity to surrender the said Form

10AC and apply for registration for AY 2022-23 as an existing trust, institution or fund, in Form 10A till 30th June 2024.

It is also clarified that those trusts, institutions or funds whose applications for re-registration were rejected solely on the grounds of late filing or filing under wrong section code, may also submit fresh application in Form 10AB within the aforesaid extended deadline of 30th June, 2024.

The applications as per Form 10A/ Form 10AB shall be filed electronically through the e-filing portal of Income Tax Department. The Circular No. 07/2024 is available on www.incometaxindia.gov.in.
