VP addresses third convocation of National Sanskrit University in Tirupati

Sanskrit is the language of divinity and serves as a sacred bridge in our pursuit of spirituality: Vice President

New Delhi, Apr. 28 (PIB)

The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar said that Sanskrit is the language of divinity and serves as a sacred bridge in our pursuit of spirituality and the quest to connect with the divine. Addressing the third convocation of National Sanskrit University in Tirupati on April 26, he described Sanskrit as a cultural anchor for human civilization in a storm emphasizing that "In today's whirlwind, Sanskrit offers a unique solace: intellectual rigor, spiritual serenity, and a deeper connection to oneself and the world."

Stressing the role of institutions like National Sanskrit University in revival and propagation of Indic knowledge systems, VP called for developing innovative curricula and fostering



interdisciplinary research, so that the gap between Sanskrit's rich heritage and modern academic needs can be bridged. "Let Sanskrit's sacred language not only connect us to the divine, but also illuminate the path towards a more holistic understanding of the world," he added. Shri Dhankhar also expressed the need for increased usage of digital technologies in preservation of precious ancient manuscripts.

Describing Sanskrit as the treasure house of our cultural heritage, the Vice President called its preservation and promotion as a national priority and duty. He also wanted Sanskrit to be developed according to present day needs and its learning made easy. Noting that any language

survives only when it used by the society and literature is composed in it, VP expressed the need to increase Sanskrit usage in our daily lives.

Referring to the rich and diverse literary corpus of Sanskrit encompassing not just religious and philosophical texts but also secular works on medicine, drama, music, and science, Shri Dhankhar highlighted that despite this breadth, Sanskrit's integration into mainstream education remains limited, often hindered by a lingering colonialist mindset that dismisses Indian knowledge systems.

Stating that studying Sanskrit is not merely an academic pursuit, VP

Left out Ration Card beneficiaries urged to get e-KYC done for all members before May 15

The Department of CS&CA has extended the last date for doing e-KYC for FIC holders upto 31st March. However, it is noticed that despite repeated request and all possible effort, there are considerable number of beneficiaries who have not yet approached their Fair Price Shops or the Department of CS&CA and respective Supply Units functioning in the Inter Islands for updating their e-KYC.

Hence, all those left out Ration Card beneficiaries (APL/ PHH & AAY) who have not yet updated their e-KYC due to whatsoever reason

have been once again requested to contact any of their nearest Fair Price Shops along with their Aadhaar numbers to get the e-KYC done for all the members listed in the Ration Card.

The Ration Card beneficiaries can also approach the Directorate of CS&CA, Port Blair at Room No. 20 or their respective Supply Units for updating their e-KYC before 15.05.2024 without fail. The list of left out beneficiaries has been made available in their respective Fair Price Shops for information.

Further, it is also reported that some of the beneficiaries are not able to update

their e-KYC as the device is unable to read their finger prints due to old age, or any other reason. Hence, they have been requested to get their Aadhaar biometric updated at the Aadhaar Enrolment Center in Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Port Blair or any Aadhaar Enrolment Center in their respective Tehsils considering this as the final opportunity to update their e-KYC of their respective Ration Cards. A&N Police issues public advisory on fake stock market investment website/apps

Port Blair, Apr. 28

Sponsored Advertisements featuring deep fake videos and images of prominent individuals are currently being disseminated across platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and Google which are redirecting users to fraudulent WhatsApp/Telegram groups operated by cyber fraudsters, falsely presented as legitimate trading groups, investment advice platforms, or financial advisors. Within these groups, cyber fraudsters disseminate information regarding Stock Market, Stock Tips, Live Classes, and lure citizens to open Institutional Accounts with them to gain maximum profit through confirm Initial Public Offering (IPO) allotments. Cyber criminals share Play store / Appstore links or apk files of fake applications with potential victims for trading purposes.



Indian mule bank accounts are given to potential victims for depositing money, initial payouts are made to gain trust, and after a significant amount is deposited, fraudsters stop communication and the citizens become victim of cyber financial fraud. In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens against Fake Stock Market Investment: ♦ Be extremely cautious of sponsored ads on Facebook, Instagram, or Google promoting investment groups on WhatsApp or Telegram, as these may be fraudulent. ♦ Be alert to

impersonation by fraudsters as FIIs/FPOs, financial advisors, or reputable institutions. ♦ Avoid sharing sensitive financial information like bank details or login credentials with unknown entities. ♦ Stay aware of common investment scams and remain sceptical of offers that seem too good to be true like promising unrealistically high returns. A&N Police issues advisories on fraudsters sending fake job offer SMSs to perpetrate cyber crime

Port Blair, April 28

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters send Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime. Fraudsters place online advertisements claiming that they can give jobs where one can make large amount of money working from home with little time and effort. A job scam occurs when a fraudster poses as an employer or recruiter, and offers attractive employment opportunities, which require job seekers to pay some money in advance. The SMSs

sent by fraudsters offer high-paying part-time jobs to siphon off victims' money and their personal information. In this regard, the Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens: ♦ Avoid tempting job offers sent via text messages or emails by unknown senders. ♦ Scrutinize the job offering company online (use words like "scam," "fraud," or "complaint" with company name to online search and verify if similar scams are happening). ♦ Avoid making any

payment without authenticating the employer for registration or other purposes. ♦ Securitize the SMS-Headers to confirm the authenticity of a job offer. ♦ Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Long range Forecast of rainfall for the 2024 South West monsoon season released by IMD

"Country as a whole most likely to receive above normal rainfall during the Southwest Monsoon season": Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences

New Delhi, Apr. 28 (PIB)

Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Dr M. Ravichandran told the media recently that the country as a whole is likely to receive above normal rainfall during the south west monsoon from June to September 2024. Briefing the media about the summary of the 2024 Southwest Monsoon Season Rainfall in a press conference held at National Media Centre, New Delhi, he said there will be 106% of the Long Period Average (LPA) with a model error of $\pm 5\%$. The LPA of the season rainfall over the country as a whole is 87 cm based on data of 1971-2020.

Dr. Ravichandran said, the forecast is based on both dynamical and statistical models, and it suggests above normal rainfall is likely over most part of the country except some areas of Northwest, East and Northeast India, where below normal rainfall is likely. He told that the expected La Nina, positive IOD and below normal snow cover over northern hemisphere would be favourable for rainfall during southwest monsoon season 2024.

Giving a detailed presentation DG, IMD, Dr Mrutyunjay Mohapatra said that currently, moderate El Niño conditions are prevailing over the equatorial Pacific region and the Climate model forecasts indicate neutral condition by the beginning of monsoon season and La Niña conditions during second half of monsoon season. He also informed the media that at present neutral Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) conditions are prevailing and Climate model forecast indicate positive IOD conditions likely to develop during the monsoon season. He added that since Sea Surface temperature conditions over the pacific and the Indian Ocean are known to have a strong influence on the Indian Monsoon, IMD is carefully monitoring the evolution of sea surface conditions over these ocean basins.

Dr Mohapatra further said that Northern hemisphere snow cover extent during the last three months (January to March 2024) was below normal which indicates above rainfall this monsoon season. Winter and spring snow cover extent over Northern Hemisphere as well as Eurasia has a generally inverse relationship with the subsequent monsoon season rainfall. He said, IMD will

issue the updated forecasts for monsoon season rainfall in the last week of May 2024.

Probability forecasts for the Seasonal (Jun to Sep, 2024) rainfall over country as a whole is given below in table:

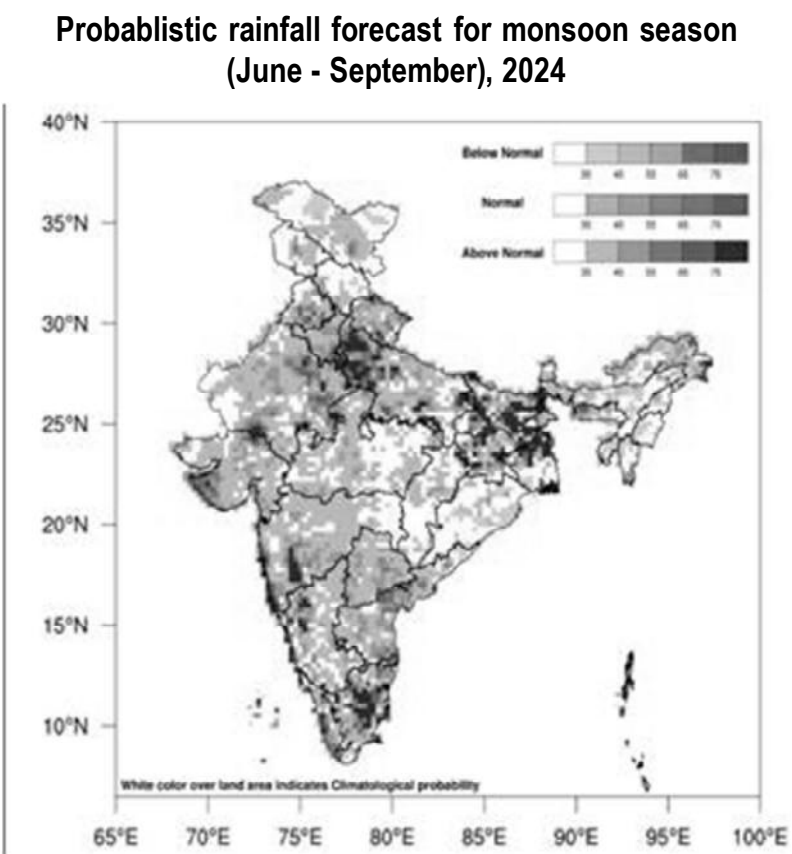


Fig.1.Probability forecast of tercile categories* (below normal, normal, and above normal) for the seasonal rainfall over India during monsoon season (June -September), 2024.

Since 2003, India and the second stage or Meteorological update forecast is issued by the end of May. Since 2021, IMD has been issuing the operational long-range forecast (LRF) for the southwest monsoon seasonal (June-September) rainfall averaged over the country as a whole in two stages. The first stage forecast is issued in April

The new strategy uses both dynamical and statistical forecasting system. Multi-Model Ensemble (MME) forecasting system based on coupled global climate models (CGCMs) from different global climate prediction centres, including IMD's Monsoon Mission Climate Forecast System (MMCFS) is used in dynamical forecast system.

In continuation to the above forecasts, monthly rainfall forecast is issued around the end of June, July and August respectively for the subsequent one month. In addition, quantitative and probabilistic forecasts for the country as a whole and spatial distribution of probabilistic forecasts of rainfall for second half (August-September) of the season is issued around end of July along with forecast for August.

Summary of the Forecast of Rainfall during Southwest Monsoon Season, 2024 is as follows:

- > The rainfall over the country as a whole during monsoon season (June to September) is very likely to be above normal (>106% of the Long Period Average (LPA)).
- > Quantitatively, the seasonal rainfall over the country as a whole is likely to be 106% of LPA with a model error of $\pm 5\%$.
- > The LPA of the season rainfall over the country as a whole is 87 cm based on data of 1971-2020.
- > Currently, moderate El Niño conditions are prevailing over the equatorial Pacific region. Climate model forecasts indicate neutral condition by the beginning of monsoon season and La Niña conditions during second half of monsoon season.
- > Currently, neutral Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) conditions are prevailing. Climate model forecasts indicate positive IOD conditions likely to develop during the monsoon season.
- > Northern hemisphere snow cover extent during the last three months (January to March 2024) was below normal. Winter and spring snow cover extent over Northern Hemisphere as well as Eurasia has a generally inverse relationship with the subsequent monsoon season rainfall.
- > IMD will issue the updated forecasts for monsoon season rainfall in the last week of May 2024.
