## Promoting entrepreneurship through Stand-Up India Scheme in A&N Islands

### Loan amounting to Rs. 77.60 crores disbursed to 372 beneficiaries for setting up own ventures

Port Blair, Aug. 4

The Stand up India Scheme aims at promoting entrepreneurship among women and Scheduled Castes and Tribes. The Scheme is implemented by Department of Financial Services (DFS), Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Stand-Up India Scheme facilitates bank loans between Rs. 10 lakh and Rs 1 Crore to at least one Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) borrower and at least

one woman borrower per bank branch for setting up a greenfield enterprise. This enterprise may be in manufacturing, services or the trading sector. In case of non-individual enterprises at least 51% of the shareholding and controlling stake should be held either by an SC/ST or woman entrepreneur. SC/ST or woman entrepreneurs, above 18 years of age, can avail loans under the scheme only for greenfield project. Here, greenfield signifies first

time venture of the beneficiary in manufacturing or services or trading sector. In case of non-individual enterprises, 51% of the shareholding and controlling stake should be held either by SC/ST or women entrepreneur and borrower should not be in default to any bank/financial institution. As per the data received from Lead Bank Port Blair, in A&N Islands, altogether 372 beneficiaries have availed loan under the Stand-Up India Scheme and an amount

of Rs. 77.60 crores (upto June, 2024) have been disbursed to the applicants for setting up their own ventures since the inception of the scheme. Out of the 372 beneficiaries, 287 Stand Up India entrepreneur are through SBI Bank which has disbursed 56.38 crores. Altogether, 330 women entrepreneurs have been disbursed loan amounting to Rs. 67.54 crores. Composite loan (inclusive of term loan and working capital) between 10 lakh and

upto 100 lakh is provided for setting up a new enterprise in manufacturing, trading or services sector by SC/ST/Women entrepreneur. The loan is repayable in 7 years with a maximum moratorium period of 18 months. The Scheme, which covers all branches of Scheduled Commercial Banks is accessible either directly at the branch or through Stand-Up India portal [www.standupmitra.in](http://www.standupmitra.in) or through the Lead District Manager (LDM).

PS Billiground cracks theft case

Billiground, Aug.4

A complaint of theft of gold ornaments and cash was reported at PS Billiground on July 30, 2024 while the complainant and their family were away in Rangat. Acting promptly on the complaint, a case of theft under relevant sections of BNS was registered at PS Billiground.

Under the leadership of SI MV Shiju Kumar, SHO, PS Billiground, a dedicated team was constituted including ASI Muthu, HC P.K. Kindo, and PCs Charles, Mustafa, and Durga Rao. The team immediately began collecting intelligence at the scene of the theft. They conducted an extensive search for the culprit, alerted informers and gathered intelligence.

Based on the information gathered, a suspect was

identified. Swift technical surveillance was conducted to track the suspect's whereabouts at the time of the incident. The team later apprehended the suspect, who confessed to the crime during interrogation. As a result of the team's diligent efforts, within 24 hours of the report, the stolen property was successfully recovered from the accused namely Saurab Saha, S/o Ashutosh Saha, 23 yrs, Private Worker, R/o Hari Nagar.




