Govt. finalising DPR of Rs 41,000 crore transshipment port at Great Nicobar Island

The detailed project report (DPR) of a Rs 41,000-crore international transshipment port project at Great Nicobar Island in the Bay of Bengal is being finalised by the Government, and it will go ahead with the implementation of the project in the next few months, a senior official said on Sunday. Great Nicobar Transshipment port project has been under scrutiny over environmental concerns.

"The project has received the environmental clearances and nod from National Green Tribunal (NGT) and now there is no hurdle in its implementation.

"The DPR of the project is also finalised and we are going ahead for its further implementation in the next few months," Ports, Shipping and Waterways secretary T K Ramachandran told PTI in an interview.

Last year, the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways in a statement had said the project is expected to be completed with an investment of Rs 41,000 crore (USD 5 billion), including investments from both government and public-private partnership (PPP) concessionaires.

"11 players have submitted expressions of interest for the international transshipment port project at Great Nicobar



Island," the ministry added.

Larsen and Toubro Ltd, Afcons Infrastructure Ltd, and JSW Infrastructure Ltd are among the companies that have submitted EoIs for the international transshipment port project.

The proposed port in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands will have the ultimate capacity to handle 16 million containers per year, and in the first phase, to be commissioned by 2028 at a cost of Rs 18,000 crore, it will handle more than 4 million containers.

Other projects planned around the transshipment port include an airport, a township and a power plant.

The project is located



on the international trade route, with existing transshipment terminals like Singapore, Klang and Colombo in proximity.

The project focuses on three key drivers, which can result in making it a leading container transshipment port -- strategic location in terms of proximity (40 nautical miles) with the international shipping

trade route, availability of natural water depth of over 20m and carrying capacity of transshipment cargo from all the ports in the proximity, including Indian ports.

The proposed facility is envisaged to be developed in four phases.

The estimated cost for Phase 1 of the proposed transshipment port is around Rs 18,000 crore, which includes the construction of breakwaters, dredging, reclamation, berths, storage areas, building and utilities, procurement and installation of equipment and development of the port colony, with core infrastructure going to be developed with the government support.

Public-private partnership (PPP) will be encouraged for this project via landlord mode. The PPP concessionaire will have the flexibility to develop a storage area, container handling equipment and other infrastructure based on the concessionaire's own market and business assessment, subject to the minimum guaranteed traffic.

The concessionaire would be awarded a long-term PPP concession of 30 to 50 years (based on requirement), will be responsible for the provision(s) of port services and shall have the rights to levy, collect and retain charges from port users.

Currently, nearly 75 per cent of India's transhipped cargo is handled at ports outside India.

Colombo, Singapore and Klang handle more than 85 per cent of this cargo, with more than half of it handled at Colombo port. **(This news article was published in 'The Economic Times' on Aug. 4, 2024).**

The MP also informed that he has taken up with the concerned Ministry about further improving the Health Care facilities in ANIIMS for the betterment of the Islanders.

In a dedicated effort to eradicate the inhumane practice of Manual Scavenging and to ensure proper sanitation facilities, the Port Blair Municipal Council is set to conduct a fresh comprehensive survey of Manual Scavengers and Insanitary Latrines from Aug. 6 to 10, 2024. This initiative is in strict compliance with the provisions of the Prevention of the Employment of Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation (PEMSR) Act-2013, MS Rules-2013, guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MoSJE) and the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation (PEMSR) Act, 2013 prohibits manual scavenging, hazardous cleaning of sewers and septic tanks and identification of insanitary latrines and demolish the same/convert it into Sanitary Latrines. This Act also aims the Survey of Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation.

PBMC to conduct fresh survey for identification of Manual...

According to the Act, if anyone employs a Manual Scavenger or construct an insanitary latrine, shall be penalized with imprisonment of up to one year or a fine up to Rs. 50,000/- or both.

As per Section 2(1)(g) of the PEMSR Act-2013; 'Manual Scavenger' means a person engaged or employed, at the commencement of this Act or at any time thereafter, by an individual or a local authority or an agency or a contractor, for manually cleaning, carrying, disposing of, or otherwise handling in any manner, human excreta in an unsanitary latrine or in an open drain or pit into which human excreta from the insanitary latrine is disposed of, or on a railway track or in such other spaces or premises, as the Central Government or a State Government may notify, before the excreta fully decomposing in such manner as may be prescribed and the expression 'Manual Scavenging' shall be constructed accordingly. It is relevant that the person engaged or employed (regular/contract) to clean excreta with the help of such devices and using such protective gear, as the Central Government may notify in this behalf, shall not be deemed to be a 'Manual Scavenger'.

As per Section 2(1)(g) of the PEMSR Act-2013; 'Insanitary Latrine' means a latrine which requires human excreta to be cleaned or otherwise handled manually, either in sue, or in an open drain or pit into which the excreta is discharged or flushed out, before the excreta fully decomposes in such manner as may be prescribed.

This survey will be carried out in all 24 Wards of the PBMC jurisdiction w.e.f Aug. 6 to 10, 2024. The Surveyors and Validators are being appointed to carry out the survey on the subsequent directions of the District Magistrate, South Andaman (Chairman, District Level Survey Committee, South Andaman District). The primary objective of this survey is to identify and enumerate individuals who are currently engaged in the practice of Manual Scavenging. Additionally, the survey also aims to identify all Insanitary Latrines that are still in existence within the Municipal area, if any. Following the identification of the Manual Scavengers, the A&N Administration will implement a comprehensive rehabilitation plan under the guidance of Central Government. This includes providing alternative employment opportunities, financial assistance, access to skill development programs and other benefits under the relevant rules and directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Further, as per the guidelines received from the MoS&E; the Municipal Council has invited all stakeholders, including individuals, Safaikarmachari Associations/Unions, NGOs, Community leaders, Social Workers and citizens to actively participate in this initiative. PBMC also encourages the stakeholders to report any kind of Manual Scavengers or Insanitary Latrines practice in the Port Blair City. Such information is vital for ensuring a thorough and accurate survey. PBMC also urges all residents and stakeholders to support the survey.

Further, PBMC has also invited Manual Scavengers, if any to declare themselves during the survey or at self-declaration center and have their details verified. Any person working as a manual scavenger may self-declare either during the survey to be undertaken by the local authority, or any time thereafter (before notification of final list), apply to the Sanitary Officer, PBMC for being identified as a manual scavenger in the prescribed proforma. There shall be no minimum age limit for identification of manual scavenger, and there shall be no restriction regarding the caste or religion or income or gender for being identified as manual scavenger. For the purposes, a person should have been engaged or employed as manual scavenger at the commencement of the Act or thereafter and should have worked continuously for not less than three months.

The PBMC is unwavering in its commitment to safeguarding the dignity and rights of every individual. The elimination of Manual Scavenging and Insanitary Latrine is a moral imperative and legal obligation. This survey is a crucial step towards eliminating the degrading practice of manual scavengers and ensuring a cleaner and safer environment for the community.
