## Andaman to get 5 luxury eco-tourism resorts including one at uninhabited Aves Island

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 31

The Andaman and Nicobar administration has decided to build five-star resorts at five locations, including the uninhabited Aves Island, which will be opened for tourism for the first time, officials said on Wednesday.

The eco-tourism properties will come up at Shaheed Dweep, Megapode Resort in Sri Vijaya Puram, and Aves Island, Long Island and Smith Island in North and Middle Andaman, they said.

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Limited (ANIIDCO) has invited bids for developing the resorts on a public-private partnership (PPP) basis on a design,

build, finance, operate and transfer mode, they added.

The pre-bid meeting will be held on August 14, while the bidding will take place on September 15, officials said.

It is for the first time that the Aves Island will be opened for tourism. It is known for the acres of coconut plantation.

After the resort comes up, the administration believes that Aves Island will become the most sought-after destination in the Andamans after Swaraj Dweep.

It is close to the Mayabunder town and has live and dead coral flat beds along with a 2-km

coastline, making it an ideal destination for campers, officials said.

A trek through the picturesque coconut plantations will take one to the lighthouse on the southern tip of the island, they said, revealing the plans being prepared to develop the destination.

A land parcel of 2.75 hectare is owned by the administration, which will be handed over to ANIIDCO on lease for the development of the project, they said.

The property will involve an investment of nearly Rs 36 crore, and will have 50 rooms, officials said.

Various facilities, such as a shopping arena and

a wellness centre, and recreational activities like scuba diving, fishing, trekking and camping will be available, they said.

The proposed resort at Lalaji Bay in Long Island would cost about Rs 391 Cr and have 220 rooms. The one at Smith Island would be set up at a cost of Rs 60 crore and have 70 rooms, while the property at Shaheed Dweep will be developed at Rs 172 crore and have 120 rooms.

The objective of the projects is to build a world-class and sustainable tourism infrastructure with low environmental impact, officials said. (Source: The news story was published in THE WEEK based on inputs from PTI)

## Hon'ble MP meets Hon'ble Finance Minister; Requests enhanced capital allocation and Special Grant of Rs. 5,000 Cr for A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 31

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, met the Hon'ble Finance Minister, Govt. of India, Ms Nirmala Sitharaman at New Delhi on 28<sup>th</sup> July and submitted a detailed letter addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Hon'ble Home Minister, Hon'ble Finance Minister with a copy endorsed to Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and Commissioners/Secretaries of A&N Administration. The MP has strongly urged the Central Government to considerably enhance the capital expenditure allocation under the Revised Estimates (RE) 2025-26 and Budget Estimates (BE) 2026-27 and subsequent budget allocation for 05 years along with a special grant of Rs. 5,000 crore for the Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

During the meeting, the MP highlighted the urgent need for strengthening basic infrastructure in the Islands, including rural roads, water supply systems, bridges, culverts, high drains, erosion control measures, and main public utilities



including hospitals, education infrastructure, Tribal Welfare etc. The current year's capital allocation of just Rs. 555 crore out of a total Rs. 6,267 crore budget is inadequate to address the needs of 40 Departments across the Islands, with only about Rs. 70 crore available to APWD for new construction.

Hon'ble MP pointed out that in many backward and tribal areas, especially in North & Middle Andaman,

settlements established over 50-60 years ago needs better road connectivity.

The MP further noted that important infrastructure funds and special grants, such as the Rs. 279 crore sanctioned in 2018 by the Hon'ble PM, remained underutilized due to lack of capacity and expertise of local bodies. MP urged for conducting timely District Planning Committee meeting, which he said, plays a key role

The last date for nominations/recommendations for Padma Awards has been extended from 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. The nominations/recommendations for Padma Awards will only be received online on the Rashtriya Puraskar Portal (<https://awards.gov.in>). Nominations/recommendations for the Padma Awards-2026 to be announced on the occasion of Republic Day, 2026 started on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2025.

The Padma Awards, namely, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri, are amongst the highest civilian awards of the country. Instituted in 1954, these Awards are announced on the occasion of the Republic Day every year. The Award seeks to recognize 'work of distinction' and is given for distinguished and exceptional achievements/service in all fields/disciplines, such as Art, Literature and Education, Sports, Medicine, Social Work, Science and Engineering, Public Affairs, Civil Service, Trade and Industry etc. All persons without distinction of race, occupation, position or sex are eligible for these Awards. Government servants including those working with PSUs, except Doctors and Scientists, are not eligible for Padma Awards.

The Government is committed to transform Padma Awards into "People's Padma". All citizens are, therefore, requested to make nominations/recommendations, including self-nomination. Concerted efforts may be made to identify talented persons whose excellence and achievements really deserve to be recognized from amongst women, weaker sections of the society, SCs & STs, divyang persons and who are doing selfless service to the society.

The nominations/recommendations should contain all relevant details

specified in the format available on the above said Portal, including a citation in narrative form (maximum 800 words), clearly bringing out the distinguished and exceptional achievements/service of the person recommended in her/his respective field/discipline.

## Training on biomedical waste handling conducted at Veterinary Units in Isles

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 31

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services (AH&VS), A&N Administration, conducted hands-on training sessions on biomedical waste handling, segregation, and collection to ensure compliance with safe disposal protocols and enhance biosecurity in Veterinary Units. The initiative aimed to promote responsible waste management practices among staff.

The first training session was held on July 16 at the Veterinary Hospital, Junglight, followed by a second session on July 30 and 31 at the Livestock Farm Complex, Dollygunj Farm. Sanitary workers, compounders, and the Senior Veterinary Officer participated, receiving comprehensive orientation on safe practices for managing biomedical waste in accordance with the Biomedical Waste

Management Rules, 2016.

The sessions emphasized proper segregation of biomedical waste categories, use of color-coded containers, safe collection methods, and the importance of maintaining hygiene to prevent cross-contamination and environmental hazards. Participants were trained to handle waste generated from veterinary activities,

enhance market potential and increase the demand for spices in the local market. For cinnamon bark extraction, ICAR-CIARI has developed a specialized extraction tool called CinnRub, which will be highly beneficial for farmers. This initiative by CIARI is truly commendable and praise worthy. In these Islands, the cultivation of clove and vanilla can also be successfully carried out, yielding good returns. By introducing cinnamon as an intercrop in coconut plantations, farmers can significantly enhance their income. There is also a need to engage Self Help Group (SHG) members in this initiative to strengthen the value chain and ensure its sustainable growth.



Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Agri), Ms. Chanchal Yadav, IAS, and Dr. Sachin Shinde, IAS, Commissioner-cum-Secretary shared their thoughts on the occasion, highlighting the importance of the initiative. During the programme, a ceremonial distribution of cinnamon and other spice saplings was carried out for the farmers, marking the formal launch of the SPICE PRAVAH campaign. A live demonstration of cinnamon bark extraction was also organized during the programme for the benefit of the farmers.

Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary (Agriculture), briefed about the SPICE PRAVAH initiative, highlighting its objectives, implementation strategy, and the expected impact on spice cultivation and farmers' livelihoods in the Islands. Secretary (Agriculture) informed that with the powerful tagline 'Sugandh Vrikshon ki PravaH -Advancement through Spice cultivation', the initiative aims to promote the sustainable cultivation, value addition, and market integration of tree-based spices such as cinnamon, nutmeg, and black pepper. The programme is designed to transform the spice cultivation scenario of the Islands through a holistic approach involving area expansion, farmer capacity building, and product-based development. The Secretary (Agri) urged all farmers and community members to actively participate in the SPICE PRAVAH movement. This is not just a plantation drive, but a nation-building mission aimed at making India self-reliant in spice production and marketing.

As part of the launch activities, a massive spice plantation drive was held today at multiple identified locations across the Islands. In the first round, an area of 40 hectares of farmers' fields was brought under spice cultivation with the distribution and planting of 78,160 saplings. The second round of the plantation drive, targeting 25 hectares in departmental farms with 47,400 saplings, is scheduled to commence within the next three months.

The campaign has commenced simultaneously in eight zones across the Union Territory from 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025. Parallel plantation events were also organized in various districts and sub-divisions under the leadership of the respective Deputy Commissioners and Assistant Commissioners, ensuring extensive reach and community involvement. The Future Interventions under SPICE PRAVAH is to establishment of 8 Spice Collection Centres across 8 Agricultural Zones to support processing and value-added product development, provision of training and technical support to farmers. A dedicated core team has already undergone a 5-day intensive training at the Indian Institute of Spices Research (IISR), Kozhikode. Focus on branding, GI tagging, and developing a robust marketing network to help Island-grown spices gain recognition in international markets.

A live demonstration of Cinnamon Extraction was also organized as part of today's event to showcase value addition techniques, development of Integrated Nurseries and Demo Farms to provide farmers with access to modern technologies and high-quality planting material.

Earlier, the Director of Agriculture, Ms. Priyanka Kumari welcomed the gathering and expressed gratitude for their presence and support for the SPICE PRAVAH initiative. The launch programme was also attended by Panchayat Pradhans of the South Andaman zone along with several PRI members. Around 60 progressive farmers participated in the event.

Apart from the State-level function, ceremonial launch programmes were also held across eight different zones.

At South Andaman, the ceremonial planting was done by Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman and Smti. in enhancing participatory planning by enabling meaningful input from local stakeholders.

He also highlighted in the letter and personally apprised the Hon'ble Finance Minister that, as of now, the total length of all types of roads under various agencies in the A&N Islands is approximately 2,500 km, out of which nearly 1,300 km are not in good condition and needs repair and maintenance. This includes both repair and new construction of pucca roads from existing earthen roads under agencies such as APWD, PRIs, and the Municipal Council. He emphasized that it is impossible to meet the expenditure for repairing and upgrading these roads within the existing capital budget, and therefore, a special grant along with an enhanced budget allocation for 05 years is urgently required. The main demands raised by the MP include:

- The A&N Administration may be asked to prepare a comprehensive and need-based proposal under the Capital Head in the RE 2025-2026 and BE 2026-2027 to address urgent infrastructure gaps.
- Provide enhanced capital funding for the next 5 years treating A&N Islands as a special case due to its remoteness, strategic importance, and developmental backlog.
- Special Grant of Rs. 5,000 Crore for essential infrastructure including rural and urban roads, dams, water pipelines, erosion control, renovation of tsunami shelters, drainage systems, health, education, agriculture, fisheries, animal husbandry, power supply, and shipping infrastructure.
- Depute a multidisciplinary central expert team from the Government of India to A&N Islands to assess infrastructure needs, consult local stakeholders, and prepare a comprehensive action plan.

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray emphasized that this support is essential to bridge the developmental gap, uplift rural and tribal populations, and build modern, resilient infrastructure in this strategically important Union Territory.

He expressed hope that the Ministry of Finance and the Government of India will treat this appeal with utmost priority and compassion for the welfare of the people of the Islands, a press release from MP Office said.

**Training on Physical verification of PMEGP Units for Department of Post held**
