Hon'ble MP meets Hon'ble Finance Minister along with delegation of National Small Savings Agents Association of India

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 9

In response to the long pending grievances of postal savings agents and to raise their demands at the appropriate level, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, yesterday met Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, Hon'ble Union Minister of Finance, at Parliament House, New Delhi, along with a delegation of the National Small Savings Agents Association, India.

The meeting was convened following representations made by the Association regarding the reduction in their commission rates. During the interaction, the office



bearers of the Association highlighted that their commission was reduced from 1% to 0.5% in 2011 and despite multiple appeals, their demand for restoration of the original 1% commission has not been addressed. They informed the Hon'ble Finance Minister that over 6 lakh agents are engaged across the country and these agents play a crucial role in creating awareness and

encouraging public participation in various postal savings schemes such as Kisan Vikas Patra, National Savings Certificates, Sukanya Samridhhi Yojana, Recurring Deposits, Monthly Income Schemes etc. on commission basis as per Govt. norms.

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray expressed hope that the legitimate demands of the agents will be resolved at the earliest, a press release from MP Office said.

Govt. land measuring 2,200 sq. mtrs. reclaimed by District Administration, SA at Swaraj Dweep



Swaraj Dweep, Aug. 9

As part of the District Administration's ongoing efforts to safeguard Government land and ensure its proper utilization, an encroachment drive was conducted today at Radha Nagar, Swaraj Dweep. During the drive, encroachment in the form of plantation and a temporary shed erected over 2,200 square metres of land falling under Government Khata was identified and removed. The encroached area was promptly restored to its original status,

reaffirming the Administration's commitment to protecting public land and preventing unauthorized occupation.

The drives were conducted peacefully with full coordination between Revenue officials and enforcement staff, without any disruptions to law and order.

The District Administration reiterates its firm commitment to act against illegal encroachments and appeals to the general

public to refrain from occupying government land without proper authorization. Citizens have been encouraged to cooperate with the District Administration in preserving public resources and maintaining the rule of law. The District Administration, South Andaman reiterates that such operations will continue unabated in all areas where illegal occupation is identified.

As part of its ongoing activities to promote informed and responsible tourism, the Tourism Department organized a Public Lecture on Heritage Tourism today in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Disaster Management. The session featured noted historian and author Dr. Rashida Iqbal, who delivered a powerful presentation on "Echoes of the Past, Colonial Footprints: Cellular Jail and the Freedom Struggle - A Living Memory".

Tracing the rich and poignant history of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Dr. Iqbal engaged the audience with valuable insights and thoughtfully



addressed their queries. Sharing her perspective on heritage tourism, she observed that the Islands' history is not only fascinating but also deeply moving, as it reminds us of the immense sacrifices made for India's freedom. In these far-flung islands, countless freedom fighters endured unimaginable hardships first in the penal settlement and later within the Cellular Jail. They were remarkable in their

deeds, but even greater in their endurance and suffering. She urged that it is now our solemn duty to honour their vision and contribute towards building the great nation they dreamt of.

Interacting with tourism stakeholders, including tour and travel operators and aspiring tourist guides, Dr. Iqbal advised them to exercise utmost care when engaging with visitors. She stressed that it is far better to politely decline a query

than to provide a distorted account of history, as heritage must be preserved in its truth. She cautioned that misinformation, could harm the Islands' image as a heritage tourism destination.

The Tourism Department reaffirmed its commitment to organising more such knowledge-sharing sessions for frontline tourism workers including tour operators, cab drivers, and hoteliers to enhance visitor experience and uphold the integrity of the Islands' historical legacy, a press release from IP&T said.

Cleaning up the Electoral System: ECI Delists 334 RUPPs

New Delhi, Aug. 9 (PIB) 1. Political parties (National/State/RUPPs) in the country are registered with the ECI under the provisions of Section 29A of the Representation of the People Act 1951

2. At present, there are 6 National Parties, 67 State Parties and 2854 Registered Unrecognized Political Parties (RUPPs) registered with ECI. (Annexure: List of National & State Parties)

3. Guidelines for registration of Political Parties mention that if the party does not contest elections continuously for 6 years, the party shall be taken off the list of registered parties.

4. In addition, as per Section 29A of the RP Act 1951, parties at the time of their registration have to give details like name, address,

office bearers etc. and any change has to be communicated to the Commission without delay.

5. Earlier, in June 2025, ECI had directed the CEOs of States & UTs to conduct verification enquiries of 345 RUPPs regarding compliance with the above conditions.

6. CEOs conducted enquiries, issued show-cause notices to these RUPPs and provided each party an opportunity to respond and present their case through personal hearings.

7. Thereafter, based on reports of the CEOs, 334 RUPPs out of the total of 345 RUPPs have been found not complying with the above conditions. The remaining cases have been referred back to the CEOs for re-verification.

8. The Commission, after

considering all the facts and recommendations of the CEOs, has delisted 334 RUPPs (Link: <https://www.eci.gov.in/list-of-political-parties>). Now, out of the total of 2854 RUPPs, 2520 are remaining. This delisting exercise is part of a comprehensive and continuous strategy of the Election Commission to clean up the electoral system.

9. These RUPPs will now not be eligible to avail any benefit under the provisions of Section 29B and Section 29C of the RP Act, 1951 read with the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968. Any party aggrieved by this order can appeal to the Commission within 30 days of the order.

The National Awards for e-Governance are presented annually to honor and encourage excellence in implementing e-Governance initiatives. The awards seek to recognize significant achievements, foster the sharing of effective practices, and promote innovations in digital governance.

Nominations for National Awards for e-Governance 2026

can be submitted under 7 Categories:

- I. Government Process Re-engineering by use of technology for Digital Transformation
- II. Innovation by Use of AI and other new age technologies for providing Citizen-Centric Services
- III. Best e-Gov. Practices/Innovation in Cyber Security
- IV. District Level Initiatives in e-Governance
- V. Grassroots Level Initiatives by Gram Panchayats or equivalent Traditional Local Bodies for Deepening/Widening of Service Delivery
- VI. Replication and Scaling of Nationally Awarded and Mission-mode e-Governance Projects by State/UTs/Districts
- VII. Digital transformation by use of data analytics in digital platforms by Central

Ministries/States/UTs

The period of consideration requires that the project's launch date fall between 01.07.2023 and 30.06.2025. Additionally, the project must be fully commissioned and operational as of 01.08.2025 for all seven categories listed under NAeG 2026.

The NAeG Awards 2026 will comprise (i) a trophy, (ii) a certificate, and (iii) an incentive of Rs. 10 lakh for each Gold Awardee and Rs. 5 lakh for each Silver Awardee. The incentive will be awarded to the respective district/organization for use in project or programme implementation or to bridge resource gaps in any area of public welfare. A total of 16 awards will be conferred under NAeG 2026, including 10 Gold Awards and 6 Silver Awards.

Indian Railways conducts trial run of Asia's Longest Freight Train 'Rudrastra'

New Delhi, Aug. 9 The Indian Railway has achieved a new milestone by successfully conduct a trial run of Asia's largest, a 4.5 km long freight train 'Rudrastra'. The trial run was conducted from the Ganjkhwaja railway station in Chandauli, Uttar Pradesh to Garhwa in Jharkhand covering a distance of 209 km in 5 hours 10 minutes at an average speed of 40.50 km per hour. Divisional Railway Manager (DRM), Shri Uday Singh Meena said now freight trains will be sent from The Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Division (DDU) of East Central Railway to the Dhanbad Division for quick loading and transportation of goods.

The Railways Minister, Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw also shared a video of the trial run and said Rudrastra is Bharat's longest freight train of 4.5 km long. Rudrastra is Asia's longest freight train, which will make



freight transportation and loading quick. This will not only save resources but also time. Shri Meena said Rudrastra was prepared by adding three long haul (two goods trains each) racks.

A total of 345 wagons were included in it, with 72 tonnes of goods loaded in one empty

wagon. He informed that two engines were attached in front and one with each rack after every 59 bogeys. In all, seven engines were used. One rack had 59 bogeys. He said in a way, five goods trains were lined up one after the other with the first goods train having two engines. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

India's defence exports reach Rs. 23,000 crore, set to double in the next 2-3 years

New Delhi, Aug. 9 India's defence exports touched 23,000 crore rupees last year and are expected to double within the next two to three years, said Dr. Sameer Kamat, Secretary of the Department of Defence Research and Development and Chairman of the Governing Council of the Defence Institute of Advanced Technology (DIAT). He was addressing a press conference in Pune on Saturday after

DIAT's 14th convocation ceremony. Dr. Kamat stated that Indian defence equipment has high demand in Middle Eastern, African, and South Asian countries. Work is underway to develop a smaller version of the BrahMos missile, while the development of the Zorawar light tank is also progressing rapidly. Addressing the convocation, he noted that during 'Operation

Sindhur', the Indian Armed Forces were significantly supported by DRDO-developed indigenous weapons, armaments, and equipment. To achieve complete self-reliance in missile and equipment production, 15 Centres of Excellence are being established with the support of the defence industry and academic institutions.
