All manual services and certificates are now available in a digital format, marking a shift towards a more efficient and user-friendly system. This change ensures that all certificates and administrative processes are handled online, significantly reducing the need for physical paperwork.

Free Wi-Fi Access: The newly launched Wi-Fi access point will enable residents to access various online services directly without any data charges. Comprehensive Web Page: A District Information System webpage has been launched, offering a range of online services and the Govt. portal can also be accessed by visitors.






