31 Lakh Government Employees trained under Mission Karmayogi: Union Minister

New Delhi, Aug. 12 (PIB)

Union Minister, Dr. Jitendra Singh launches 'Amrit Gyan Kosh' Portal and 'Faculty Development Portal' at the Civil Service Training Institutions Convention today at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. Dr. Jitendra Singh traced back the journey of National Capacity Building Commission and Mission Karmayogi Bharat said, "It marks a



paradigm shift in how we approach civil service training and it also envisions a future-ready civil service rooted in Indian ethos, with a global perspective".

The DoPT Minister added that within a short term the CBC and Mission Karmayogi has got integrated within the governance structure though many of them were skeptical

about its role but leaving everything behind it carved a niche for itself and contributing positively to achieve Minimum Government and Maximum Governance. He announced that 31 Lakh Government Employees trained under it every year. He also said "With the evolution of technology and governance we need to learn and unlearn in every phase."

Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment (SJE), Dr. Virendra Kumar administered the countrywide 'Mass Pledge' against drug abuse, under the Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyan (NMBA), at Modern School Barakhamba Road, in New Delhi today. The occasion was graced by the presence of Ministers of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, Shri Ramdas Athawale; and, Shri B.L. Verma (via video conference).



Around 2700 students, teachers from Modern School were physically present during the event including senior officers from the Ministry. Various stakeholders such as schools, colleges, Universities, State/ District

Administrations etc. joined the event virtually from around 10,000 locations from the country. More than 1 crore people from across the country took oath and participated in various programmes conducted to celebrate this occasion.

In his address, Dr.

Virendra Kumar reminded the gathering that it was on 15th August 2020, when Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi gave a clarion call for a drug-free India from the ramparts of the Red Fort. Responding to his call, the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment identified 272 districts of the country which were the most affected by drug abuse, and launched the NMBA. The Minister further informed that all the districts of India have been included in this campaign from August 2023.

MP meets Union Power Minister regarding power issues in Isles

Port Blair, Aug. 12

The Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A & N Islands, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, yesterday met Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, Govt. of India, Shri Manohar Lal Khattar and has once again submitted a letter regarding unabated power cuts in the Islands and Port Blair in particular.

In his letter, Shri Ray has stated that the capital Port Blair city is experiencing severe power crisis, since many years and no corrective steps have been taken yet. Due to power cuts, people are facing difficulties.

The average

requirement of power at Port Blair is about 45 MW. But all the available power producing sources put together including Department's 4 MW Power Plants are unable to meet the requirements.

The problem of power crisis is not limited just to Island capital, but is being experienced in all populated Islands of the Territory.

Shri Ray has also pointed that the 33 KV and 11 KV tie lines in Port Blair are very old and requires immediate revamp to address the



power cut crisis. In addition to the technical issues, Shri Ray also pointed that the Electricity Department requires the revival of SE post and up-gradation of the same to CE post.

Shri Ray has invited the Union Power Minister to Andaman & Nicobar Islands to

All manual services and certificates are now available in a digital format, marking a shift towards a more efficient and user-friendly system. This change ensures that all certificates and administrative processes are handled online, significantly reducing the need for physical paperwork.

Free Wi-Fi Access: The newly launched Wi-Fi access point will enable residents to access various online services directly without any data charges.

Comprehensive Web Page: A District Information System webpage has been launched, offering a range of online services and the Govt. portal can also be accessed by visitors.

With the launch of these services, two previously manual services have now transitioned to online mode: through URL:<https://sites.google.com/view/denicobars/> i.e. Helicopter Ticket Booking & Guest House/Transit/Quarter Allotment.

Citizens can now submit applications and view passenger lists through an integrated online platform. All relevant links and resources are available on the District's website and within the premises of respective Sub-division Offices.

This move positions Nicobar Deputy Commissioner Office as the first paperless Office within the Andaman and Nicobar Administration. The transition to a fully digital service model aligns with the District Administration's goal of providing 'Maximum Service with Limited Resources'.
