## President, Smt. Droupadi Murmu to address the nation on the eve of 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day today



New Delhi, Aug. 13 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu will address the nation tomorrow (August 14, 2025) on the eve of the 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day.

The address will be broadcast from 1900

hrs. on the entire national network of Akashvani and telecast over all channels of Doordarshan in Hindi followed by the English version. Broadcast of the address in Hindi and English on Doordarshan will be followed by

broadcast in regional languages by regional channels of Doordarshan. Akashvani will broadcast regional language versions at 2130 hrs. on its respective regional networks.

## Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi to lead 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day celebrations from Red Fort, Delhi

### Grand spectacle to provide a glimpse of a prosperous, secure & bold Naya Bharat

New Delhi, Aug. 13 (PIB)

The Nation will celebrate the 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day on August 15, 2025, with the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi leading the celebrations from the iconic Red Fort in Delhi. The Prime Minister will hoist the National Flag and address the nation from the ramparts of the iconic monument. As the nation is making giant strides towards realising the Government's vision of Viksit Bharat by 2047, the theme of this year's celebrations is Naya Bharat. The celebrations will serve as a platform to commemorate the continuing rise of a prosperous, secure & bold Naya Bharat and provide renewed power to surge further ahead on the path to progress.

Upon his arrival at the Red Fort, the Prime Minister will be received by Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh, Raksha Rajya Mantri, Shri Sanjay Seth and Defence Secretary, Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh. Thereafter, the Prime Minister will inspect the Guard of Honour. The Guard of Honour contingent for the Prime Minister will consist of 96 personnel (one officer & 24 personnel each from the Army, Navy, Air Force & Delhi Police. The Indian Air Force is the coordinating service for the Independence Day



celebrations this year.

After inspecting the Guard of Honour, the Prime Minister will proceed to the ramparts of the Red Fort where he will be greeted by Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh, Raksha Rajya Mantri, Shri Sanjay Seth, Chief of Defence Staff, General Anil Chauhan, Chief of the Army Staff, General Upendra Dwivedi, Chief of the Naval Staff, Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi and Chief of the Air Staff, Air Chief Marshal AP Singh. The GoC, Delhi area will conduct the Prime Minister to the dais on the ramparts to hoist the National Flag.

Flying Officer Rashika Sharma will assist the Prime

Minister in hoisting the National Flag. It will be synchronised with the 21-Gun Salute by the valiant gunners of the 1721 Field Battery (Ceremonial). The ceremonial battery, utilising the indigenous 105mm Light Field Guns, will be commanded by Major Pawan Singh Shekhawat and the Gun Position Officer will be Naib Subedar (Assistant Instructor in Gunnery) Anuthosh Sarkar.

The National Flag Guard, comprising one officer and 32 Other Ranks each from the Army, Navy & Air Force and Delhi Police totalling 128 personnel, will present the Rashtriya Salute at the time of hoisting of the National Flag by

the Prime Minister. Wing Commander Tarun Dagar will be in command of this Inter-Services Guard and Police Guard.

The Army Contingent in the National Flag Guard will be commanded by Major Prakash Singh, the Naval contingent by Lieutenant Commander Mohd Parvej and the Air Force Contingent by Squadron Leader VV Sharvan. The Delhi Police contingent will be commanded by Additional DCP Shri Abhimanyu Poswal.

After being hoisted, the Tricolour will receive a 'Rashtriya Salute'. The Air Force band, consisting of one JCO and 25 Other Ranks, will play the National Anthem during the hoisting of the National Flag and presenting the 'Rashtriya Salute'. The Band will be conducted by Junior Warrant Officer M Deka. For the first time, 11 Agniveer Vayu musicians will be part of the band which will be playing the National Anthem.

As soon as the National Flag is hoisted by the Prime Minister, flower petals will be showered at the venue by two Mi-17 helicopters of the Indian Air Force - one trooping the

### Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands to hoist National Tricolour at historic Netaji Stadium

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 13 Independence Day will be celebrated in a befitting manner in these Islands too together with the rest of the country on Aug. 15, 2025. The main function for the 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day will be held at the historic Netaji Stadium wherein the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will hoist the National Tricolour at 9.14 AM.

Thereafter, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor will inspect the Guard of Honour and present Medals, Gallantry Awards and distribute Certificates. This will be followed by the address of Hon'ble Lt. Governor. The main function at Netaji Stadium will conclude with the National Anthem.

Before arrival at the Netaji Stadium for the main function, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor will visit National Memorial Cellular Jail and place wreath at the 'Martyr's Column'. He

will also hoist the National Flag in the Cellular Jail.

A full dress rehearsal of the 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day celebration was held in the historic Netaji Stadium today.

Meanwhile, prominent places in the city got a face lift with the historical monuments and Government buildings white coated. Elaborate traffic arrangements and traffic diversions have been put in place for the smooth conduct of the main function of the 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day celebrations.

## Elaborate traffic arrangements made for Independence Day main function on Aug. 15

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 13

It is notified for the information of the general public that the following Traffic arrangements have been made for the Independence Day celebrations on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 (Friday).

- The arcade of Hon'ble Lt. Governor and other dignitaries, holders of parking card 'P' (Green) shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium.
- The holders of parking card 'P' (Pink) shall be parked near Andaman Club and near Netaji Stadium parking.
- The holders of car parking label 'P', (both Green and Pink) may use any route of their choice to approach the place of function, but are requested to reach the place of function latest by 0830 hrs., failing which, their vehicles will be stopped near the Gymkhana Crossing, RK Mission and Fire Brigade (HQ) crossings.
- After the departure of the chief guest from the place of function, the vehicles bearing parking label "P" (both Green & Pink) shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan (ANIIDCO Office)-Fire Brigade-APWD Crossing to their destinations.
- The holders of 'P-1' parking labels will arrive at the Netaji Stadium via Model School-Clock Tower-Gymkhana Crossing to Netaji Stadium. Thereafter, the vehicles shall proceed to the parking on the western side of main gate of Netaji Stadium and near Swimming Pool.
- After the departure of all vehicles parked inside the stadium and near Andaman Club having "P" parking label, the vehicles with "P-1" parking label will be allowed to come to the main entrance of Netaji Stadium to pick up the guests and shall leave via Scout Hut Junction-Girls School Crossing-RK Mission and RGT Road.
- All other vehicles without any parking label including two and four wheelers will be parked near Water Sports Complex and Girls School parking.
- The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing - Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon.
- No heavy vehicles, private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed towards Cellular Jail from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs and shall be diverted to other routes from Bengali Club Junction.
- The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar.
- Heavy vehicles shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglight from Bengali Club from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.
- No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from Y- Narayan Junction, RK Mission, Fire Brigade Junction and Water Sports Junction after 0830 hrs.
- No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Aberdeen Bazar after the start of the function from any direction till the dispersal of the crowd.
- The vehicles carrying parade contingents after dropping the contingents in front of Netaji Stadium shall proceed to Water Sports Complex/Girls School Parking and will remain stationed there. After culmination of parade they will come to Netaji Stadium via Y- Narayan Junction and proceed to their respective units with the parade contingents.
- Further, vehicles intending to proceed to GB Pant Hospital shall follow the routes from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.
- Gandhi Statue- Marine Gate - Sisty Nagar - Dignabad Sea Shore Road - Khan Jn. - exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.
- Bengali Club - Clock Tower - Gymkhana Crossing - Round Basthi - Dignabad Sea Shore Road - Khan Jn. - exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.
- Ambulance and vehicles with medical emergency cases proceeding to GB Pant Hospital shall take the route Y-Narayan Junction-Cellular Jail-GB Pant Hospital and this route shall be closed from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs for all other vehicles except Ambulance and vehicles with medical emergency.
- Private tourist boats carrying tourists from Aberdeen Jetty to NSCB Dweep, North Bay etc. shall be shifted to Junglight jetty on 15/08/2025, a press release from DC (SA) said.

## Training prog. on Fodder Cultivation organized in VK Pur, Little Andaman

Hutbay, Aug. 13

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services (AH&VS), Andaman and Nicobar Administration, in collaboration with the Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA), conducted a two-day training program on "Fodder Cultivation" on August 12 and 13, 2025 at the Panchayat Community Hall in Vivekananda Pur (22 km) in Little Andaman. The initiative aimed to enhance livestock productivity by equipping farmers with scientific fodder production techniques tailored to local agricultural conditions.

The program was inaugurated by Shri Primal Mondal, Pradhan of Vivekananda Pur, as the chief guest. In his address, he emphasized the need for controlled intercropping methods for fodder production, noting that arecanut plantations dominate the area, making fodder grass cultivation challenging due to potential interference with arecanut collection. He urged farmers to



adopt controlled intercropping practices and requested the AH&VS Department to supply poultry and duck inputs at the Panchayat Bhavan, citing difficulties faced by farmers in accessing these from Nanjappa Nagar. The Senior Veterinary Officer of Hut Bay delivered a welcome address, outlining the significance of fodder production in supporting livestock health and productivity in the region. Participants received hands-on training, reading materials, plastic buckets, and Super Napier fodder cuttings to facilitate practical implementation. Technical sessions covered scientific approaches to fodder cultivation, including soil preparation, seed selection, and intercropping strategies. The program continued today with additional sessions to reinforce these practices. This initiative reflects the AH&VS Department's commitment to promote sustainable animal husbandry in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The active participation of farmers underscores their dedication to improving livestock management. The Department plans to expand such training programs to ensure farmers across the islands have access to essential resources, aligning with the Administration's vision of fostering sustainable rural development, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

Light Motor Vehicle (LMV) driving training to eligible women across the Islands. The goal is to help women, especially those from poor and underprivileged backgrounds, become self-reliant and earn their livelihood.

The training program will be conducted in all districts and efforts will be taken to accommodate the candidates at the place where the program will be conducted which is nearer to their place of residence. In the first instance, it is decided to start the training program in Sri Vijaya Puram and Swaraj Dweep. Such program will also be held in other Islands.

Interested female candidates aged 18 and above can submit their applications in the offices of Transport Department or SBI, RSETI, Sri Vijaya Puram. Applications will be scrutinized based on the following preferences:

- Scheduled Tribe (ST) women.
- Women from Below Poverty Line (BPL) families.
- Women who are members of Self-Help Groups (SHGs).
- Women from families registered under MGNREGA who worked atleast 35 days last year.
- Other unemployed females.

The training with a duration of 30 days will be given free of cost and each batch will have a capacity of 25 candidates. SBI, RSETI will be arranging the classes and other facilities and wherever required, the services of skilled manpower of Transport Department will be made available during the training. After completion of training and passing the driving test, Driving Licenses will be issued to the candidates. Another important aspect of the training will be the entrepreneurship training initiative which forms the part of curriculum and will be a significant step towards women empowerment and skill development in the Islands, helping women become self-reliant and enabling them to explore employment and self-employment opportunities. 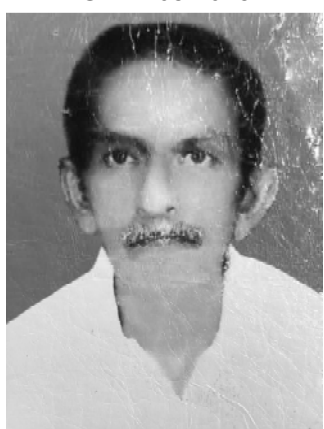
