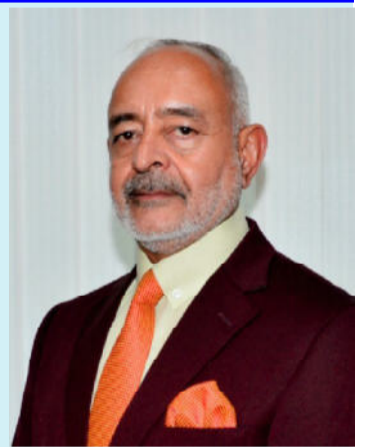

## A&N Administration acknowledges the fortitude of general public in dealing with power crisis

### Hon'ble Lt. Governor accords in principle approval to augment 15 MW Power through DG sets

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 14

The Administration acknowledges the support of general public, public representatives, who have demonstrated patience and trust in the ongoing measures being adopted to minimize the pain of forced power cuts.

In a significant move to augment the increasing demand of power in South Andaman, Hon'ble Lt.

Governor has accorded in principle approval for Electricity Department's in-house augmentation of 15MW DG sets to generate electricity of around 9 MW and 6 MW at Chatham and Phoenix Bay Power House, respectively. The tendering process for procuring these DG sets will be initiated shortly.

Presently, Sri Vijaya

Puram is experiencing power shortage due to closure of one of the hiring power plant at Chatham. To mitigate the ongoing acute power crisis situation, UT Administration is actively exploring possibilities of augmentation of additional power generation from existing DG power plants at Sri

Vijaya Puram as a short term measure.

This move has been taken considering the growing demand of electricity and taking into cognizance slow progress in implementation of renewable energy projects. The A & N Administration is also actively taking efforts to fast track these projects.

The above measure has

been taken to minimize inconvenience to Electricity Consumers in SVP/South Andaman.

A&N Administration re-affirms its goal of de-dieselization in power generation in next 3-4 years. All renewable energy projects shall be rigorously persuaded and monitored to realize achieving this goal, a press release from Director (Power) said.

## NHIDCL engages Consultant for Chatham Causeway Retrofitting work also initiated as a temporary measure

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 14

Andaman & Nicobar Administration is actively working on the refurbishment of the Chatham causeway to provide relief to the residents of South Andaman. In the interim, the Administration has enlisted the expertise of NIT Tiruchirappalli to carry out additional testing for exploring remedial measures for the existing structure. Preliminary assessments suggest that the bridge can be made suitable for light vehicular traffic following the necessary retrofitting work as a temporary measure. The project is anticipated to commence in a couple of months and is expected to be completed within six months from the start date.

Given the bridge's critical role in regional connectivity and the grave safety concerns, the project is being monitored at the highest administrative level. The Andaman & Nicobar Administration also sought intervention from the Govt. of India for the early sanction and execution of a new Chatham causeway under appropriate central funding. A meeting was chaired by the Home Secretary on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 in the matter, wherein senior officials of MoRTH and MoPSW were also present. NHIDCL has been assigned the work of construction of the new Chatham causeway along with Andaman Marine Drive road. The consultancy for the new Chatham Causeway has already been awarded by NHIDCL.

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration reiterates its commitment to ensure uninterrupted connectivity to the Chatham Island while also ensuring that public safety remains the top priority. All possible measures are being undertaken on war footing to get the causeway refurbished for public convenience, a press release from APWD said.

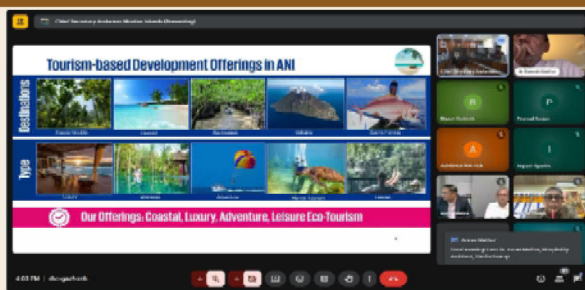

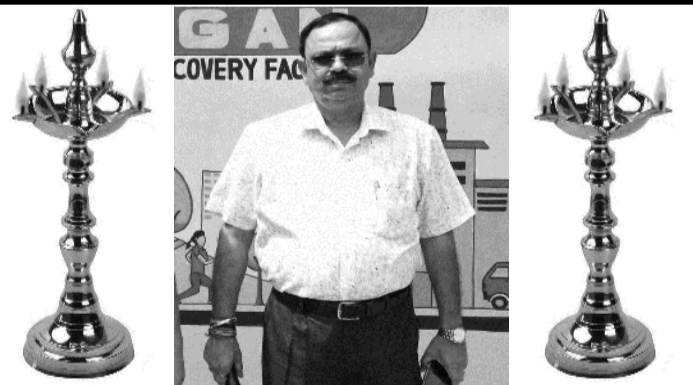

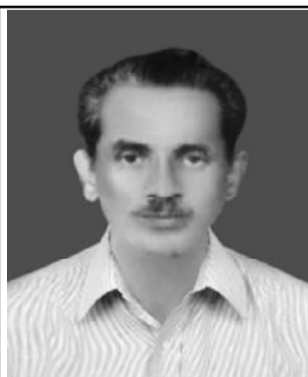
