Lauding the role of Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) in driving inclusive growth, the Prime Minister noted that the establishment of the Global DPI Depository during India's G20 Presidency marked first multilateral consensus on DPL He also said that India has established a Social Impact Fund to accelerate progress in DPI in the Global South. He added that India will make an initial contribution of 25 million dollars to this fund.

Shri Modi highlighted that for health security, India's mission is - One World-One Health and vision is - "Arogya Maitri". He said that New Delhi upheld this friendship by collaborating on hospitals, dialysis machines, life-saving medicines, and Jan Aushadhi Centers in Africa and Pacific Island countries.

PS Diglipur cracks down snatching case; accused arrested

Diglipur, Aug. 17

The Diglipur Police successfully cracked down on a snatching case and arrested the accused, Suraj Mazumder @ Gullu on 11.08.2024. Following a complaint about a woman's handbag being snatched near Radha Krishna Mandir, Diglipur, an FIR was promptly registered under the relevant section of the newly enacted Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita-2023. A large-scale manhunt was launched by the PS Diglipur staff under the

supervision of Shri Ankesh Yadav, SDPO Diglipur. Based on intelligence inputs, it was determined that the suspect, a notorious criminal with a history of offenses, had been evading police action by fleeing to different jurisdictions after committing crimes. However, Suraj Mazumder was swiftly apprehended after an extensive search, and the stolen property was recovered from his possession. The accused was

arrested following all codal formalities as outlined in the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita-2023 and was produced before the Hon'ble Court at Mayabunder, from where he was remanded to judicial custody. A&N Police issues public advisory on illegal digital lending apps

These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/videos, in order to avail the loans. This personal data is then misused for blackmail and harassment. The illegal apps make use of bulk SMSs.

advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale. All citizens are therefore advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been cheated, blackmailed or harassed as a result of using these apps, they are advised to report the matter to the Cyber Cell, CID, Port Blair or the nearest Police Station of the area without delay.

(iv) Analysis of polling station data to identify gaps in electoral roll with special focus on enrolment of youths in 18-19 age group and women and to take necessary corrective measures.
(v) Checking spellings, multiple/duplicate entries, part header page, photos etc. of electors in the roll.
(vi) Collecting photos of the residual voters.
(vii) Collecting mobile numbers/e-mail ID of electors.
(viii) Submitting reports to Electoral Registration Officer/Asst. Electoral Registration Officer so that notice can be issued to the persons whose names have to be deleted.
(ix) Display of Draft Roll/prescribed notices at designated locations.
(x) Reading of Rolls in Gram/Ward Sabhas- Liaisoning with RWAs in urban areas for registration
(xi) Distribution of Voter ID Cards (EPIC).
(xii) Maximization of EPIC coverage
