Promoting Geo-tourism in Isles

Geological Survey of India (GSI) worked jointly with A&N Administration to highlight geological importance of four Geoheritage sites in A&N Islands

A&N Administration is under process of signing a MOU with GSI for research, documentation & management of these sites & other potential sites in Isles

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 1

Indian subcontinent exhibits imprints of varied geological processes through ages and is a storehouse of interesting geological features. Ministry of Mines has enlisted some of those locales as Geoheritage sites. It is imperative that the Tourist Map of India would be greatly enriched by the inclusion of these geological monuments and alike, so that the visitors from the country and abroad can have an insight in the real past.

With the objective of achieving this goal, the Geological Survey of India (GSI) jointly with Andaman and Nicobar Administration have worked to highlight the geological importance of four Geoheritage sites in A&N Islands to promote Geo-tourism in the



Islands. The Art and Culture Department, A&N Administration is the Nodal Agency in this regard. A team of senior officers from GSI headed by Dr. Santanu Bhattacharjee, the Deputy Director General, West Bengal and Andaman Nicobar Islands, GSI visited these

Islands recently and inspected these Geo Heritage sites. They also visited Science Centre at Sri Vijaya Puram and installed information boards about some of the Geo Heritage sites there. The four Geoheritage sites as identified by GSI in A&N Islands include:

1. Mud Volcanoes, Baratang Island, Middle Andaman



The mud volcanoes, situated in Baratang Island, Middle Andaman is active and erupt sporadically. The major volcano exposed has a diameter of around 100 m and a height of 30 m. Many volcanoes are reported from this area. Mud volcanoes erupt mud or clay accompanied by gas (methane) that typically build a conical body around its orifice. These are driven by subsurface over pressure and tectonic activity and often bear signatures of subsurface hydrocarbon horizons. As more mud oozes out and spills over the edge, it grows in size, gradually forming a miniature volcano with rich, creamy mud crater at the top. Other major attractions on the island include the limestone caves, Parrot Island, and Baludera Beach.

2. Natural Coral Bridge, Shaheed Dweep, South Andaman



Shaheed Dweep, is famous for its two living natural corals formed just like a bridge. It is stunning geological formation sculpted by the relentless forces of nature, stands as a majestic marvel in the rugged landscape, best seen during low tide. They represent the calcareous (limestone) sediments of Neil Formation and are characterized by coralline algae, corals and foraminifera.

3. Barren Island, Middle Andaman



Barren Island, Andaman Sea, is the only active volcano in the Indian subcontinent along a chain of volcanoes from Sumatra to Myanmar. It is built of lava flows and volcanoclastic deposits of basaltic compositions. It is part of a north-south trending volcanic arc extending between Sumatra and Myanmar. This small, uninhabited 3-km-wide island contains a roughly 2-km-wide caldera with walls 250-350 m high. The caldera, which is open to the sea on the west, was created during a major explosive eruption in the late Pleistocene that produced pyroclastic flow and surge deposits.

4. Narcondam Island, North Andaman



Narcondam Island represents a dormant inner arc volcano of the active Andaman-Java Subduction Complex in the Andaman Sea, formed of volcanic rocks. The island's peak rises to 710 m above mean sea level and it covers an area of 6.8 km². It is an extinct volcano that was active till the Holocene period. The Narcondam volcano along with the active barren volcano lies in the chain of inner arc volcanoes extending from Myanmar

Andaman's 5 Luxury Eco-Resorts

The Andaman and Nicobar Administration has decided to build five-star resorts at five locations, including the uninhabited Aves Island, which will be opened for tourism for the first time, officials said on Wednesday.

The eco-tourism properties will come up at Shaheed Dweep, Megapode Resort in Sri Vijaya Puram, and Aves Island, Long Island and Smith Island in North and Middle Andaman, they said.

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Limited (ANIIDCO) has invited bids for developing the resorts on a public-private partnership (PPP) basis on a design,

build, finance, operate and transfer mode, they added.

The pre-bid meeting will be held on August 14, while the bidding will take place on September 15, officials said.

It is for the first time that the Aves Island will be opened for tourism. It is known for the acres of coconut plantation.

After the resort comes up, the administration believes that Aves Island will become the most sought-after destination in the Andamans after Swaraj Dweep.

It is close to the Mayabunder town and has live and dead coral flat beds along with a 2-km coastline, making it an ideal destination for campers, officials said.

A trek through the

picturesque coconut plantations will take one to the lighthouse on the southern tip of the island, they said, revealing the plans being prepared to develop the destination.

A land parcel of 2.75 hectare is owned by the

administration, which will be handed over to ANIIDCO on lease for the development of the project, they said.

The property will involve an investment of nearly Rs 36 crore, and will have 50 rooms, officials said.

Various facilities, such

as a shopping arena and a wellness centre, and recreational activities like scuba diving, fishing, trekking and camping will be available, they said.

The proposed resort at Lalaji Bay in Long Island would cost about Rs 391

Shortage of 5 MW power due to closure of NVVN plant at Chatham to facilitate vacation of site for upcoming installation of new 10 MW power plant at same location

Electricity Deptt. to carry out load shedding on a rotational basis in Sri Vijaya Puram & South Andaman areas

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 1

It is brought to the notice of General Public/All Govt. Departments /All Pvt. organizations that the gap between demand and supply of electricity has increased leading to shortage of electricity supply due to closure of 05MW NVVN Power Plant at Chatham for facilitating vacation of the site for the upcoming installation of a new 10 MW power plant at the same location and significant increase in power demand due to sudden rise in ambient temperature. Adding to it during re-charging of

feeders there is a huge spike in demand due to domestic and commercial inverter charging and simultaneous switching on a high power guzzlers and other equipment, which is adding the overall demand more than as expected. This has led to a considerable shortage of around 8-9MW during peak hours and around 4-5 MW shortage during day hours. In order to

combat the situation mobilization of resources are underway which shall take some time.

To mitigate the situation the department is forced to carry out load shedding on a rotational basis in the Sri Vijaya Puram and South Andaman areas w.e.f. 01/08/2025 from 1600Hrs. to 2330Hrs. as per schedule given for a period of 01 month.

Massive spices plantation program under "Spice Pravah" organized by Deptt.of Agriculture, L/Andaman

The Department of Agriculture, Little Andaman zone, in coordination with other zones across the Union Territory, conducted a large-scale plantation programme under the 'Spice Pravah' initiative on July 31, 2025, aimed at expanding the area under spice cultivation. The programme witnessed active participation from farmers, Panchayati Raj Institutions, and field functionaries.

The programme was formally inaugurated by Shri Parmanathan, Pramukh, Panchayat Samiti, Little Andaman at Ramakrishnapur Gram Panchayat, in the presence of Smti Siuli Mondal, Pradhan, Ramakrishnapur, and Shri Rudramoorty, Pradhan, Hutbay, along with members of the Panchayat Samiti. The event marked a significant step toward promoting sustainable spice cultivation in the region. In his brief address, the chief guest, Shri Parmanathan lauded the efforts of the Department of Agriculture in promoting spice cultivation and acknowledged the department's



continuous support and training initiatives to empower the farming community and improve production standards. In her address, Smti Mary Magdalene, Agriculture Officer, underscored the importance of the initiative in enhancing spice cultivation across the Island. She highlighted the objectives of the 'Spice Pravah' programme in promoting sustainable agricultural practices. Shri Dinesh Chandra Das, Agriculture Assistant, provided technical insights on spice cultivation, including recommended package of practices, popular black pepper varieties, and the export potential of spices cultivated in Little Andaman. As part of the programme, 2,200 rooted black pepper cuttings were planted across 1 hectare of land belonging to four identified beneficiary farmers: Shri Ashok Bachar, Shri Shyamal Mondal, Shri Kamlesh Mondal, and Shri Noni Gopal Baroi. During the camp, 165 cattle were examined, with 28 animals screened specifically for infertility. Of these, 10 animals received treatment for reproductive disorders. Veterinary teams identified the causes of infertility and provided necessary treatments and advice to restore animal health and productivity. Emphasis was placed on balanced feeding practices and comprehensive reproductive care as essential components for effective dairy farming and cattle breeding. Farmers were educated on management strategies to enhance reproductive efficiency, ensuring sustainable livestock production and improved milk yields.

3. Score Card of JEE (Main)-2025 issued by NTA for Engineering/Architecture candidates (Not applicable for B.Pharmacy).
4. Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth
5. Certificate and Mark sheet of qualifying examination

Illegally sawn padauk wood seized by PS Ograbraj

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 1

Acting swiftly on credible intelligence inputs, the staff of Police Station Ograbraj executed a well-coordinated raid at a clandestine timber storage site, resulting in the seizure of a significant cache of illegally sawn Padauk wood.

On 23/07/2025, acting on a credible information regarding storage of illegally swan timber, a team was immediately mobilised under the leadership of Inspector Stalin N S, SHO PS Ograbraj. The team immediately rushed to the target location situated behind the Government Middle School, Ograbraj, where a tin-roofed structure was found securely locked. A preliminary inspection through visible openings revealed a considerable volume of timber



stockpiled inside. Subsequent investigation established that the shed belonged to Shri Shia Muddin, an ex-serviceman. The entire consignment both timber and cutting equipment were seized on the spot under relevant sections of the Indian Forest Act, 1927. The entire operation was carried out under the close watch & supervision of Shri Ajay Rai, DANIPS, SDPO Bambooflat and overall supervision of Shri Manoj Kumar Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District.


