Hospitality majors explore developing eco-tourism resorts in Andaman Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 19 (PTI)

Top hospitality companies, including Tata group's IHCL and Hyatt Hotels Corp, have shown interest in developing eco-tourism resorts at four locations in Andamans, including the uninhabited Aves Island, which will be opened for tourism for the first time, officials said on Saturday.

The eco-tourism properties will be developed on a public-private partnership (PPP) basis at Shaheed Dweep, Aves Island, Long Island and Smith Island. Besides, the administration is also looking to redevelop



Megapode Resort in Sri Vijaya Puram, they said.

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Ltd (ANIIDCO) on July 28 invited bids for developing the resorts on a design, build, finance, operate and transfer basis, they added.

A virtual pre-bid meeting was held on

August 14, and it was attended by officials of some of the biggest players of the sector, including The Leela, Indian Hotels Company Limited (IHCL), Club Mahindra, Hyatt Hotels Corp, Ambuja Neotia Hospitality, Chalet Hotels, Juniper Hotels, The Park, Polo Hotels Ltd and GVK Group, officials said.

"The pre-bid meeting was organised to provide a platform to the potential investors to share their suggestions and seek clarifications, if any. The discussions covered the entire project life cycle for all the proposed developments," ANIIDCO, MD, Ms. Chanchal Yadav said.

District Administration, SA cracks down on illegal excavator operation and encroachment on Govt. land

As part of its ongoing commitment to uphold environmental laws and safeguard Government land, the District Administration, South Andaman, has taken firm action against the illegal operation of an excavator and unauthorised encroachments in Sippighat Village.

Acting on a complaint regarding the illegal use of an excavator without valid development permission, a team of



Revenue Officials conducted a surprise inspection at Sippighat. The excavator found at the site was immediately seized. In addition, around 100

cubic meters of illegally extracted earth were also seized, and penalties have been imposed under the applicable provisions of law.

While continuing its efforts to protect public land, the Revenue Officials also carried out an anti-encroachment drive in the same area. Recently erected encroachments in the form of ghumtis were removed, and a total of six unauthorised structures constructed along the main road were cleared.

and queries raised by the participants were suitably clarified. Our aim is to transform the Andaman and Nicobar Islands into a global destination of sustainable and nature-led tourism. I am happy to share that we are planning site visits for the investors during the first week of September," she added.

The bidding will take place on September 15.

It is for the first time that the Aves Island, which is known for its acres of coconut plantation, will be opened for tourism.

After the resort comes up, the administration believes that Aves Island will become the most sought-after destination in the Andamans after Swaraj Dweep. It is close to the Mayabunder town and has live and dead coral flat beds along with a 2-km coastline, making it an ideal destination for campers, officials said.

A land parcel of 2.75 hectare is owned by the administration, which will be handed over to ANIDCO on lease for the development of the project. The property will involve an investment of nearly Rs. 36 crore and have 50 rooms, they said.

The proposed resort at Lalaji Bay in Long Island would cost about Rs.391 and have 220 rooms. The one at Smith Island would be set up at a cost of Rs.60 crore and have 70 rooms, while the property at Shaheed Dweep will be developed at Rs. 172 crore and have 120 rooms. (Source: www.livemint.com)

PMF, Rangat rescues stranded trawler & fishermen onboard braving adverse weather

Mayabunder, Aug. 19

A distress relay was received from the Fisheries Department, Nimbutala at PMF Rangat on 18/08/2025 at 1550 hrs, reporting that a fishing trawler MV Sarveshwaran (Reg. No. IND-AN-SA-MM-2059) with 5 crew onboard had suffered an engine failure off Rangat Bay and required immediate assistance.

Responding with promptness and professionalism, the PMF Rangat team consisting of SI (Master) Abdul Latheef, HCs Samson & C. Samsudeen onboard FIB MV Suntook set sail at 1610 hrs to carry out a Search and Rescue operation. The crew maintained constant vigilance while



navigating through choppy waters and deteriorating weather conditions, ensuring that no time was lost in reaching the distressed fishermen. After a careful search, at about 1715 hrs, the team successfully identified and located the stranded trawler MV Sarveshwaran, positioned approximately 4.5 nautical miles from Rangat Bay jetty.

The fishermen were immediately provided with basic first aid onboard MV Suntook to ensure their wellbeing after prolonged distress at sea. Despite being confronted with adverse weather marked by heavy rains, rough seas, and squally winds, the PMF personnel displayed remarkable seamanship and resilience in towing the disabled trawler towards safety to Rangat Bay Harbour, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.
