78469 persons insured under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana in A&N Islands

130 claims settled disbursing an amount of Rs. 2.60 crore to insured persons

The Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) is available to people in the age group of 18 to 50 years having a bank account who give their consent to join / enable auto-debit. Life cover of Rs. 2 lakhs shall be for the one year period stretching from 1st June to 31st May and is renewable. Risk coverage under this scheme is for Rs. 2 Lakh in case of death of the insured, due to any reason.

As per the data provided by the Lead Bank Port Blair, altogether,



78469 persons have been enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) in these Islands. A total of 130 claims were settled disbursing an amount of Rs. 2.60 crores to insured persons (Rs. 2 lakh for each claim) as on June 30, 2024.

As per the salient features of the scheme, a person insured during the month of June, July & August has to pay a premium amount of Rs. 436 while for the month of September, October & November, the premium amount is Rs. 342. Similarly, for the month of December, January

& February, the premium amount is Rs. 228 and for the month of March, April & May, the premium amount is Rs. 114. The premium per annum will be auto-debited in one installment from the subscriber's bank account as per the option given by him on or before 31st May of each annual coverage period under the scheme. The scheme is being offered by Life Insurance Corporation and all other life insurers who are willing to offer the product on similar terms with necessary approvals and tie up with banks for this purpose.

Deptt. of CS&CA distributing fortified rice through PDS

Beneficiaries asked not to mistake white granules of rice as plastic/foreign materials

Port Blair, Aug. 19

The Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs is issuing Fortified Rice as per the direction of the Govt. of India to the beneficiaries covered under Public Distribution System, Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) and Pradhan Mantri Poshan Scheme (earlier known as mid-day meal scheme) as per their entitlement. The fortified rice is distributed with an aim to address the issues of anaemia in children and women. The fortified rice distributed through

PDS and other welfare schemes is enriched with minerals and vitamins majority of which contains iron, folic acid and vitamin B12. The standard operating procedures are also being followed by the suppliers and distributors for rice fortification as devised by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).

However, many a times the white granules of rice are mistaken as plastic/foreign materials by the consumers which are nothing but the fortified granules added to distributed through

PS Kalighat seizes illicit ganja; one arrested

To combat the menace of illicit drugs in N&M Andaman District, PS Kalighat has once again demonstrated its determination by continuing the fight against drug peddlers. Acting on a tip-off that a person is traveling on a motorcycle towards Talbagan area, is in possession of a significant quantity of illicit Ganja, a raiding team was formed under SHO of PS Kalighat, SI Ashok Kumar Baghel.

The suspected motorcycle was spotted approaching Kalara Junction and the raiding team immediately intercepted the

motorcycle and conducted a search, resulting in the seizure of 200 grams of illicit ganja from the possession of the rider Bipin Bairagi, S/o Bimal Bairagi, 25 yrs, R/o Talbagan. Following thorough interrogation, the accused person confessed to his crime. Subsequently, the accused was arrested, and a case was registered at PS Kalighat under the NDPS Act. The raiding team comprised of HC(D) Rupesh Kumar and PCs Subrata Biswas, Sushil Sarkar, R Devika, and Subralekha along with two independent witnesses.

The whole operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Anakesh Yadav, SDPO, Diglipur and overall direction and supervision of Ms. Geetanjali Khandelwal, IPS, Superintendent of Police, North& Middle Andaman District.

PS Pahargaon solves blind attempt to
murder case within hours

Port Blair, Aug. 19

The Pahargaon Police Station has swiftly resolved a blind attempt to murder case within a few hours, showcasing their dedication and efficiency in upholding law and order. The incident occurred on the late night of 14th August, 2024, where an altercation in front of Unique Hotel and Bar, Dollygunj, escalated into a brutal assault on the victim, Ashish Sadhukhan.

The victim was found unconscious at his residence and was immediately rushed to GB Pant Hospital in critical condition, where he was placed on a ventilator. With no initial leads, the Pahargaon Police

registered a criminal case against an unknown person, and the investigation was entrusted to SI Sudhir Kumar.

The investigation team, led by Inspector Mohd. Elias, SHO, PS Pahargaon, thoroughly examined CCTV footage from the area and conducted interviews with local residents. This meticulous investigation led to the identification of a suspect, Suprobhat Das @ Joy, who has a known criminal background and was found absconding from the area.

After being taken into custody, Suprobhat Das confessed to the crime. The investigation

revealed that an altercation between the victim and the accused escalated, resulting in the victim being severely beaten.

The successful resolution of this case was due to the tireless efforts of the Police team, which included HCs Ravi Limbu, Sunil Yadav, Ajay Kr. Anand, PCs L. Horo, Ashish Kr. Singh, Santosh Lal, and Nokraju. The operation was conducted under the guidance of Inspector Mohd. Elias, with the supervision of Shri Vikas Swami, IPS, SDPO SA, and the overall supervision of Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS, SP(D) South Andaman, a press release from SP (SA) said.

Islands, the Department has opened avenue for transport of commercially valuable fish seeds from mainland India by issuing Fish Transport Registration Certificate with proper quarantine standards. This has created greater impact in increase of Freshwater Aquaculture in the Islands.

The fish seed distribution was conducted in 20 villages of Swadeshnagar, Billiground, Nimbudera, Tugapur, Chainpur and Bajota Gram Panchayats and the distribution programme was conducted in the presence of Dr. K Gopal, Joint Director (Fisheries) and Shri Tapan Kumar Biswas, Assistant Director of Fisheries (N&M Andaman). The Joint Director of Fisheries during distribution briefed about the prevailing Good Management Practices (GMPs) in Aquaculture and about the pre-stocking, stocking and post stocking management of aquaculture ponds for better production and marketing of freshwater fish produce. He also congratulated the team of Department of Fisheries posted in N&M Andaman for enabling the seed production even during this erratic monsoon season.

The Assistant Director of Fisheries, N&M Andaman during the interaction with fish farmers motivated the gathering to take up the 'Establishment of Freshwater Finfish Hatchery' under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana wherein the Govt. of India is extending financial assistance of Rs. 15 lakh for women beneficiaries and Rs. 10 lakh for general beneficiaries with a maximum unit cost of Rs. 25 lakh per unit. This hatchery will have a minimum capacity of 15 million fry/year/unit or 6 Crore spawn/year/unit with minimum area of 0.50 Ha. He also explained the success story of freshwater fin fish hatchery established under PMMSY in Diglipur of N&M Andaman District. Such new hatcheries will help to cater to the requirement of seeds of all the areas of N&M in near future. The second round of fish seed distribution in N&M Andaman in Hanspuri, Tugapur and Billiground is scheduled to be held in the third week of August, 2024, a press release from Fisheries Department said.



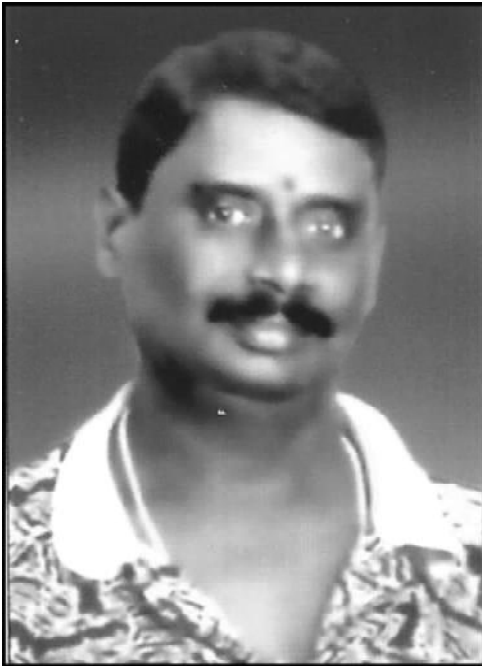


