## President presents National Geoscience Awards

New Delhi, Aug. 20 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu presented the National Geoscience Awards-2023 at a ceremony held at Rashtrapati Bhavan Cultural Centre today.

Speaking on the occasion, the President said that to achieve India's goal of becoming a developed nation by 2047, it is important to achieve self-sufficiency in mineral production. She was happy to note that the Government is taking many steps like integration of geoscientific data through National Geoscience Data



Repository Portal, use of AI and emerging technologies in exploration and mining of mineral resources. She expressed confidence that these steps will enable us to

understand our natural wealth better and utilize it properly. The President said that moving towards sustainable development, India is committed to achieving Net Zero

Carbon Emission. Our efforts to adopt clean energy on a large scale are in line with this goal. She emphasised that green transition requires greater focus on minerals such as critical minerals and

rare earth elements. She expressed confidence that the establishment of National Critical Minerals Mission will help India become self-reliant and strengthen value chain of critical minerals required for economic development and green transition.

The President was happy to note the establishment of National Landslide Forecasting Centre in Kolkata which will issue an early warning bulletin for all landslide-prone States. She stressed upon to make our

## TRAI issues directions to Access Service Providers for taking measures to curb misuse of messaging services

New Delhi, Aug. 20 (PIB)

Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) today issued directions for enforcement of measures to curb the misuse of messaging services and protect consumers from fraudulent practices. Through a direction issued today, TRAI has mandated all Access Service Providers to ensure the following:

➤ TRAI has mandated the Access Service Providers to migrate telemarketing calls starting with 140 series to online DLT platform latest by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024 for better monitoring and control.

➤ Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024, all Access Service

Providers will be prohibited from transmitting messages containing URLs, APKs, OTT links, or call back numbers which are not whitelisted by the Senders.

➤ To enhance message traceability, TRAI has mandated that the trail of all messages from Senders to Recipients must be traceable from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2024. Any message with an undefined or mismatched telemarketer chain will be rejected.

➤ To deter the misuse of templates for promotional content, TRAI has introduced punitive measures for non-compliance. Content Templates registered under the wrong category will

be blacklisted, and repeated offenses will lead to a one-month suspension of the Sender's services.

➤ To ensure compliance with regulations, all Headers and Content Templates registered on DLT must adhere to prescribed guidelines. Additionally, a single Content Template cannot be linked to multiple Headers.

➤ In case misuse of headers or content templates of any Sender comes to the notice, TRAI has directed immediate suspension of traffic from all the Headers and Content Templates of that Sender for their verification. Revocation of traffic

In recent times, there has been a concerning surge in fraudulent activities targeting individuals through calls over WhatsApp and other sources. Fraudsters, posing as representatives of law enforcement agencies such as CID, CBI, or similar bodies, are resorting to deceitful tactics to extort money from unsuspecting victims.

These fraudulent callers are falsely informing individuals

that their son or daughter has been implicated in serious legal matters, such as rape cases/abetment to suicide cases/involving in Drugs and Narcotics cases etc. Exploiting the emotional vulnerability of parents, they demand gratification for the release of their children. Additionally, instances of college students being kidnapped and ransom demands made have also been reported.

The fraudulent calls often originate from numbers with the

country code +92. General public have been advised not to respond to such calls and to exercise caution, especially when receiving international WhatsApp calls from unknown numbers.

In order to tackle this threat and safeguard citizens from becoming victims of such schemes, the A&N Police encourages individuals to take proactive steps:

◆ Remain vigilant and cautious when receiving unsolicited

He pointed out that while the Act is stringent in punishing offenders and seizing illegal substances, it also offers avenues for rehabilitation, which is crucial in the fight against drug addiction. The NDPS Act serves not only as a deterrent but also as a means of offering a second chance to those who have fallen into the trap of drug abuse, highlighting a balanced approach in tackling this serious issue.

Secretary (Education), Shri L. Kumar, IAS, expressed profound gratitude to A&N SLSA and DLSA for organizing this crucial awareness initiative at JNRM. ◆ Refrain from engaging with individuals claiming to be from law enforcement agencies who ask for money or personal information over phone.

◆ Utilize the 'Chakshu-Report Suspected Fraud Communications' facility available on the Sanchar Saathi portal ([www.sancharsaathi.gov.in](http://www.sancharsaathi.gov.in)) to report fraudulent activities.

◆ Regularly check and verify mobile connections associated with your name using the 'Know Your Mobile Connections' feature on the Sanchar Saathi portal ([www.sancharsaathi.gov.in](http://www.sancharsaathi.gov.in)). Report any unauthorized connections immediately.

◆ Go to WhatsApp settings Privacy calls Silence unknown callers.

◆ Talk to your children/other relative/friend, directly on his/her mobile numbers, who is reportedly under distress, in order to verify.

These measures have been taken forward TRAI's initiatives to ensure a clean and secure messaging ecosystem, safeguarding consumer interests and preventing fraudulent activities.

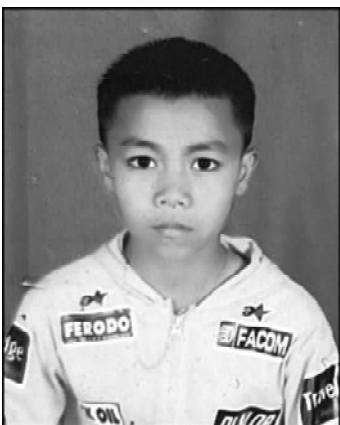

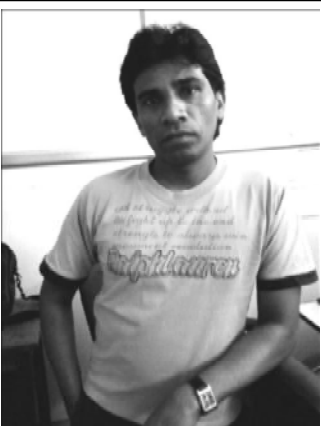
