

Court of India has constituted a Committee to oversee the road safety scenario in the country on a day to day basis. Students from the schools of nearby locality performed a Nukkad Natak showcasing the importance of observing road safety rules and losses, if these rules are not followed properly. The Secretary (Transport) therefore urged all present in the camp to understand the message given by the students through the beautifully executed street play and follow them in their life.

The Transport Department has conducted such road safety awareness camps in many different clusters and will continue to create awareness amongst the road users by conducting more and more awareness camps at different places. The Secretary (Transport) also mentioned that the benchmark for the success of this camp can be assessed by the fact that a good number of school students have not only attended the camps, but also sincerely participated in all the activities related to road safety, thereby enhancing their awareness on making the roads safer.

The Secretary (Transport) further stated that the goal of the Chief Secretary is to bring to the door steps of citizens, all the services rendered by Government Departments and the second aspect of the awareness camp is to provide all the services of Transport Department related to driver licensing, fitness and registration related activities of motor vehicles, road tax, permits, operation of bus service etc. to the citizen in the camp itself. He requested all the participants to benefit from the services provided by the Department in the Camp. He concluded with the remarks that the mission on road safety will only be successful with the active and constructive participation from the society.

Dr. Jatinder Sohal, Director (Transport) while addressing the gathering appealed to all road users to follow traffic laws in true spirit, which is the sign of any better society. He requested the gathering to make the road safety a part of life and share knowledge on road safety with others. While appreciating the Nukkad Nataks, he stated that the Nataks highlighted important aspects on road safety. He said that whatever is learned from the awareness camp will not only be useful to them but will also be passed on to the family as well as to others in the society so that they can also be made aware on road safety. He stressed that road safety is an important issue that should be talked about and should be cultivated in nature & family as one fatal accident causes untold sufferings to the whole family of the deceased. He advised all the road users to avoid using mobile phones while driving and desist from the habit of drunken driving. Concluding the address, he stated that such awareness camps will be held at regular intervals and requested the villagers to share their grievances and suggestions towards the services provided by Transport Department which will promptly be addressed.

The Deputy Director (Transport), welcomed the gathering and highlighted the importance of traffic laws. He advised citizens to follow the traffic rules to bring down road accident fatalities in the UT.

Representative from Education Department also shared with the participants the safety rules in detail which are to be practiced by every road users whether they are driving the vehicles or while walking on the

Labour Disputes: Resolution of disputes related to employment and workers' rights.

>Electricity and Water Bill Disputes (excluding non-compoundable matters) Fair settlement of billing disputes.

Maintenance Cases: Ensuring timely and fair maintenance for dependents. Civil Disputes: Peaceful resolution of civil issues, including property and contract disputes.

Disputes under the Consumer Protection Act: Addressing consumer grievances efficiently.

The public who have disputes falling within the above categories, whether at the pre-litigation or post-litigation stage, have been asked to come forward and participate in this Lok Adalat. This is an excellent opportunity to resolve the disputes amicably and avoid prolonged litigation.

#### **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

Expression of interest is invited from eligible person to be empanelled as support persons to POCSO victims as per NCPCR's Model Guidelines with respect to Support Persons under Section 39 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

#### **INTERVIEW:**

#### SELECTION/EMPANELMENT:

The DCPO shall empanel the selected candidates on the recommendations of the Selection Committee.

REMUNERATION OF SERVICES OF SUPPORT PERSONS:

- **a. Monthly Allowance:** The Support Person shall submit a report at the end of each month to the DCPO for review and remuneration as prescribed in Form A. (The Remuneration for the services of a support person whose name is enrolled in the register maintained under rule 5(1) or otherwise, shall be made by the State Government from the Fund maintained under Section 105 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 (2 of 2016), or from other funds placed at the disposal of the DCPU.)
- Any support person engaged for the purpose of assisting a child under this Act, shall be paid on a pro-rata basis, determined by the number of days worked or in-person visits conducted to locations such as Hospitals, Child Welfare Committee, police station, childcare institutions, the victim's family, educational institution, court, government department, banks etc. The Monthly remuneration based on assigned cases, shall be prescribed by the State Government, but which shall be calculated in a prorated manner basis the amount prescribed for a skilled worker under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948).
- Further, if a person empanelled as a support person has not been assigned any case or has not been providing support to a child, he/she shall not be entitled to claim remuneration.
- **b. Travel Allowance:** The support person shall be provided reimbursement as per actual for the travel undertaken with the minor victim on production of bills duly verified by CWC.
