## GST Commissionerate of A&N Administration cancels 25 fake GST registrations Detects above Rs. 2 Cr of fake Tax Credit

Port Blair, Aug. 23

Based on the intelligence and enforcement orders, the UTGST Officers had conducted an inspection of probable fake GST registration taken by forged/fake documents in Mayabunder, N & M Andaman. On reaching the premises, it was found that the addresses of the GST registrations were non-existent and the GST registrations were taken solely for the purpose of passing illegal ITC fraudulently. Forty-Five fake GST registrations have been identified which were obtained from 9 PAN numbers.

Out of these 45 registrations, 25 registrations have been cancelled. Remaining registrations falling outside the jurisdiction of UTGST Commissionerate will also be cancelled.

The Commissioner, UTGST, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, said that the Department has detected fake ITC evasion of around Rs.2 crore from May 2024 till date. He also said that special emphasis is being laid on identifying and apprehending the masterminds and disrupt syndicates, operating across A & N Islands. FIRs against the PAN numbers have

## PBMC steps up enforcement for effective waste segregation Secretary PBMC urges citizens to ensure waste segregation and avoid littering in open areas

Port Blair, Aug. 23

The Port Blair Municipal Council has intensified its efforts to achieve 100% source-segregated waste collection with enhanced door-to-door waste management efforts. On 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2024, an inspection and enforcement team, led by the Superintendent Engineer (SE) and including Assistant Engineers (AEs), the Junior Engineer (SWM) and Junior Engineers (Civil), assessed Ward Nos. 9 and 14 to ensure adherence to these regulations.

Under the #SafaiApnaoBimaaniBhagao (SABB) initiative, the team reinforced the necessity of segregating waste at the source, directing residents to properly sort their waste for collection by Safai Mitras at their doorsteps. Parallel inspections were conducted in Ward Nos. 13 and 17 on Aug. 22, 2024, with further inspections scheduled

First ever seizure of commercial quantity of Heroin valued at Rs.4 Crores by PS Crime & Economic Offence; four persons arrested

Port Blair, Aug. 23  
Based on an intelligence input, on Aug.19, 2024, a team comprising of Inspector Girish Kumar, SHO, PS Crime & Economic Offence (CID) under the supervision and presence of Shri Kumar Abhishek, Dy.SP (CID) and Executive Magistrate conducted raid in the rented house of Susankar Das @ Chotu, Pvt. Driver, R/o Dollygunj, permanent resident of Diglipur and recovered 435 grams of Heroin from his possession and he was arrested.  
A case under relevant sections of NDPS Act-1985 has been registered at PS C&EO and investigation is in progress. During investigation, accused Susankar Das @ Chotu was put under sustained interrogation and the involvement of co-accused Kiron Chandra Halder, R/o Shantipur 10, Swadesh Nagar and the main supplier Kishor Halder, R/o Cutbert Bay, Billiground was ascertained.  
Accordingly, a team led by SI Shaji Mathew of PS Crime & Economic Offence was deputed to Billiground & Cutbert Bay and after thorough search, another 410 grams of Heroin was recovered from the possession of Kiron and subsequently he was arrested. On interrogation, he disclosed that his son namely Kishor Halder, had supplied the whole recovered Heroin and subsequently Kishor was also arrested.  
During sustained interrogation of arrested accused persons, involvement of one Subendu Das, Pvt. Worker, R/o Shantipur No.10, Billiground was ascertained as a carrier for transportation and supply of heroin and he was also arrested.  
Till now, total 845 grams of Heroin has been recovered having value of Rs.4 Crores (approx.) in international market. The hard work and immediate action of team of PS Crime and Economic Offence has resulted in the first ever seizure of commercial quantity of Heroin following arrest of four accused persons breaking the chain of supplier, carrier and distributor.  
The raids were conducted under the command of Shri Kumar Abhishek, Dy.SP (CID) and under overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID), a press release from SP (CID) said.

He said, another major flagship automation project Digi Yatra is also in pipeline, which is an advanced technology-based passenger processing solution that provides contactless, seamless movement of passengers at various check points at airports based on facial recognition technology.
