

supersonic surface-to-surface missiles, surface-to-air missiles and rapid-fire gun systems. Both ships feature Combined Diesel or Gas propulsion plants and a state-of-the-art Integrated Platform Management System, enabling higher speeds and improved fuel efficiency. These are the 100th and 101st warships designed inhouse by the Warship Design Bureau of the Indian Navy, and built in India, reflecting the Navy's continuous effort to enhance indigenous content and selfreliance. High indigenous content - exceeding 75% - has been achieved through the participation of numerous MSMEs and the procurement of major weapons and sensors from Indian Original Equipment Manufacturers.




