### Hon'ble MP urges Centre for urgent sanction of funds and construction of additional bridge at Chatham Causeway

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 28

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, has made an urgent appeal to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport & Highways, Shri Nitin Gadkari, and Hon'ble Minister of Ports, Shipping & Waterways, Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, along with the Hon'ble Lt. Governor and Chief Secretary of A&N Islands, seeking immediate sanction of funds and early commencement of construction of an additional bridge at Chatham Causeway, which has now become a matter of public urgency and strategic importance.

In his letter dated 26.08.2025, he stated that the Chatham Causeway, constructed in 1970 by ALHW, serves as the only road link between Sri Vijaya

Puram and Chatham Island. It is home to vital establishments like the Government Saw Mill and Power House, where over 1,000 employees are engaged in daily operations. The causeway is also critical for the transportation of goods, raw materials, machinery, fuel and essential equipment, and serves as a lifeline for thousands of commuters. Furthermore, since the Chatham Jetty is a vital embarkation point for ferry services to Bambooflat, the causeway has, over the decades, become a lifeline for thousands of daily commuters including Government officials, students, patients, traders and the general public.

The NHIDCL has now been tasked with preparing a feasibility study and DPR. However, Shri Ray said that the process is time-consuming and delays in sanctioning funds could jeopardize the safety, mobility, and

livelihood of the islanders.

Highlighting the plight of the people, Hon'ble MP Shri Ray said "earlier, all categories of vehicles including buses, autos, cars and trucks were able to reach Chatham Jetty for boarding/de-boarding. Now, in the absence of alternative arrangements, people are suffering extreme hardship."

Therefore, Hon'ble MP has urged the Centre for urgent measures viz. Direct NHIDCL to complete the feasibility study and submit the DPR in a strict time-bound manner; earmark and sanction the required funds immediately and accord Administrative Approval & Expenditure Sanction (AA & ES) for construction of an additional bridge between Chatham Island and PS Chatham, Haddo, treating it as a special case of public urgency; and direct the

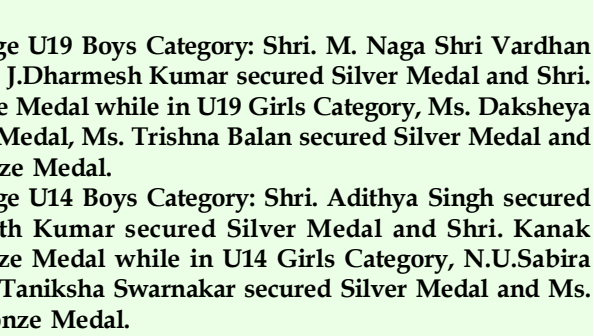

Napier in airtight conditions, retains nutrients for sustained use.

At CLF, Sitanagar, Shri Biplab Das, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Sitanagar, joined 18 livestock farmers from the Diglipur zone. Shri Das commended the initiative of AH&VS for supporting the livestock community. Dr. Tejal, Senior Veterinary Officer, CLF, Sitanagar, highlighted that quality silage should be greenish-yellow to golden-brown, with a sweet-sour vinegar-like smell and moist texture. Shri Abdul Inayat, Agriculture Demonstrator, conducted a step-by-step demonstration, covering fodder cutting, mixing with mineral supplements, pit preparation or silage bag selection, layering, pressing, and sealing for 45 days. The Senior Veterinary Officer, Diglipur, encouraged farmers to adopt silage making at home.
