## Hon'ble PM releases 20<sup>th</sup> instalment of PM-KISAN transferring more than Rs 20,500 crore to over 9.7 crore farmers

New Delhi, Aug. 2 (PIB)

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone and inaugurated development works worth around Rs 2,200 crore in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh today. Highlighting the grand celebration of the farmer festival being held in Varanasi, the Prime Minister announced that Rs.21,000 crore had been transferred to the bank accounts of 10 crore farmer brothers and sisters across the country under the PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme.

Affirming that the Government is consistently working towards the prosperity of farmers, Shri Modi emphasized that their



Government delivers on its promises, citing the PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi as a testament to the Government's firm commitment. Till date, he mentioned that Rs.3.75 lakh

crore has been transferred directly into farmers' accounts. In Uttar Pradesh alone, around 2.5 crore farmers have benefited, receiving over Rs.90,000 crore under the scheme. He highlighted that the most significant aspect of the scheme is that the funds have reached farmers without any deductions or commissions. He stated that this is a permanent arrangement established by his Government-there will be no leakage, and the rights of the poor will not be denied.

## Election Commission doubles the remuneration for Booth Level Officers; Enhances remuneration for BLO Supervisors ECI also decides to give honorarium to ERO & AEROs

New Delhi, Aug. 2 (PIB)

Pure electoral rolls are the bedrock of democracy. The electoral roll machinery, consisting of Electoral Registration Officers (EROs), Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs), BLO Supervisors and Booth Level Officers (BLOs), do a lot of hard work and play a pivotal role in preparation of impartial and transparent electoral rolls. The Commission has therefore, decided to double the annual remuneration for BLOs & also enhanced the remuneration of BLO Supervisors involved in the preparation and revision of electoral rolls. The last such revision was done in 2015. Also, honorarium has been provided for EROs and AEROs for the first time.

## Hon'ble MP meets Additional Secretary (Home), MHA; requests to expedite issues concerning A&N Islands

As part of his continued efforts to address the important issues concerning the A&N Islands, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, met the Additional Secretary (Home), Ministry of Home Affairs, in New Delhi on Aug. 1, 2025.

During the meeting, the Hon'ble MP discussed the status of multiple matters he had previously raised with the Ministry of Home Affairs and urged for their expeditious resolution. A key point of discussion was the long-pending demand for framing of a domicile-based job reservation policy for local candidates of the A&N Islands, along with enhancement of the upper age limit to 40 years for recruitment to Group (NG) and Group 'C' posts, in line with the provisions already extended to the Union Territory of Ladakh. Shri Ray reiterated that he has already taken up this matter with the Hon'ble Prime Minister and the Hon'ble Home Minister in this regard. Further, Shri Ray brought to



attention the matter of 23 qualified candidates from A&N Islands, who were excluded from being called for interview by UPSC for the post of Assistant Professors. The Hon'ble MP strongly requested that this

## Andaman to open Aves Island to tourists, plans luxury eco-resorts across five Islands

### The new eco-tourism resorts will be set up at Shaheed Dweep, Megapode Resort in Sri Vijaya Puram, Aves Island, Long Island, and Smith Island

To boost eco-tourism in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the administration has announced plans to develop five-star resorts at five locations, including the previously inaccessible Aves Island, which will be opened to tourists for the first time.

Officials said that the new eco-tourism resorts will be set up at Shaheed Dweep, Megapode Resort in Sri Vijaya Puram, Aves Island, Long Island, and Smith Island in the North and Middle Andaman districts. The Andaman and Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Limited (ANIIDCO) has invited bids for these projects under a public-private partnership model, following a design, build, finance, operate and transfer framework.

Aves Island, known for its vast coconut plantations and coral flat beds, will be opened for tourism for the first time. Located close to Mayabunder town, the island



features a two-kilometre coastline and is considered ideal for nature-based activities such as camping. "It is close to the Mayabunder town and has live and

dead coral flat beds along with a 2-km coastline, making it an ideal destination for campers," officials said. A trek through the island's lush coconut groves will lead

visitors to a lighthouse situated at its southern tip.

The administration owns a 2.75-hectare parcel of land on Aves Island, which will be

leased to ANIIDCO for development. The proposed resort is expected to require an investment of nearly ₹36 crore and will include 50 rooms. Planned amenities include a shopping area, wellness centre, and a range of recreational offerings such as scuba diving, fishing, trekking and camping.

At Long Island, the proposed resort at Lalaji Bay will involve an estimated investment of Rs.391 crore and provide 220 rooms. The Smith Island project is expected to cost Rs.60

more backward a region, the higher the priority it receives", Shri Modi announced that earlier this month, the Central Government approved a major new initiative-the Pradhan Mantri Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana. He informed that Rs.24,000 crore will be allocated for this scheme. The Prime Minister emphasized that the focus of this initiative will be on areas with low agricultural output and where farmers' incomes remain limited. He stated that the Pradhan Mantri Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana will directly benefit millions of farmers in Uttar Pradesh as well.

"Our Government is working with full strength to transform the lives of farmers, increase their income, and reduce the cost of cultivation, We stand firmly with farmers from seed to market", emphasised the Prime Minister, highlighting that to ensure water reaches the fields, irrigation schemes worth lakhs of crores of rupees are being implemented across the country.

Shri Modi acknowledged that weather has always posed a major challenge for farmers-be it excessive rainfall, hailstorms, or frost. To protect farmers from such uncertainties, the Government launched the PM Fasal Bima Yojana. He informed that under this scheme, farmers have received claim settlements amounting to over Rs.1.75 lakh crore so far.

Affirming that the Government is committed to ensuring farmers receive fair prices for their produce, the Prime Minister stated that record increases have been made in the Minimum Support Price (MSP) of crops, including key staples like rice and wheat. To safeguard farmers' harvests, the Government is constructing thousands of new warehouses across the country, he added

Emphasising the Government's focus on increasing women's participation in the agricultural economy, Shri Modi highlighted the "Lakhpati Didi" campaign, with a target of creating three crore Lakhpati Didis across India. He noted that over 1.5 crore women have already achieved this milestone. He also mentioned that the Government's "Drone Didi" initiative has significantly boosted the income of lakhs of women.

The Prime Minister stated that the Government is actively working to bring modern agricultural research directly to the fields. He mentioned that a specially designed Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan was conducted during May and June 2025, under the guiding principle of "Lab to Land," through which direct engagement was made with over 1.25 crore farmers. He emphasized that the benefits of Central Government schemes must continue reaching all citizens seamlessly.

Sharing an important update with the public, Shri Modi said, "Under the Jan Dhan Yojana, 55 crore bank accounts have been opened for the poor across the country". He informed that the scheme recently completed ten years and as per regulations, bank accounts require fresh KYC verification after ten years. He added that to fulfill this requirement, a nationwide campaign has been launched from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2025. The Prime Minister said that banks were reaching every gram panchayat, and camps have already been set up in nearly one lakh gram panchayats, while lakhs of people have successfully completed their KYC renewal. The Prime Minister urged every individual who holds a Jan Dhan account to ensure they complete their KYC process without delay.

Underlining an additional benefit of the special bank camps being organized in gram panchayats, Shri Modi stated that these camps are facilitating registrations for several key schemes, including the Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana, and Atal Pension Yojana. He emphasized that these schemes offer significant support to citizens and urged everyone to visit these camps. He encouraged those who have not yet enrolled in these schemes to register and also complete the KYC process for their Jan Dhan accounts. The Prime Minister called upon all public representatives of their party to actively raise awareness about this campaign, assist banks in their outreach efforts, and ensure maximum participation from the public.

**5. Power to relax:**

Where the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, By order and for the reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Savings:**

Nothing in his rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belong to the Schedule castes, Schedule Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
