Major step towards simplifying property transactions & promoting ease of doing business

District Administration, SA withdraws No-Dues Certificate requirement for property registration

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 29

The District Administration, South Andaman has taken a major step towards simplifying property transactions and promoting ease of doing business. In a significant decision, the mandatory requirement of producing a No-Dues Certificate from the Municipal Council, Sri Vijaya Puram for the registration of sale deeds and other property-related instruments in the Office of the Sub-Registrar, South Andaman has been withdrawn with immediate effect.

Until now, the checklist incorporated in the National Generic Document Registration System (NGDRS) portal required parties to furnish a No-Dues Certificate issued by the Municipal Council before registering property-related documents. However, upon review, it has been observed

that neither the Registration Act, 1908 nor the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 contains any statutory provision mandating such a requirement.

Section 17 of the Registration Act, 1908 specifies the documents which are compulsorily registrable, while Section 71 empowers the Sub-Registrar to refuse documents only on grounds of non-compliance with provisions of the said Act or the rules framed thereunder. Similarly, the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 does not impose the production of a No-Dues Certificate from the Municipal Council as a pre-condition for transfer or registration of property.

Recognizing that such additional requirements create avoidable hurdles for citizens, the A & N Administration has decided to remove this non-statutory condition. This

decision is in line with the Government of India's commitment to ensuring hassle-free citizen services, improving transparency, and reducing procedural bottlenecks under the Ease of Doing Business framework.

The Deputy Commissioner, exercising powers under the Registration Act, 1908, has therefore ordered that the requirement of producing a No-Dues Certificate from the Municipal Council, Sri Vijaya Puram, shall stand withdrawn with immediate effect. All concerned officers, including the Sub-Registrar, South Andaman, have been directed to ensure strict compliance with this order.

This reform is expected to provide significant relief to citizens by streamlining property registrations and removing an unnecessary step in the process, a press release from DC (SA) said.

India, Shri C. Raj, Director, RSETI, Shri P. K. Ummer Farooq, Chief Manager, UTLBC A&N Islands, Shri Vivek Bharati, LDO, RBI, Shri E. Pratap, AGM, NABARD, Shri Anil, Assistant Engineer, NRSE, along with representatives from banks and Government Departments.

The Deputy Commissioner emphasized the need for greater outreach and disbursement under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, urging banks to popularize the scheme among citizens and also explore credit facilities for traders and hoteliers to install solar power systems in commercial establishments. As of 30th June, 2025, a total of 36 applications had been received under the scheme, out of which, 30 were sanctioned. Shri Santosh Sahu informed that State Bank of India is offering loans up to Rs.10 crore under the 'Surya Shakti Solar Finance' scheme to support SME and non-SME enterprises in setting up solar projects.

Reviewing the progress of Pradhan Mantri Flagship Schemes, the Deputy Commissioner directed banks to cover all eligible citizens under PMSBY, PMJJBY and APY. While appreciating the efforts of some banks, he noted that overall performance remained unsatisfactory and instructed banks to engage their field staff more effectively to enroll all eligible beneficiaries.

With regard to PM Vishwakarma Yojana, it was informed that 215 loan applications were received by banks, out of which 77 were sanctioned. The Deputy Commissioner directed early sanctioning of all pending cases to ensure timely benefits to artisans and craftsmen.

On Priority Sector Lending (PSL), it was highlighted that banks achieved 32.75% performance, disbursing Rs.542.79 crore during the first quarter against the annual target of Rs.1657.34 crore. The Deputy Commissioner reiterated that banks must achieve the statutory PSL target mandated by the Reserve Bank of India.

The meeting also reviewed the Credit Deposit Ratio, which stood at 63.07%, reflecting a decline of 2.85% during the quarter. The Deputy Commissioner directed banks to analyze the reasons for the reduction and initiate corrective measures.

Shri C. Raj, Director, RSETI, briefed the gathering on training initiatives and informed that the first batch of LMV driver training under the 'SARTHANI' scheme will commence at Swaraj Dweep from Aug. 30. He also apprised that progress on land allotment for RSETI was underway. The Deputy Commissioner instructed that annual training targets must be achieved in a time-bound manner.

The Deputy Commissioner concluded the meeting by calling upon all banks and institutions to work in close coordination for the effective implementation of schemes and to extend the benefits of financial inclusion to every eligible citizen of South Andaman, a press release from DC (SA) said.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of the undersigned that, as on date, the production of a *No-Dues Certificate* issued by the Municipal Council, Sri Vijaya Puram has been prescribed as a mandatory requirement for the registration of sale deeds and other property-related instruments in the Office of the Sub-Registrar, South Andaman, as per the check-list incorporated in the online registration portal, *National Document Registration System (NGDRS)*.

And whereas, it is observed that there is no express statutory requirement under the Registration Act, 1908 or the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 mandating submission of such a certificate as a pre-condition for registration of documents.

And whereas, the Section 17 of the Registration Act, 1908 specifies the documents which are compulsorily registrable and Section 71 empowers the Sub-Registrar to refuse documents only on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of the said Act or the rules framed thereunder. Similarly, under the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, no clause has been provided which makes the production of a *No-Dues Certificate* from the Municipal Council a statutory pre-condition for the validity or registration of property transfers.

And whereas, the Government of India is committed to promoting Ease of Doing Business and providing simple and hassle-free services to the public, the requirement of a *No-Dues Certificate* from the Municipal Council is considered unnecessary and creates an avoidable hurdle in property transactions.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the undersigned as the Deputy Commissioner under the Registration Act, 1908, it is hereby ordered that the requirement of production of *No-Dues Certificate* from the Municipal Council, Sri Vijaya Puram, for land/property registration in the Office of the Sub-Registrar, South Andaman, is withdrawn with immediate effect.

The Sub-Registrar, South Andaman and all other concerned officers shall ensure strict compliance of this order forthwith.
