## PM Modi to participate in SCO Summit in Tianjin, China today

Tianjin, Aug. 30

The 25<sup>th</sup> Summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) will begin tomorrow (Aug. 31) in Tianjin, China. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will participate and join global leaders in the two-day deliberations.

The summit will review 25 years of the organization's achievements and also adopt a ten-year development strategy. China is hosting the SCO Summit for the fifth time, with President, Mr. Xi Jinping chairing the proceedings. More than 20 heads of state and 10 leaders of international organisations are expected to attend.



Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi and Russian President, Mr. Vladimir Putin are among the prominent participants, making this summit the largest and most ambitious in the history of the organisation. Meanwhile, Prime

## Major relief for A&N Islands: Hon'ble Union Minister, Shri Nitin Gadkari Ji approves Rs.4998.69 Lakh for 90 road works; Hon'ble MP expresses gratitude

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, during the visit of Shri Nitin Gadkari ji, Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, to Sri Vijaya Puram, had highlighted before him on 28.12.2024 that due to the limited UT budget under the capital head, it would not be possible to create or improve vital infrastructure, particularly the repair and renovation of roads across the A&N Islands including the

Municipal areas, without financial assistance from the Centre under the CRIF scheme.

Taking cognizance, Shri Nitin Gadkari Ji, Hon'ble Minister, immediately assured his support and during review meeting held at Raj Niwas on 28.12.2024 directed the A&N Administration to prepare and submit detailed estimates. Acting swiftly, the A&N Administration prepared and submitted road proposals for repairs, renovation and upgradation in the

Municipal area and other rural area under APWD divisions in April and July 2025.

Responding positively, the Hon'ble Minister accorded his in-principle approval on the spot on 07/08/2025 and in a landmark decision, conveyed the formal sanction order to the A&N Administration on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 for 90 road works including 49 works covering all 24 Municipal Wards and 41 works under APWD Divisions (CD-III Prothrapur - 5 works, RCD Wimberlygunj - 29 works, MID Hut Bay - 05

works and CD Campbell Bay - 02 works) at a total estimated cost of Rs. 4998.69 lakhs.

## UT Census Coordination Committee reviews preparations for Census 2027 in A&N Islands

### Chief Secretary emphasized the need to pay special attention to enumeration in tribal areas to ensure inclusivity and accuracy

The Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has begun preparations for the upcoming Census of India 2027. The first meeting of the UT-level Census Coordination Committee, constituted to monitor the exercise at the highest level, was held on August 29 under the chairmanship of Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Islands. Secretaries from various Departments of the UT Administration participated in the meeting. Ms. Purva Garg, IAS, Director of



Census Operations and Convenor of the meeting, made a detailed presentation outlining the tentative Census calendar, progress of preparatory work, and the new innovations to be

adopted. She apprised the Committee that the 2027 Census will be conducted digitally across the country, in two phases - House Listing & Housing Census (HLO) and P o p u l a t i o n

Enumeration (PE). She also briefed that prelude to actual Census, a pre-test of House Listing and Housing Census is planned to be held in October-November 2025 in selected areas of all the three districts of A&N Islands.

The Chief Secretary emphasized the need to pay special attention to enumeration in tribal areas to ensure inclusivity and accuracy. In response, the Director of Census Operations assured that all necessary steps would be taken, a press release from Directorate of Census said.
