Sarpanch and other Panchayati Raj Institution (PRI) members also attended, reinforcing community support for the initiative. Their presence highlighted the significance of collaborative efforts in advancing animal husbandry

The technical session covered essential aspects of goat rearing, including shed construction, balanced feeding, farm operations, and the prevention and control of common diseases. Veterinary experts provided practical guidance to equip farmers with skills to improve goat health and productivity. Reading materials and plastic basins were distributed to support the implementation of these practices. The training will continue on August 7, 2025, with a veterinary camp and distribution of medicines to further assist farmers in maintaining the healthy livestock.

This initiative reflects the AH&VS Department's commitment to strengthening animal husbandry activities in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The active participation of farmers and local leaders underscores the community's enthusiasm for adopting modern farming techniques. The department plans to conduct similar programs across other regions to ensure farmers have access to essential knowledge and resources, aligning with the A&N Administration's vision of fostering sustainable rural development and economic empowerment through livestock management, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

officials from various Departments with the necessary knowledge and skills to address evolving cyber threats.

In his address, Shri Jitendra Meena emphasized the urgent need for cyber awareness and readiness, especially in the face of increasing ransomware attacks and threats to critical infrastructure. He highlighted that cybersecurity is a shared responsibility, and that every individual has a role in safeguarding digital systems and data.

Delivering the keynote address, Shri Sushant Padha, Special Secretary (IT), underlined the importance of inclusive awareness, stating that cybersecurity impacts multiple stakeholder groups-technical officials, law enforcement agencies, educators, students, and the community at large. He also announced the pilot launch of ISEA Cyber Security Clubs in five selected schools viz. Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School, Govt. Boys Sr. Sec. School, Govt. Girls Sr. Sec. School, GSSS Bhatubasti and GSSS School Line.

Shri Ritesh R Dhote, Scientist-E from C-DAC Patna, provided an overview of the workshop and encouraged participants to fully engage with the sessions and benefit from the expertise of the C-DAC trainers.

The event witnessed participation from around 100 delegates, including officials from Department of IT, SOVTECH, and faculty and students from institutions like DBRAIT, JNRM, and Tagore College. Simultaneously, Cyber Awareness Programmes are also being conducted in North & Middle Andaman to further extend the outreach.

The programme began with a welcome address by Ms. Nazima Parveen, Project Manager, State Data Centre, SOVTECH. The vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Shrabani Mallick, OSD (IT), Department of IT, A&N Administration, a press release from Department of IT said.

key locations in the district.

The camps aim to raise community-level awareness on Tuberculosis (TB) and eral lung health, screen vulnerable populations for early symptoms, and connec citizens to essential health services. The initiative also includes Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) creation and Avushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Ian Arogva Yojana (AB-PMJAY) Card generation, thereby ensuring health security for all eligible individuals.

The camps were successfully held at Community Hall, Haddo and School Line covering Ward Nos. 01 & Ward No.16 with a total of 67 and 53 people attending respectively. During the camp, Chest X-rays were conducted using state-of-the-art hand-held X-ray machines provided by ICMR-RMRC. Apart from this, general health check-ups, including blood pressure and blood sugar screenings were carried out by trained medical staff. Screening for TB symptoms and assessment of vulnerability criteria by doctors from the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP) were also done. ABHA IDs and PM-JAY e-Cards were generated for eligible participants to enable digital health records and access to free healthcare under the Ayushman Bharat scheme.

In a strong gesture of support and community engagement, Shri S. Shahul Hameed, Chairperson, SVPMC/Councillor of Ward No. 01, and Shri C. Karunanidhi, Councillor of Ward No. 16, attended the camp, encouraging public participation and setting a commendable example of Jan Bhagidari (people's participation) in health initiatives.

The District Administration appeals to the public to actively participate in the upcoming screening camps and take full advantage of the health services being provided. Early detection and timely treatment remain the most effective tools in the fight against Tuberculosis.

The schedule of subsequent camps across other wards has been notified and is available with the respective Health & Wellness Centres and Urban Local Bodies, a press release from NTEP said.

The authorization letter should have three (03) specimen signature of the recipient. The Adhaar card copy of the candidate and the recipient should be enclosed with the
- 3. The candidates shall make their own arrangement to reach the venue at the reporting time and no TA/DA will be paid for attending the trade test.
- 4. Use of mobile phone or any other electronic gadgets will be strictly prohibited at the venue during the Trade Test.
- 5. No change in the date, time and venue of trade test shall be allowed for any candidate under any circumstances. If the candidate fails to attend the trade test, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested for the test and his/her candidature will be summarily rejected/cancelled at that stage itself and no further communication will be made.
- 6. In case the trade test of the candidate could not be held on particular day, due to some unforeseen reasons like natural calamity etc., trade test of the candidates fixed on that particular date will be held on a different date and the candidate will be informed separately.


