Speaking on the surge in Bio



economy, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Earth Sciences, MoS PMO, Department of Atomic Energy, Department of Space, Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr. Jitendra Singh said "India's bio economy has experienced remarkable growth, skyrocketing from \$10 billion in 2014 to over \$130 billion in 2024, with projections to reach \$300 billion by 2030. It establishes cutting-edge bio manufacturing facilities, bio foundry clusters, and Bio-AI hubs, he added. The Minister said, renewed focus is on ethical biosafety considerations and global regulatory harmonization by aligning with international standards.

Giving special emphasis on employment generation potential of the policy, Dr. Jitendra Singh said "It is expected to generate substantial employment opportunities, particularly in tier-II and tier-III cities, where bio manufacturing hubs will be set up. These hubs will leverage local biomass sources, thereby enhancing economic development in these regions."

Major drug bust: PS Billiground seizes
2.4 kg of heroin valued at Rs 16 crore

Billiground, Aug. 26

In a significant crackdown on illegal drug trafficking, the team from PS Billiground, conducted an extensive search operation in and around Curtbert Bay which resulted in the seizure of a large quantity of psychotropic substance, suspected to be Heroin, weighing 2.470 kg. The estimated market value of the seized drugs is approximately Rs 16 crore.

On 24.08.2024, a Police team led by SI MV Shiju Kumar, SHO PS Billiground, during a meticulous search in the secluded region of Curtbert Bay, discovered an unclaimed plastic bucket containing six packets marked with a foreign language. Upon inspection and testing, the packets were confirmed to contain heroin, a prohibited psychotropic substance. The seized items were confiscated following all legal formalities, and a formal inquiry was initiated. Given that the quantity seized exceeds the commercial threshold, an FIR has been registered at PS Billiground under NDPS Act and investigation is underway to identify and apprehend those involved in this illegal drug trade.

The whole operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Rahul L Nair, IPS, SDPO Rangat and overall direction and supervision of Ms. Geetanjali Khandelwal, IPS, Superintendent of Police, North& Middle Andaman District. The other members of the Police team included ASI M S Muthu, ASI Diana, ASI Rajni Babu, HC Bawali, PCs Mustafa, Sujan, and Abhijeet.

- **Clean Water:-** Provide clean drinking water in containers that are stable and not easily tipped over preferably in metal bowls with large mouth.
- **Emergency Veterinary Services:-** Coordinate with local veterinary services to ensure quick response and treatment for sick or injured animals.
- **Community Participation and Volunteer Programs:-** Encourage local volunteers to participate in sheltering, and monitoring the health of stray animals. Also, encourage community members to allow stray animals to take shelter in their porches, garages, or any other covered space, if available.
- **Drainage, Water and Waste Management:-** Ensure proper drainage systems to prevent water logging, which can pose a threat to stray animals. Also, encourage proper disposal of waste to prevent contamination of food and water sources for stray animals.

The local Animal Welfare Organizations, District Administration and Compassionate citizen have been requested to work towards raising community awareness and involvement in taking care of community animals by conducting public awareness campaigns, utilizing social media, posters, and community meetings. 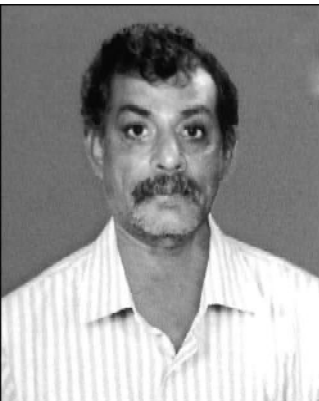
