State Level Mock Disaster Management
Exercise -2024 conducted successfully in Isles

Exercise focused upon effectiveness of information dissemination, alert
& warning and response of IRTs to save precious lives and property

Port Blair, Aug.30
A State Level Mock Disaster Management Exercise (SLME-2024) was conducted today by the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration in coordination with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), INCOIS, ANC, NDRF, District Administrations and other Emergency Support Functionaries (ESFs) of A&N Islands by creating a scenario on Earthquake followed by Tsunami. The objective of this exercise was to test Incident Response System (IRS) and the level of preparedness of all stakeholders in A&N Islands.

The SLME - 2024 started with the receipt of first bulletin at 0907 hrs from INCOIS, Hyderabad in the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC), Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan, Port Blair.

During the Exercise, Tsunami Sirens were blown in entire UT of A&N Islands. Alerts and warnings were issued, Operations of Incident Response Teams (IRTs) carried out in the identified incident sites, Search and Rescue teams were deployed from District Administration. Help was also sought from A&N Command and NDRF in search & rescue as well as evacuation operations. Various Departments including Police, APWD, Shipping, Controller of Ports, PBMC, Education etc were engaged in different tasks. With the help of A&N Command, airdropping and aerial survey of various low-lying inundated areas in N&M and Nicobar districts were also carried out. All activities like Evacuation, Search & Rescue, Medical Support, Setting up relief shelter, use of various Equipment & Material, providing of relief, Transport (Air/Ship/Road) arrangement, deployment of Personnel/Volunteer/NGOs etc. have been successfully carried out to manage the Earthquake and Tsunami scenario in ANI. A dedicated Command and Control Room was setup at the Conference Room of Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan at Port Blair. All the communications were done through State Emergency Operation Center as well as through District EOCs.

Shri ASPS Raviprakash, IAS, Secretary, Disaster Management, A&N Administration, Director,



Disaster Management, Shri Azharuddin Zahiruddin Quazi, IAS and Comdt. (Retd.) Aditya Kumar, Sr. Consultant, NDMA, New Delhi monitored the State Level Mock Exercise from the Situation Room of the Directorate of Disaster Management. Officials from Situation Room also interacted virtually through Video Conferencing with the Officials of Districts and ESFs in different Islands and took stock of their alertness, response and preparedness to deal with the situation in the wake of a disaster. Hotlines, Satellite Phones and VHF sets were utilized as an alternate channels of communications with the Districts and other EOC in-charges. Requirement of Men and Material were taken from simulation sites and immediate orders were issued to Line Departments for providing the required personnel as well material. Requests for providing additional equipment and other emergency support were also made to A&N Command, MHA and NDMA.

This Exercise focused upon effectiveness of information dissemination, alert & warning, and response of IRTs to save precious lives and property. The Exercise ended with All Clear Message issued from SEOC to all EOCs & Stakeholders.

Later, a Debriefing session was held in the Situation Room of

Directorate of Disaster Management under the chairmanship of Shri ASPS Raviprakash, IAS, Secretary (DM), A&N Administration wherein all the activities carried out during this Exercise by the District Administrations, Line Departments, A&N Command, NDRF, INCOIS, Incident Commanders and nominated observers, were comprehensively reviewed and

feedbacks were taken from all stakeholders and observers.

Thereafter, Comdt. (Retd.) Aditya Kumar, Sr. Consultant, NDMA, New Delhi, identified the gaps and key areas that need attention of the Administration. He also appreciated the efforts of all IRTs, District Administrations, NDRF, ANC and other stakeholders for successful

CBDT rolls out Dispute Resolution Scheme
(e-DRS)-2022 to minimise litigation

Dispute Resolution Committees constituted in all 18
jurisdictional Pr. CCIT regions across the country

New Delhi, Aug. 30 (PIB)

In pursuance of section 245MA in the Income-tax Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the

Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) had notified the e-Dispute Resolution Scheme, 2022 (e-DRS) with the aim to reduce litigation and provide relief to eligible

taxpayers. Section 245MA of the Act also provides for the constitution of Dispute Resolution Committees (DRC).

The e-DRS enables the taxpayer, who fulfils certain specified conditions as stipulated in section 245MA of the Act, to file an application electronically for dispute resolution to

the DRC designated for the region of Principal Commissioner of Income-tax having jurisdiction over the taxpayer. To this end, DRCs have been constituted in all 18 jurisdictional Pr. CCIT regions across the country. The list of such DRCs along with their e-mail addresses is available on: <https://www.incometax.gov.in/iec/foportal/help/all-topics/statutory-forms/file-statutory-form/popular-form/form-34-BC>.

As per e-DRS, a taxpayer can opt for e-Dispute Resolution against the 'specified order' as defined in clause (b) of the Explanation to section 245MA of the Act,

which includes an order in which the aggregate sum of variations proposed or made does not exceed Rs.10 lakh and returned income for the relevant assessment year does not exceed Rs. 50 lakh. Further, such order should not be based on search/surveys or information received

exceeding Rs.1,00,000/- through adopting sustainable livelihood practices with an average monthly income of rupees ten thousand or more sustained for at least 4 agricultural seasons and/ or four business cycles.

During the programme, hands-on training on preparation of Vermi compost and Bio-pesticides like Jeevamrit and Neemashtra from the locally available materials was demonstrated, so that they can prepare and sell it to other farmers exploring the vast potential in view of promotion of organic farming in the Islands. Further, the process of cinnamon extraction was also conducted in view of promotion of spices cultivation in the area and its vast demand in these Islands.

Altogether, 35 members of 6 SHGs namely Joy Guru, Maruti, Deep, Anmol, Ekta and Shiva of Kishorinagar, Parangara and Srinagar village under Kishorinagar Gram Panchayat attended the training programme.

Similar program was also conducted on Aug. 24 at Spices Demonstration Farm, Kalighat wherein 15 members of 6 SHGs were imparted training to enhance their skills, knowledge for increasing their income for attaining a decent livelihood. Smti Protima Roy, Pradhan of Gram Panchayat, Nabagram and other PRI Members were also present to motivate the SHG Members. Similar programmes will also be conducted in Diglipur Block for all interested SHG Members, a press release from Department of Agriculture said.

under an agreement referred to under section 90 or 90A of the Act. According to e-DRS, a DRC may make modification to the variations in the specified order and decide to grant reduction/waiver of penalty and prosecution in accordance with the provision of rule 44DAC of the Income-tax Rules, 1962 (hereinafter referred to as "the Rules"). The DRC is mandated to pass its order within six months from the end of month in which application for dispute resolution is admitted by it.

The application for e-DRS is to be filed in Form No. 34BC referred in rule 44DAB of the Rules, on the e-filing portal of the Income Tax Department, within one month from the date of receipt of specified order. In cases where appeal has already been filed and is pending before the Commissioner of Income-tax (Appeals), the application for e-DRS, is to be filed on or before 30.09.2024. In cases where the specified order has been passed on or before 31.08.2024 and the time for filing appeal against such order before CIT (Appeals) has not lapsed, the application for dispute resolution can be filed on or before 30.09.2024.

The Tax Payer can access e-DRS module by login on income tax portal <https://eportal.incometax.gov.in>. Login to your account using PAN / TAN as user ID->Go to Dashboard ->e-File ->Income Tax Forms ->File Income Tax Forms -> under tab 'Persons not dependent on any source of Income (Source of Income not relevant)> Dispute Resolution Committee in Certain Cases (Form 34BC) -> Fill Form No. 34BC -> Review the details -> E-Verify the Form No. 34BC using Aadhar OTP, EVC or DSC. This is another initiative by the Government towards minimising litigation.




