District Administration, SA imposes fines against illegal extraction of Earth

The District Administration, South Andaman has taken strict action against individuals involved in illegal extraction and dumping of Earth, in contravention of the Land Revenue Regulations and Mines and Mineral Rules.

During a recent field inspection at Teylerabad village, revenue officials detected unauthorized activities involving the extraction and leveling of earth using heavy machinery, carried out without the necessary permission. A fine of Rs. 10,000 has been imposed on the violators.

The Deputy Commissioner has issued a stern warning to those engaging in such illegal activities, including unauthorized mining, earth transportation, and dumping. Further, the

Chief Secretary launches SMART Public Distribution System (PDS) 2.0 Portal

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, today officially launched SMART PDS 2.0, a modern, citizen-centric Public Distribution System (PDS) that marks a significant technological upgrade from the earlier ePDS platform.

Effective from August 5, 2025, all ration card-related services will be available online through the newly developed portal: <https://an.smartpds.nic.in>. The platform has been developed by NIC (HQ) in coordination with



NIC, Sri Vijaya Puram. Beneficiaries can log in using the Aadhaar Number, Ration Card Number, or Registered Mobile Number of the Head of Family, followed by OTP-based secure authentication.

Key features of SMART PDS 2.0:

- One-stop online access to all ration card services-no physical visits to Government Offices required.
- Time-saving and efficient, eliminating long queues and manual form submissions.

Andaman & Nicobar plans commercial helicopter services to boost tourism

The Andaman & Nicobar administration has invited Expressions of Interest from Indian aviation operators to launch commercial helicopter services, aiming to connect 11 islands with faster travel.

The Directorate of Civil Aviation, Andaman & Nicobar administration, has invited Expression of Interest (EOI) from registered Indian aviation companies for introduction of commercial helicopter services from Sri Vijaya Puram to 11 islands in the archipelago, popular among tourists.

The call for EOI, issued on August 4, is aimed at obtaining

response from interested operators and ironing out operational concerns before proceeding to a formal tender. Subsequent to this, based on the responses would float a transparent and competitive request for proposal (RFP) on no-cost-no-commitment (NCNC) basis for selection of the operator.

The administration's pitch is anchored in existing infrastructure. On the northwest side of Veer Savarkar International Airport's runway sits a dedicated inter-island helicopter terminal, complete with passenger facilities, security screening, and a hangar. The apron can park up to six helicopters at a time, while a 32-by-29-metre hangar stands ready for operations.

Operators to bear full responsibility

Under the plan, the island administration

would serve as facilitator, offering helipads and related amenities - from waiting rooms to X-ray machines - available at a cost. Operations from Sri Vijaya Puram to all the proposed routes can be undertaken by filing flight plan(s) with Air Traffic Control (ATC) service, provided by Indian Navy (INS Utkrosh), while refuelling would be provided by Indian Oil Corporation.

No government subsidies or viability gap funding are on offer. Operators would assume full responsibility for aircraft, crew, passengers safety, and

District Administration, SA issues advisory for Ganesh Puja celebrations - 2025

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 5

Following the coordination meeting held on 31.07.2025 at 1700 Hrs, the District Administration, South Andaman has issued the following advisory for strict compliance by all Ganesh Puja Committees to ensure a safe, eco-friendly, and peaceful celebration:

- To prevent any mishap due to overhead HT lines, the height of Ganesh idols shall be restricted to below 16 feet. This directive is to be adhered strictly.
- Puja Committees are advised to use natural colours and avoid hazardous chemicals while preparing idols to mitigate environmental hazards during immersion.
- A designated route for immersion shall be followed. All Puja Committees shall inform the Police Department in advance about the date, time and route of immersion.
- All Puja Pandals must use ISI-marked insulated wiring with proper earthing. No decorative lighting shall be hung across roads. The Electricity Department shall inspect Pandals and issue NOC. Lighting should be placed at least 5 feet above ground level.
- Joint inspections by officials of Electricity Dept., Police, Fire Brigade and the area Executive Magistrate shall be conducted. A report is to be submitted to the SDM/Assistant Commissioner (SA).
- No loudspeakers shall be used after 10:00 PM. Noise levels shall be maintained as per prescribed limits. Violation shall lead to seizure and legal action.
- Puja Committees shall ensure adequate fire-fighting equipment at the Pandals.
- Puja Committees shall deploy identifiable volunteers with ID cards/badges, abstaining from alcohol or intoxicants. Misconduct shall lead to denial of permission in subsequent years. Volunteer details with photographs to be submitted at the concerned Police Station.
- A single window facilitation counter shall be established at the District Control Room for receiving and processing Puja permission applications.
- Drivers of immersion vehicles shall be instructed against over speeding and intoxication. Committee members shall accompany processions to ensure discipline.
- Puja Committees shall place separate dustbins for general and plastic waste. PBMC shall ensure timely waste collection.
- Only devotional songs to be played at Pandals and during immersion. Volunteers or individuals found intoxicated shall be penalized.
- Organizers shall arrange for power backup and obtain NOC from the Junior Engineer regarding earthing and wiring.
- Any act of violence, eve-teasing or breach of peace by volunteers or members shall lead to disqualification from next year's celebration and legal action.
- Organizers shall be held responsible for any untoward incidents due to non-compliance with fire, electricity, and law & order regulations.
- Organizers shall strictly adhere to CPCB's "Guidelines for Idol Immersion" as per public notice dated 01.09.2016. A copy shall be issued with the final permission, a press release from DC (SA) said.

property, along with all insurance and liability obligations.

In the year 2024, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands welcomed about 722,000 tourists, marking a steady rise in visitor numbers over the years.

Rising tourism spurs push for helicopter service

Tourism to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has surged in recent years. In 2024, the archipelago welcomed roughly 722,000 visitors, a steady increase that has prompted major investments in infrastructure, according to the Andaman & Nicobar administration. In 2023, the Veer Savarkar International Airport inaugurated a new integrated terminal building capable of handling 1,200 passengers an hour, or up to five million domestic and international travellers annually.

Inter-island air connectivity has become a priority. The administration has developed 19 helipads - 12 of them strategically located in popular tourist destinations across south, north, and middle Andaman - opening the possibility of helicopter services that could shorten journeys to some of its most remote and scenic parts.

Islands expand sustainable tourism offerings

The tourism sector itself is evolving. Around 600 hospitality businesses now operate across the islands, from budget bed and breakfast (B&B) accommodations to luxury beach resorts. More high-end resorts and villas are in development. Authorities are also investing in eco-tourism, heritage trails, adventure water sports, and niche experiences like bird watching and stargazing, with an eye on positioning the islands as a world class sustainable tourism destination.

For now, ferries remain the backbone of inter-island travel. Alongside government vessels, seven private cruise boats - each seating about 300 passengers - run daily trips to Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep. Other islands are still served solely by government ferries, a gap the administration hopes helicopter services might begin to fill. (Source: www.business-standard.com)


