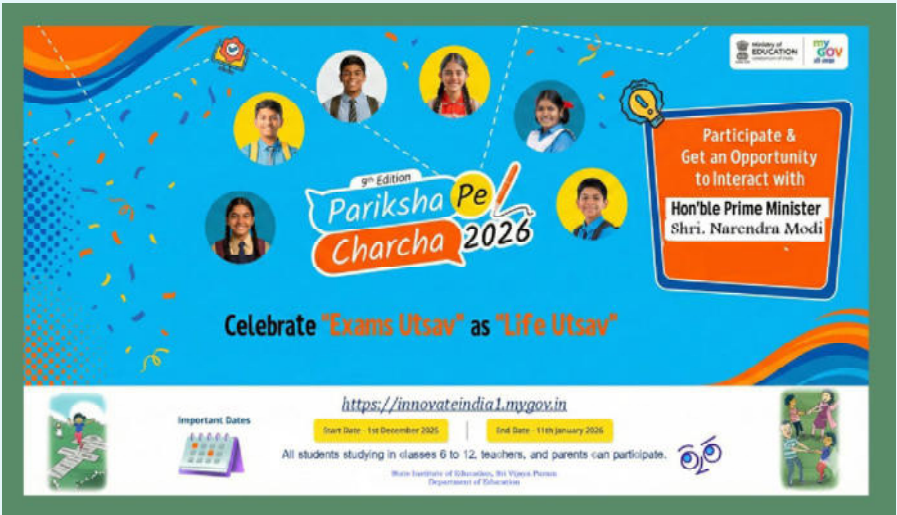

Hon'ble MP meets Add. Secretary (UT), Ministry of Home Affairs

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A&N Islands, met the Additional Secretary (UT), Ministry of Home Affairs, in New Delhi and submitted a letter on important public issues taken up with the Home Ministry for urgent consideration. Introduction of a domicile law; Fixation of upper age limit at 40 years; Enhancement of the annual UT budget under the Capital Head and allocation of a special grant of Rs.5,000 crore for infrastructure development; Early constitution of the OBC



Commission; Enhancement of salaries of MNREGA staff; Urgent implementation of anti-defection provisions; Review and re-examination of certain provisions in the Industrial Estate Policy, 2025; Appraisal and approval by the MHA for the acquisition of 04 ships.

Special UTGST teams conducting random inspections across business establishments

Recovered total penalty amount of Rs. 3.93 lakh from non-compliant businesses

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 5

Following the recent rate changes introduced under GST 2.0, the GST Department of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has observed that several businesses in the region are yet to comply with the revised GST rates, regulations and exemptions, despite adequate time having been provided for transition.

In response and under the leadership of the Commissioner, UTGST, special teams

have been conducting random inspections across business establishments in Sri Vijaya Puram since 22nd September, 2025. During these inspections, on-the-spot penalties are being imposed wherever discrepancies are detected. As part of this ongoing drive, the Department has recovered a total penalty amount of Rs. 3.93 lakh from non-compliant businesses. The enforcement activity will continue to

ensure effective implementation of the updated GST rules, thereby ensuring that consumers receive the intended benefits of the revised tax structure.

All business entities are hereby reminded that strict adherence to the rules and

regulations notified by the GST Department is mandatory. Any instance of non-compliance will attract penalties as prescribed under the GST law.

Illegal bootlegging unit detected during Forest Fire vigil patrol at Mayabunder

The Anti-Forest Encroachment & Vigilance Squad (AFEVS) led by Shri Raghunath Baraik Forester successfully detected and dismantled an illicit country liquor distillation unit deep inside the Chainpur Reserved Forest (RF) today. The team was carrying out routine fire mitigation measures and forest vigilance patrols when they encountered the concealed illegal setup. Upon inspection, approximately 170 litres of fermented liquor was found stored in plastic containers which was promptly destroyed by the team on the spot.

All utensils, containers, and equipment used for the illegal distillation process were immediately seized and removed from the site and a case has been registered against unknown offenders under the relevant provisions of the Indian Forest Act,

1927 for trespassing and kindling of fire inside Reserved forest area.

The Divisional Forest Office, Mayabunder, urges the public to remain vigilant and report any illegal activity related to forest-timber, fire, encroachment and wildlife. The identities

Day 1 commenced with detailed briefings by participating stakeholders outlining roles responsibilities and preparedness plans. Discussions focused on response frameworks under National Oil Spill Disaster Contingency Plan (NOSDCP) availability of resources and coordinated action mechanisms. A comprehensive table-top exercise simulating a heavy oil spill off Sri Vijaya Puram Harbour was conducted to assess inter-agency communication decision-making and coordination in a controlled environment.

Day 2 featured a full-scale sea exercise demonstrating pollution response capabilities of Indian Coast Guard and partner agencies. Offshore Patrol Vessels in PR configuration along with other surface platforms and aircraft were deployed. Containment booms were effectively laid to control and recover simulated spilled oil. Coast Guard Dornier aircraft and Chetak helicopters showcased aerial capability using spray pods to restrict spread of oil reaffirming operational readiness and technical proficiency, a press release from HQ ANC said.
