

or absent', while 23,137 are reported to have permanently shifted. There are also 2,842 electors whose names are duplicate/already enrolled on the list and 705 electors in 'Others' category. These electors collectively account for 21.27% of the total Enumeration Forms distributed.

At the polling station level, the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) are conducting meetings with Booth Level Agents (BLAs) and sharing the list of uncollectable enumeration forms to Booth Level Agents of respective polling station for verification.

In Polling Stations, where no Booth Level Agents (BLAs) has been appointed by the recognized Political Parties, the uncollectable list is being displayed at the polling station for public verification. 


