Whereas, a communication has been received from the Senior Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, regarding the visit of a VIP to the Islands from 11th December 2025 to 14th December 2025, during which the VIP will be visiting various locations within the district;

And Whereas, recent intelligence inputs suggest that anti-social elements or terrorists may attempt to use Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), including drones, gliders, or other remote-controlled aircraft, to carry out attacks, disrupt public order, or conduct surveillance on critical infrastructure, particularly in areas where the VIP will visit at VSI Airport, Chinmaya Mission, Burmanallah, DBRAIT and Netaji Stadium.

And Whereas, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, am of the opinion that there are sufficient grounds for proceeding under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, and that immediate action is necessary to prevent obstruction, annoyance, or injury to persons lawfully employed, and to avert any potential danger to human life and public safety during the VIP visit;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, hereby issue the following order:

A complete ban is hereby imposed on the flying, operation, and use of all types of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), including drones, gliders, and any other remote-controlled aircraft in and around restricted areas of VSI Airport, Chinmaya Mission, Burmanallah, DBRAIT and Netaji Stadium of Sri Vijaya Puram Tehsil under South Andaman District.

This ban shall remain in force from 11th December 2025 to 14th December

Any person found violating this order shall be liable for punishment under the Section 223 of the Bharativa Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, as well as other relevant provisions of law, including provisions under BNSS 2023 and the Civil Aviation Act.

In view of the emergent nature of the situation, this order is issued exparte and is being made public to ensure immediate compliance.

This order shall be promulgated by affixing copy thereof at the notice board of the office of the undersigned as well as the District Court, Port Blair and publication in News Paper having circulation in the areas through office of the Information & Publicity, A&N Administration.

Today, the banking sector stands stronger than ever- with robust capital and liquidity buffers, improved asset quality, and sustainable profitability. The resilience of public sector banks (PSBs) and scheduled commercial banks (SCBs), reflected in their highquality capital, declining loan losses, and solid earnings, underscores their capacity to finance growth while withstanding shocks.

From Crisis to Confidence- The New Face of Indian Banking

After the Global Financial Crisis, which ended in early 2009, India's strong fiscal and monetary stimulus helped cushion the impact. However, the following years saw the emergence of a "twin balance sheet" problem, marked by overleveraged corporates and mounting stress. Yet, what followed turned the challenge into an opportunity, eventually bringing India in the list of "Top Five" economies of the world.

Guided by the principle "never waste a good crisis", in the last 10 years, a series of deep structural reforms began- aimed at restoring the long-term strength and stability of the financial system. Today, Indian banks are far more mature than they were a decade ago.

Bank deposits and credit (domestic) have nearly tripled between 2015 and 2025, with deposits rising from Rs. 88.35 lakh crore to Rs.231.90 lakh crore and credit expanding from Rs.66.91 lakh crore to Rs.181.34 lakh crore.

Capital buffers have strengthened- the capital to risk weighted assets (CRAR), which measures capital adequacy, rose from 12.94% in March 2015 to 17.36% in March 2025 with CET-1, which represents the highest quality From FY 22-23 to FY 24-25, net profit increased from Rs.1.05 lakh crore to capital a bank can hold, increasing from 9.98% to 14.81% during the same period.

Asset quality has also improved. Gross Non-Performing Assets (GNPA) and Net Non-Performing Assets (NNPA) have reduced to 2.2% and 0.5% in March 2025 after rising to highs of 11.18% and 5.94% respectively in March 2018. 

Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCBs)

During FY 24-25, SCBs recorded their highest ever aggregate net profit of Rs.4.01 lakh crore, compared to the net profit of Rs.3.5 lakh crore in FY 23-24. The growth trajectory continues, as SCB's recorded an aggregate net profit of Rs.1.02 lakh crore in first 3-months of FY26.

Continuing on this success, the profitability of SCBs improved during FY An asset becomes non-performing when it ceases to generate income for 25, with Profit After Tax surging by 14.7% (YoY). Gains in profitability continued with Return on Assets (RoA) at 1.37% and Returns on Equity

Besides, banks' capital position remained satisfactory, as reflected in key parameters like leverage ratio (which measures the proportion of a bank's Tier 1 capital to its total assets, serving as a safeguard against excessive risk exposure) and capital to risk weighted assets ratio (CRAR), defined as the practices during this period along with wilful default / loan frauds, economic ratio of total capital funds to risk-weighted assets. The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) introduced in 2016, along with complementary out-of-court resolution mechanisms, transformed India's credit culture and improved recovery processes. It changed the creditorborrower relationship, taking away control of the defaulting company from promoters/owners and debarred willful defaulters from the resolution process.

Sharper recovery laws: Key legislations such as the SARFAESI Act, 25 from 1.24% in FY 22-23. This indicates sustained improvement in asset 2002 (The Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002) and the Recovery of Debt and Bankruptcy Act have been amended to enhance their effectiveness in asset recovery.

The deployment of business correspondents and incorporation of a business strategy that uses physical sales and marketing force to interact directly with customers (Feet-on-street model), has further boosted recovery efforts.

> In October 2025, the RBI issued a landmark reform through its Draft Directions 2025, proposing a shift to the Expected Credit Loss (ECL) framework. The framework applies to scheduled commercial banks, including foreign banks, and introduces a risk-sensitive approach to provisioning. These are expected to further support credit risk management practices, promote greater comparability across financial institutions, and align regulatory norms with globally accepted regulatory and accounting standards.

> Proactive stress management: The RBI's Prudential Framework for Resolution of Stressed Assets promotes early identification, reporting, and time-bound resolution of stressed loans, with incentives for lenders to act swiftly.

Evolving Priorities in India's Banking Landscape

Building on their strong financial performance and improved asset quality, Indian banks are now focusing on sustaining growth through innovation, inclusion, and strategic expansion. The following priorities outline the path ahead for strengthening the banking ecosystem and supporting India's broader development goals:

Industries such as mining, petroleum, metallurgy, chemical and heavy manufacturing play a vital role in India's economic growth. Many workers in these industries operate in high-risk environments. Recognizing the need for a stronger, future-ready safety architecture for the workforce, the Government has introduced the new Labour Codes consolidating 29 Central labour laws into 4 Labour Codes. Under The Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (OSH&WC), a more integrated, preventive safety system with risk assessment, free annual health check-ups, training, PPE, emergency planning, etc. have been provisioned. These reforms strengthen safety protocols, mandate risk-mitigation practices, and enhance accountability while giving employers clearer, simpler, and more predictable regulatory pathways. Notably, the new framework aims to ensure safer worksites, stronger protections, and more

dignified conditions for India's hazardous-sector workforce. **Key Benefits to Workers in Hazardous Processes**

The Labour Codes introduce a strengthened safety and welfare framework for India's hazardous-sector workforce, enhancing protection, accountability, and risk management across high-risk industries. All workers engaged in hazardous processes or industries, including chemical, explosive, gas, radiation, mining, construction, dock, and heavy engineering sectors, are comprehensively covered under OSH&WC.

⇒Safety Standards: The OSH&WC Code highlights national standards to be followed for use, handling, storage, and transport of hazardous substances. In order to further enhance the safety safeguards employers must conduct risk assessment, obtain approval, and maintain emergency response systems.

maintained manually and lacked portability and long-term traceability. Now, health records are mandatory and accessible to employees and inspectors, enabling transparency and long-term portability. Additionally, under the new Codes, pre-employment, periodic, and post-exposure medical examinations are mandatory, along with a free annual health check-up for all workers, ensuring early detection of occupational diseases that reduces medical costs and supports a healthier, more productive workforce.

⇒ <u>Protective & Welfare Measures:</u> Under the new provisions, employers must provide and maintain PPE (personal protective equipment) such as helmets, pregnant women and adolescents also avail benefits of special rights, as they are strictly gloves, respirators, and goggles. Additionally, ensuring improved sanitation and barred from engaging in hazardous processes. Safety supervision is also mandatory



hygiene standards is also required- by mandating canteens, rest shelters, washing facilities, first aid, ambulance rooms, and cooling areas in high-temperature workplaces. Employers need to adhere by the prescribed maximum working hours of 8 hours per day and 48 hours per week.

Training & Awareness: Earlier, trainings were not compulsory and varied by sector. Now, mandatory training sessions on the safe handling, storage, transport, and disposal of hazardous materials have been introduced to assist workers.

Social Security: To ensure efficient social security provisions, immediate ⇒ Health & Medical Protection: Earlier, medical & health records were compensation for occupational diseases or accidents is ensured under the Social Security Code, 2020 (SS) / ESIC. Besides, workers are also entitled to ESIC benefits (medical, occupational disease, injury, disability, dependents' benefits). Other benefits such as PF, gratuity, maternity, employment injury compensation and old-age protection (pension) are also provided, along with digital health and social security records that enhance transparency and portability.

Special Rights: The Right is explicitly guaranteed under OSH&WC Code wherein workers may refuse dangerous work that are likely to cause serious injury or death, with mandatory employer investigation and zero penalty for refusal by workers. Besides,

for women workers in permitted tasks.

Comparative Analysis of Previous Laws vs. New Labour Codes

Previously, hazardous workers were protected under fragmented provisions with inconsistent enforcement and limited medical coverage. Now, under the OSH&WC Code, an integrated, preventive safety system with standards is in place, offering provisions for free annual health check-ups, training, PPE, emergency planning, etc. Likewise, compensation, backed by universal social security have also been provided for under the SS Code.

Legal Framework

Earlier, fragmented laws with separate provisions under the Factories Act (hazardous process), Mines Act, Dock Workers Act, and Building & Other Construction Workers Act (BOCW Act), carried their own list of hazardous operations. However, there are now uniform definitions under OSH&WC Code, 2020 for all industries involving chemical, biological, physical hazards. Specific provisions lay down standards for use, handling, storage, transportation of hazardous substances. There is also a uniform national framework for safety, health, welfare, emergency response. **Identification of Hazardous Processes**

Previously, different lists and rules under multiple Acts led to weak enforcement. Now, a consolidated Schedule under OSH&WC Code lists all hazardous processes (asbestos, toxic chemicals, pesticides, radioactive materials, etc.). Additionally, employers must conduct risk assessments and provide prior intimation before initiating hazardous processes.

Emergency & Disaster Preparedness

No unified emergency management system existed with dependency on factory inspectorates or National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) guidelines. Now, with the Labour Codes in place, there needs to be a mandatory on-site emergency plan for every hazardous establishment, emergency response mechanisms and six-monthly mock drills. Besides, a formal linkage with the local Disaster Management Authority for external coordination is also required. **Inspection & Enforcement**

There were multiple inspectorates under different Acts and overlapping jurisdictions existed. Whereas now, a unified Inspector-cum-Facilitator system is in place with risk-based digital inspections, joint compliance audits, and stringent penalties for


