Lok Sabha passes Viksit Bharat-Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin): 'Viksit Bharat - G RAM G Bill 2025'

Legislation to replace Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005

New Delhi, Dec. 18

The Lok Sabha has passed the Viksit Bharat - Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin): Viksit Bharat - G RAM G Bill 2025. The legislation will replace Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005. The Bill seeks to establish a rural development framework aligned with the national vision of Viksit Bharat @2047. Under the legislation, a statutory guarantee of one hundred and twenty-five days of wage employment will be provided in every financial year to every



rural household whose adult members volunteer to undertake unskilled manual work. The fund-sharing pattern between the Central Government and State Governments will be 60:40 for all States other than the North-eastern and the Himalayan States, wherein the sharing arrangement will be 90:10. The State Government will continue to pay unemployment allowance and weekly public compensation. The bill provides for using biometric authentication for transactions, geospatial technology for planning and monitoring, mobile application-based dashboards for real-time tracking, and disclosure systems. All works undertaken

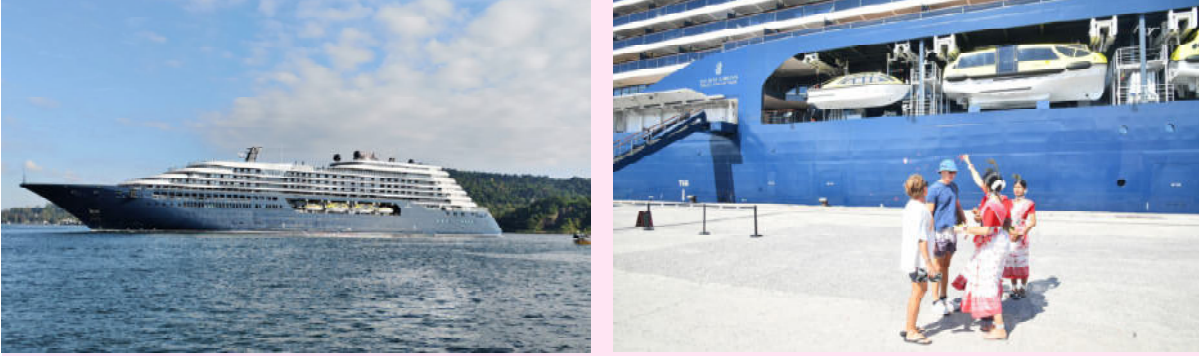
under this Bill will be aggregated into the Viksit Bharat National Rural Infrastructure Stack, creating a unified national framework for rural public works. Replying to the discussion on the Bill, Union Rural Development Minister, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan said, Rural development is at the core of its policy. He said, under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the MGNREGA scheme has been implemented properly and effectively. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

India Begins Work On Second Great Nicobar Airfield Near Malacca Strait

India has initiated preparatory work for building a second airfield on Great Nicobar Island, a strategically located outpost at the mouth of the Malacca Strait that sits astride one of the world's busiest maritime corridors, The Tribune has reported. The proposed airport will be developed at Chingen near Galathea Bay on Great Nicobar, south of the existing naval air station

INS Baaz at Campbell Bay. Its proximity to the Six Degree Channel between Great Nicobar and Indonesia's Sumatra places it closer to shipping lanes that funnel traffic into the Malacca Strait, through which tens of thousands of commercial vessels pass every year. The Airports Authority of India is overseeing the project, estimated at Rs 8,573 crore, and has floated tenders for appointing

a project management consultant, with bids scheduled to close later this month. Planned as a dual-use greenfield facility, the airfield will cater to civilian operations while also supporting aircraft and unmanned systems of the Indian Navy and the Indian Air Force. Officials said the model will mirror other airports across the country that are shared between military and civilian users. The airport forms a

key component of the proposed International Container Transshipment Port at Galathea Bay, which is being projected as a future logistics hub in the eastern Indian Ocean. The Union Government has stated that safeguards and mitigation measures have been built into the project design to reduce ecological impact. Alongside the civilian-led (Contd. on last page)

development, the military footprint on Great Nicobar is being strengthened.

The Andaman and Nicobar Islands already host a Joint Operations Centre for integrated surveillance and planning, and additional upgrades are planned at other naval air stations in the archipelago.

'Operation Coral Shield' launched: 8 Myanmarese poachers & engine dinghy apprehended and approx. 800 kg Sea Cucumber seized by A&N Police



Mayabunder, Dec. 18

Acting on credible information received from local fishermen on 01/12/2025 regarding the sighting of suspected foreign poachers in the vicinity of uninhabited Western Coast of North Andaman Islands, an A n t i - P o a c h i n g Operation 'Coral Shield' was swiftly launched by the North & Middle Andaman District Police. Multiple Anti-Poaching teams comprising of Police personnel from PS Kalighat, OP Kishorinagar, PS Mayabunder, PS Diglipur as well as personnel from IRBn, PMF and Home Guard Volunteers were i m m e d i a t e l y mobilized to the suspected location.

The team conducted persistent patrolling and extensive searches across the identified stretch of Islands and adjoining sea routes spanning an area of 50 Sq. Km. During the operation, on 02/12/2025, the team s u c c e s s f u l l y intercepted 01 engine-powered dinghy and apprehended 02 Myanmarese poachers along with approximately 800 kg of sea cucumber and other survival articles near Nemai Gope under the jurisdiction of Police Station Kalighat.

Some poachers managed to escape into the dense jungle of the Islands, following which a comprehensive and sustained jungle search operation was immediately launched to trace and apprehend them. The team undertook continuous

tracking and combing efforts for two weeks, working in close coordination with the local fishermen community and building on local intelligence inputs.

After covering nearly 200 Sq. km across dense jungle terrain and coastal stretches and facing extremely difficult and hostile conditions, the team s u c c e s s f u l l y apprehended 03 more poachers from Karen Nallah on 16/12/2025, followed by the apprehension of 03 more poachers from Nappi Gope on 17/12/2025. Thus, a total of 45 poachers have been apprehended, 06 dinghies seized and approximately 1,500 kg of sea cucumber have been recovered by North & Middle Andaman District Police in the current year.

The operation Coral Shield was coordinated by SI Shibender Nath Haider, SHO, PS Kalighat under the supervision of Shri Ankesh Yadav, SDPO, Diglipur. This forms part of the ongoing o p e r a t i o n "S A N R A K S H A N" initiative launched by A&N Police aimed at strengthening maritime vigilance and safeguarding the uninhabited and ecologically sensitive Islands of the Andaman & Nicobar. The North & Middle Andaman District Police has commended the alert fishermen for their timely input and reaffirmed commitment towards protecting marine biodiversity, preventing illegal trespassing and ensuring territorial security, a press release from SP, N&MA said.

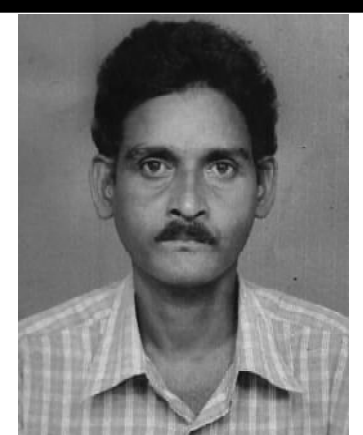
