Sanction accorded for two key road infrastructure projects APWD to undertake improvement of Wandoor & Calicut roads

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 24
The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has accorded sanction for the improvement of two important road projects under the Andaman Public Works Department (APWD). These include the upgradation of State

Highway-08 from Manglutan Junction to Wandoor Beach and the rural road from Pump House to Ayyanar Temple at Calicut. The estimated cost of the projects is Rs. 9,94,39,192 and Rs. 2,95,49,366 respectively. State Highway-08, originating from Manglutan Junction, is a vital link connecting Sri Vijaya Puram to the popular tourist destination of Wandoor. The proposed improvement of this 6-km stretch will significantly enhance riding quality and is expected to give a boost

to tourism in the Wandoor area. The improvement of the Calicut road will strengthen connectivity between Garacharma and Calicut, addressing a long-standing public demand. The upgraded road will reduce travel distance to

the proposed District Hospital and nearby schools by more than 6 km. The Administration is also planning to introduce bus services on this road after completion of the improvement works, a press release from APWD said.

The Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands has informed that as per the schedule of Special Intensive Revision (SIR), the draft electoral roll-2026 was published on 23rd December, 2025 in this UT of Andaman & Nicobar Parliamentary Constituency. On publication of draft roll, the period for filing claims and objections period is from 23rd December, 2025 to 22nd

January, 2026. The Booth Level Officers (BLOs) with copies of the Draft Electoral Roll are present at the Polling Stations to facilitate electors in verifying their names. In addition, copy of Absent/Shifted/Deceased list also available with BLOs for verification. Both the Draft Electoral Roll and ASD list have been made available for public reference and checking on the CEO's website: <https://ceoandaman.nic.in> or ECI portal: <https://voters.eci.gov.in>.

The District Administration, South Andaman in its steadfast commitment to reclaim and protect public assets, has escalated its unwavering dedication to uphold the law of land and preserving the sanctity of public spaces. This concerted

effort is focused on phase of the eviction drive, an unauthorized residential RCC structure under construction, along with fencing erected on Government revenue land at Calicut Village, was successfully demolished. As a result, an area

No. 110/2025/F, No. 34-725/2025/Rev.- Whereas it appears to the appropriate Government that a total of 35.05 hectares land is required in the Govind Nagar village of Campbell Bay Tehsil of Nicobar District for public purpose, namely the Acquisition of Land for extension of runway at Naval Airforce Station INS BAAZ, Campbell Bay, Great Nicobar Island, Nicobar District.

Whereas, the Appropriate Government has issued a Notification under Section 40 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, vide F.No.34-725/2021 dated 07/11/2025.

And whereas, the said acquisition had been justified as being in the interest of national security and strategic requirements of the State.

And whereas a total of 16 families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The reason necessitating such displacement is that the construction of this infrastructure on the said land is of vital importance to the sovereignty, integrity, security and strategic interests of the nation.

The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District is Appointed as Administrator for Rehabilitation and Resettlement vide A & N Administration Notification F. No. 34-725/2017-Rev. dated 14.11.2017 under Section 43 of the Act for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families.

Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Govind Nagar village of Campbell Bay Tehsil under Nicobar District, a piece of land measuring 35.05 hectares of standard measurement, whose detailed description are annexed as Annexure-VI, is under acquisition.

The Notification is made under the provisions of Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (30 of 2013), read with Notification No. 1197(E), dated 23.06.2017 of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector and Tehsildar during the working days and working hours.

The Government is pleased to Authorize Officer Tehsildar and his revenue field staff to enter upon and survey land, take levels of any land, dig or bore into the sub-soil and do all other acts required for the proper execution of their work as provided and specified in Section 12 of the said Act.

Under Section 11(4) of the Act, no person shall make any transaction or cause any transaction of land i.e. sale / purchase, etc or create any encumbrances on such land from the date of publication of such notification without prior approval of the Collector.

Since the land is urgently required for the project falling within the purview of Section 40(2) The Appropriate Government has decided not to carry out the Social Impact Assessment Study, vide F. No. 34-725/2021 dated 07/11/2025.
